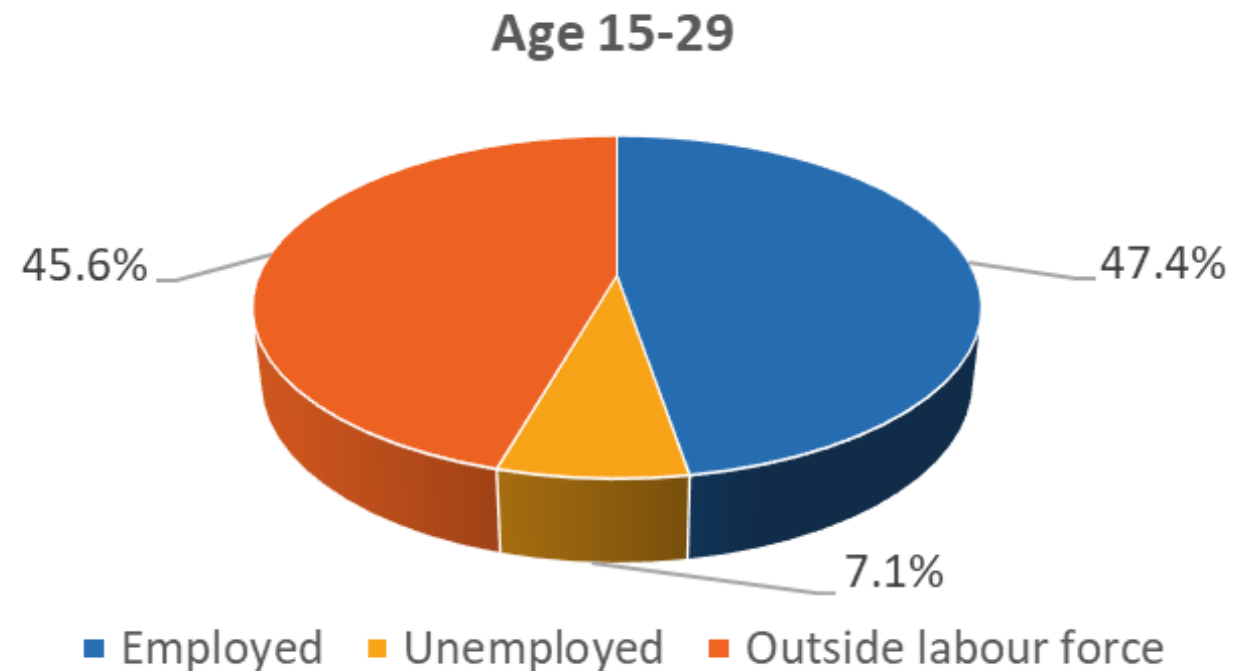
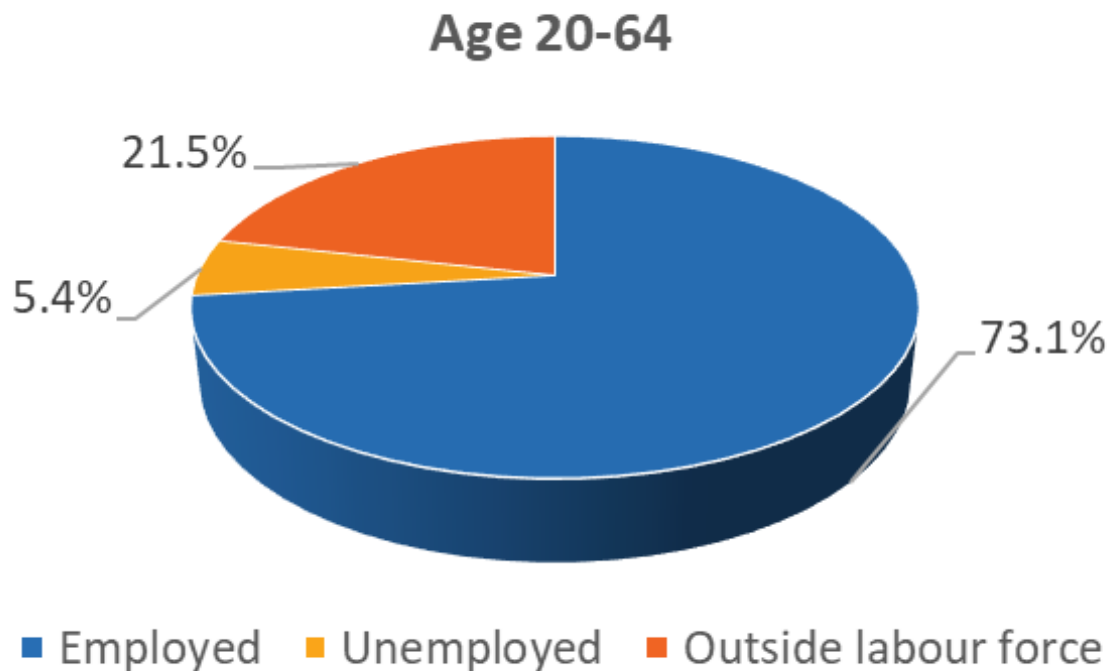

