

Annex 12 Data quality of residence permits valid at the end of the year in Denmark

Date: 04.04.2023

Reference country: Denmark

Table: All valid permits by reason, length of validity and citizenship on 31 December of each year (migr_resvalid)

The general description of the data, which is based on a combination of data from The Danish Immigration and Danish Statistics, can be found here <https://www.dst.dk/en/Statistik/dokumentation/documentationofstatistics/the-population>.

The data includes all valid permits by the end of year 2021. This means that the permits valid less than 12 months are included. An estimation of the distribution of the permits less than 12 months, based on the delivered data in the other residence permits statistics tables will be made at later stage and published.

The distribution depends on the type of reason:

Family: Under 1% of these permits are estimated to have a validity of under 3 months, 2% of these permits a validity of 3-5 months, 13% a validity of 6-11 months and 85% a validity of 12 months or more and are therefore listed in this subcategory.

Education and study: About 1% of these permits are estimated to have a validity of under 3 months, 25% of these permits a validity of 3-5 months, 22% a validity of 6-11 months and 52% a validity of 12 months or more and are therefore listed in this subcategory.

Remunerated: About 1% of these permits are estimated to have a validity of under 3 months, 3% of these permits a validity of 3-5 months, 31% a validity of 6-11 months and 65% a validity of 12 months or more and are therefore listed in this subcategory.

Other reason: About 1% of these permits are estimated to have a validity of under 3 months, 1% of these permits a validity of 3-5 months, 48% a validity of 12 months or more and 50% a validity of 6-11 months and are therefore listed in this subcategory.

These statistics are available from 2021 reference period onwards only due to the limitations of the data sources in Denmark.