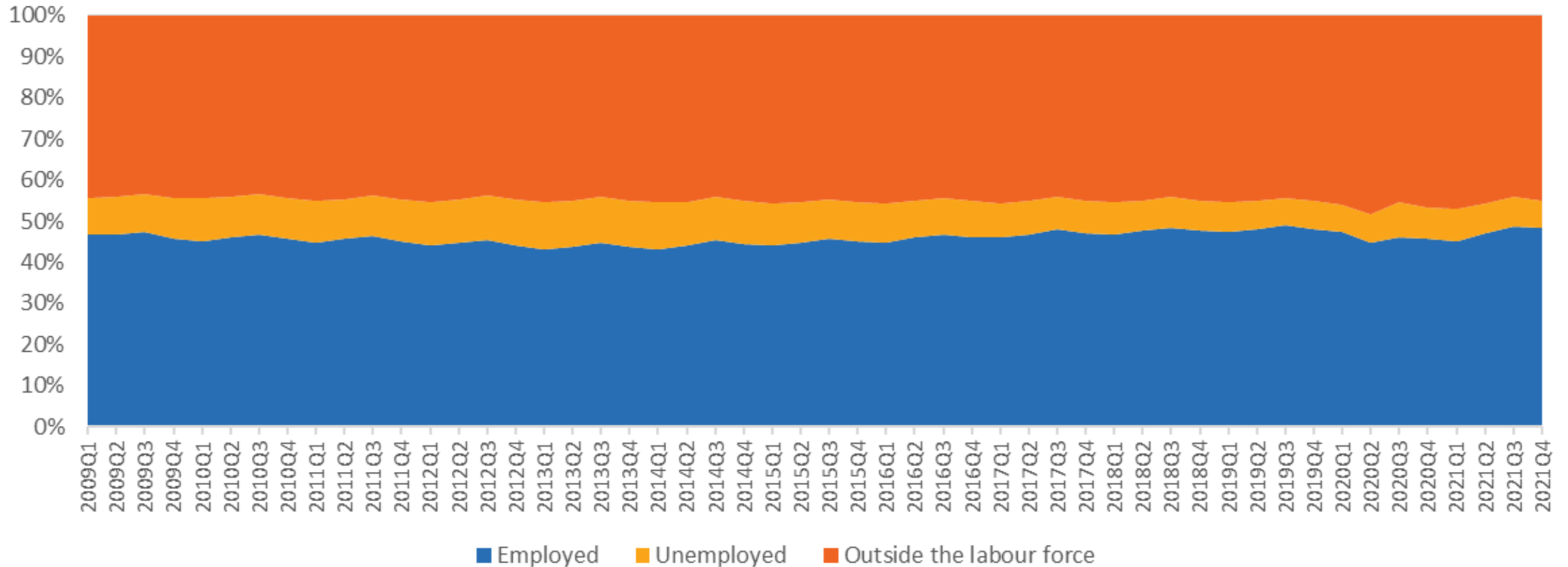
What is the situation of the young people on the labour market ?

EU level, 2021 data

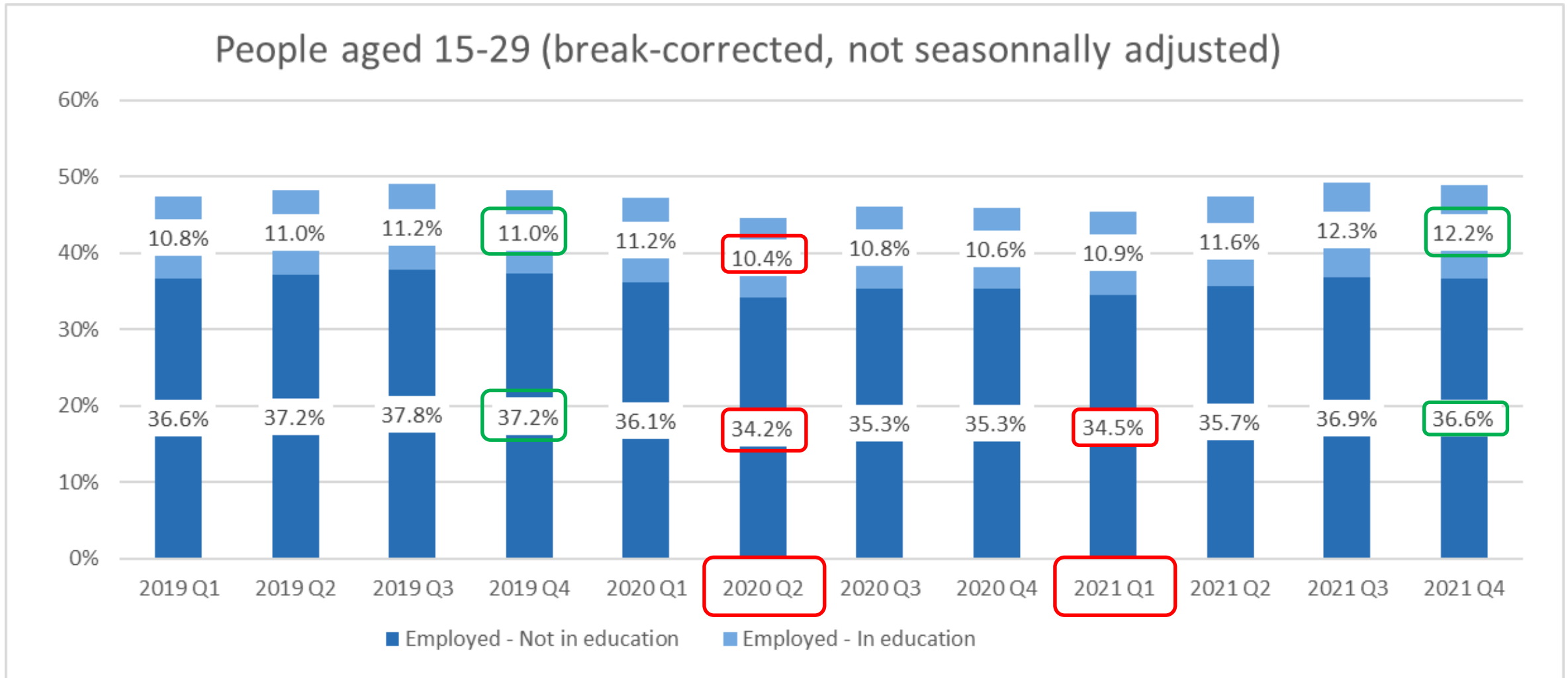


How did it evolve in the last decade ?

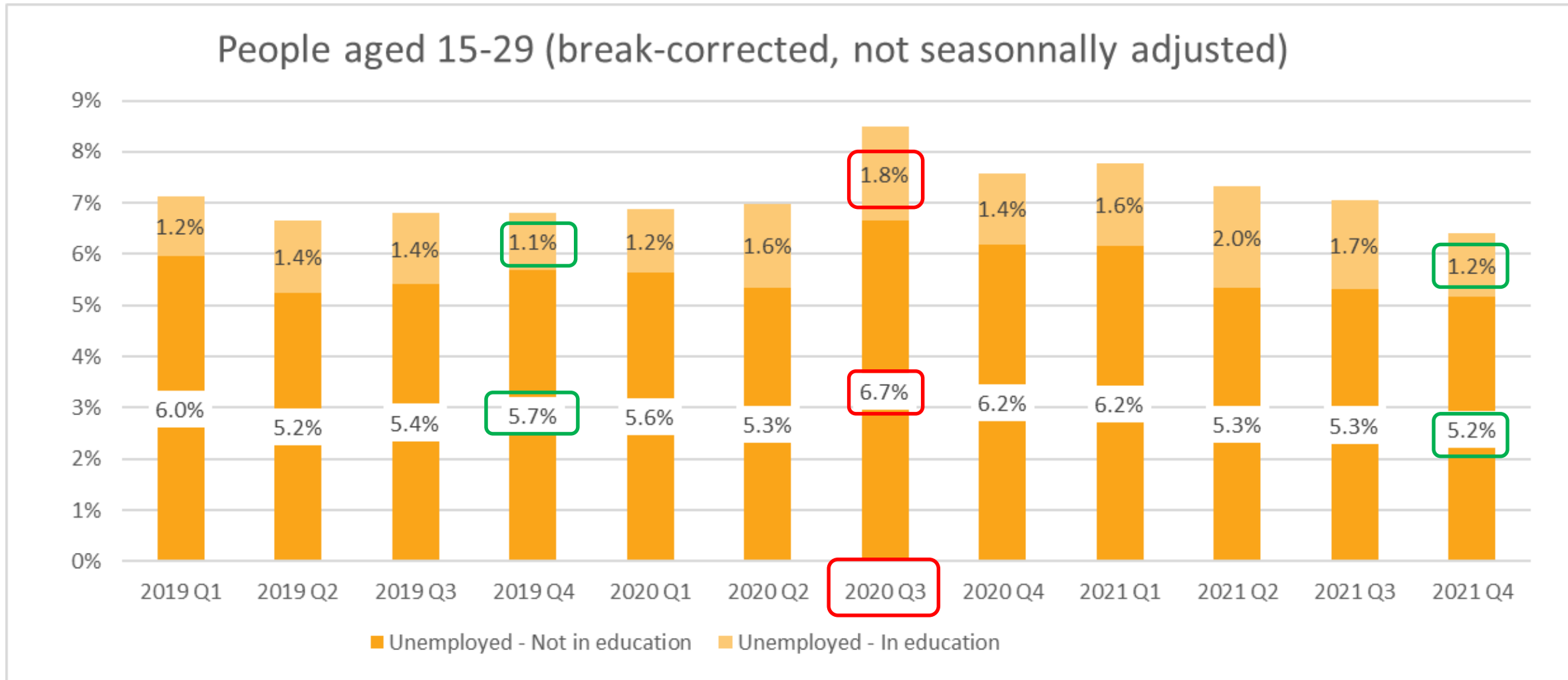
People aged 15-29 (break-corrected, not seasonally adjusted)



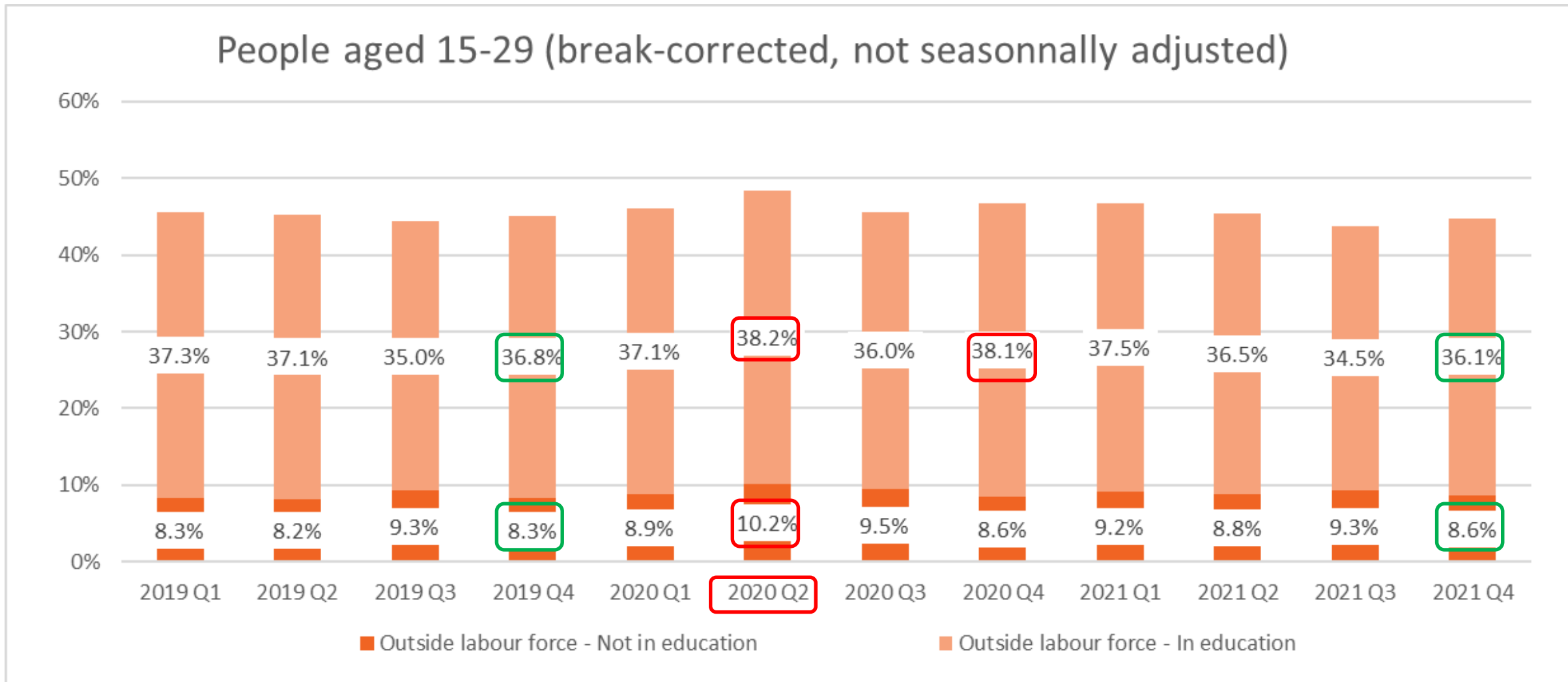
Which impact did COVID-19 have on youth employment ?



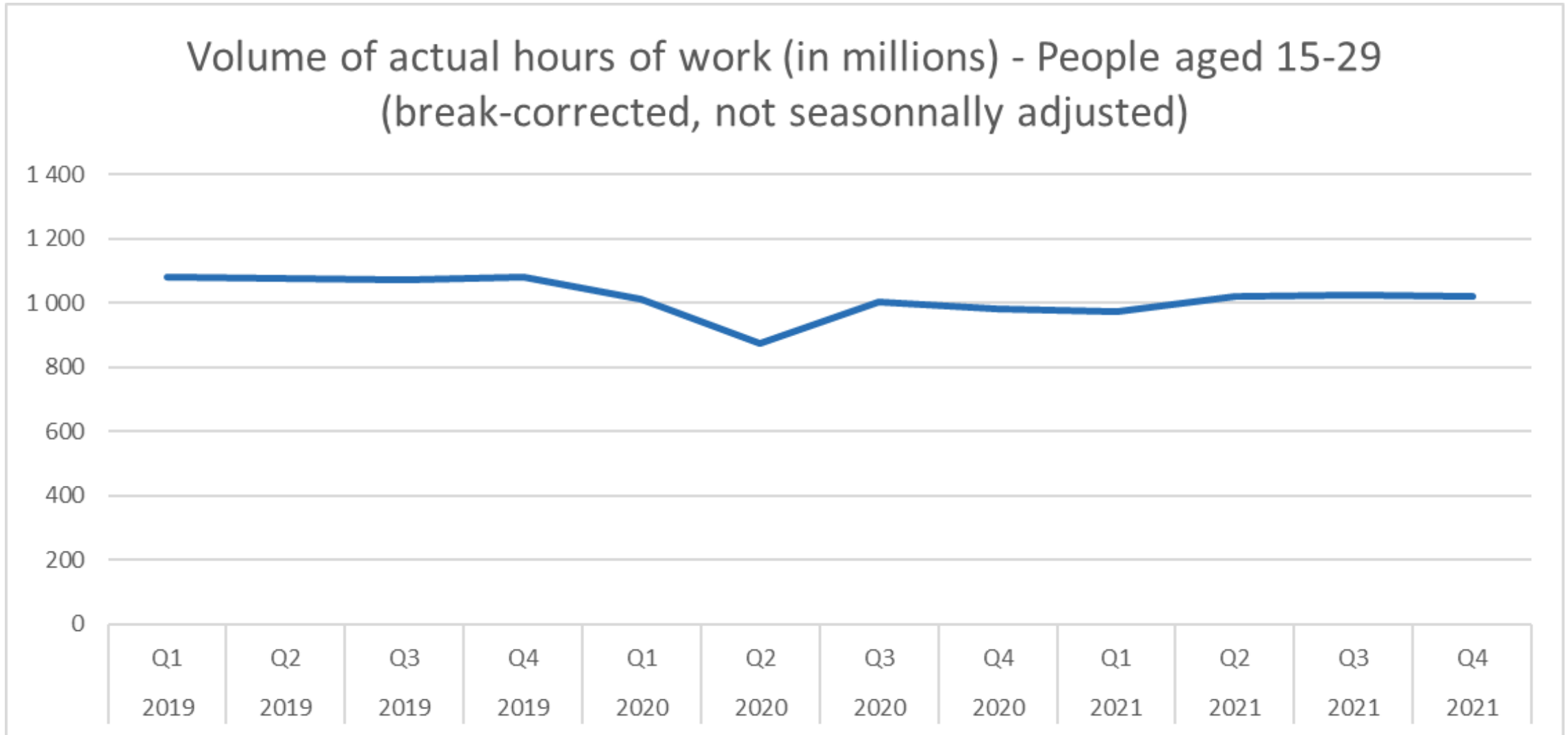
Which impact did COVID-19 have on youth unemployment ?



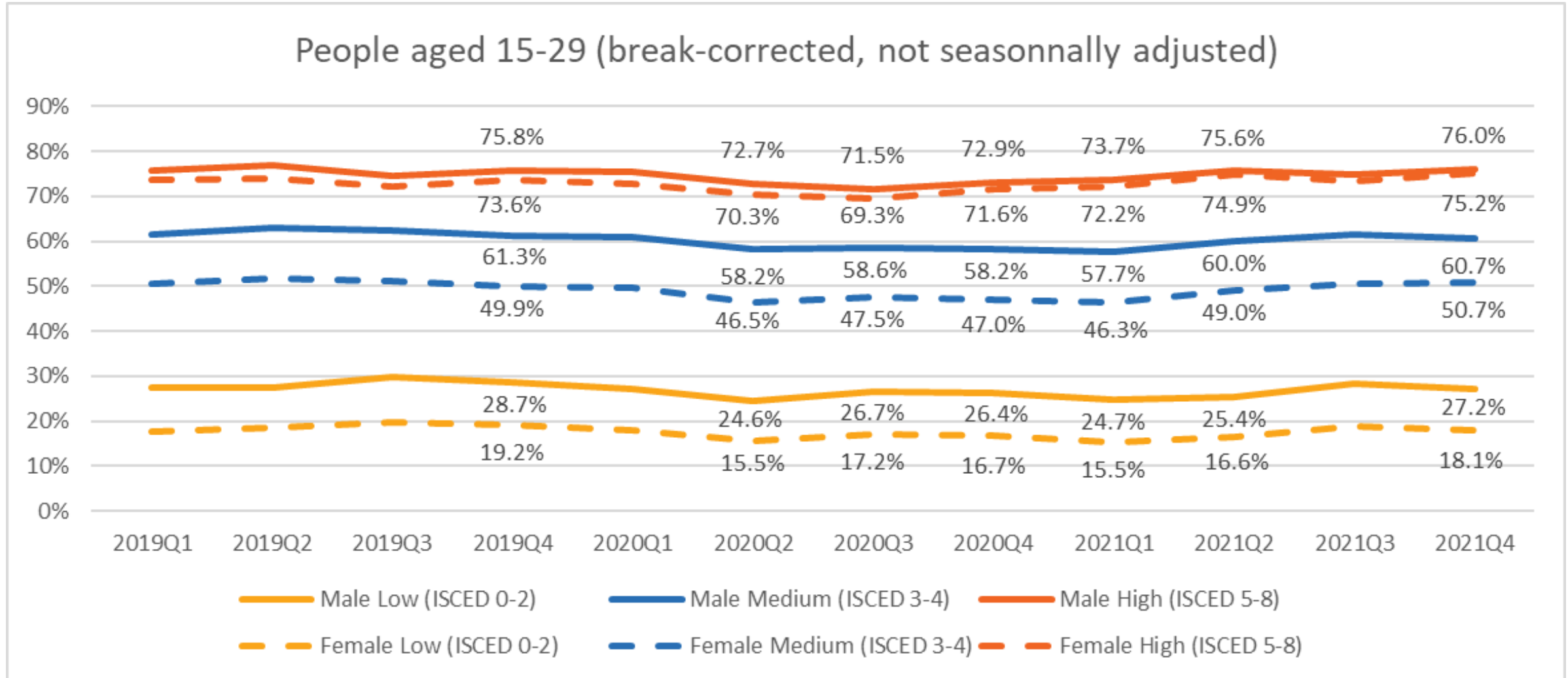
Which impact did COVID-19 have on young people outside the labour force?



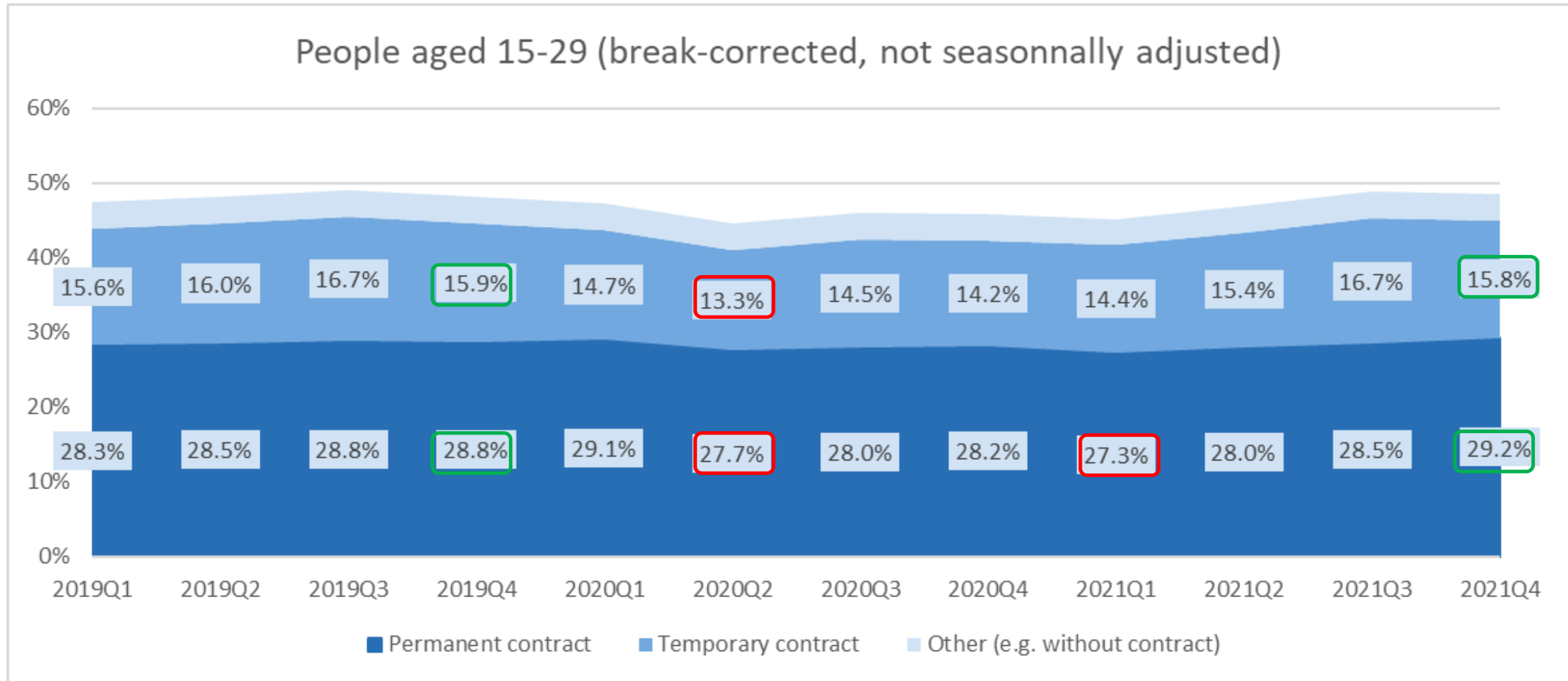
Which impact did COVID-19 have on the hours of work for young people?



Youth employment by sex and educational attainment level

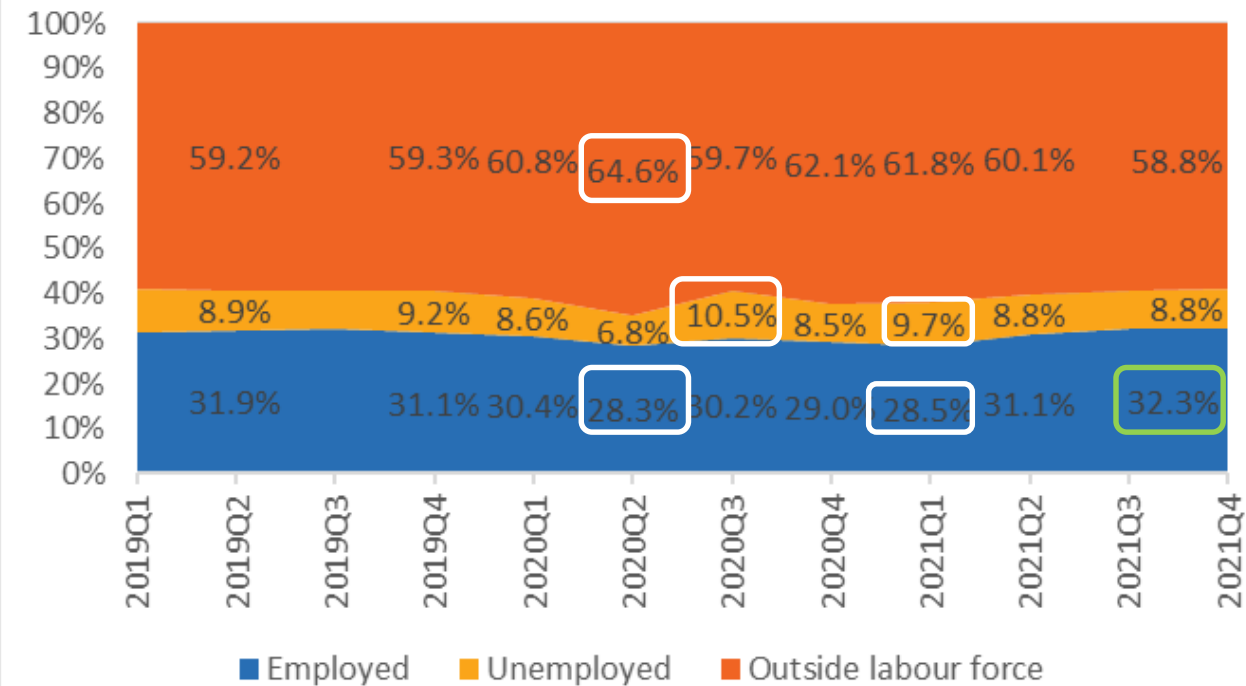


Youth employment by type of contract (permanent / temporary)

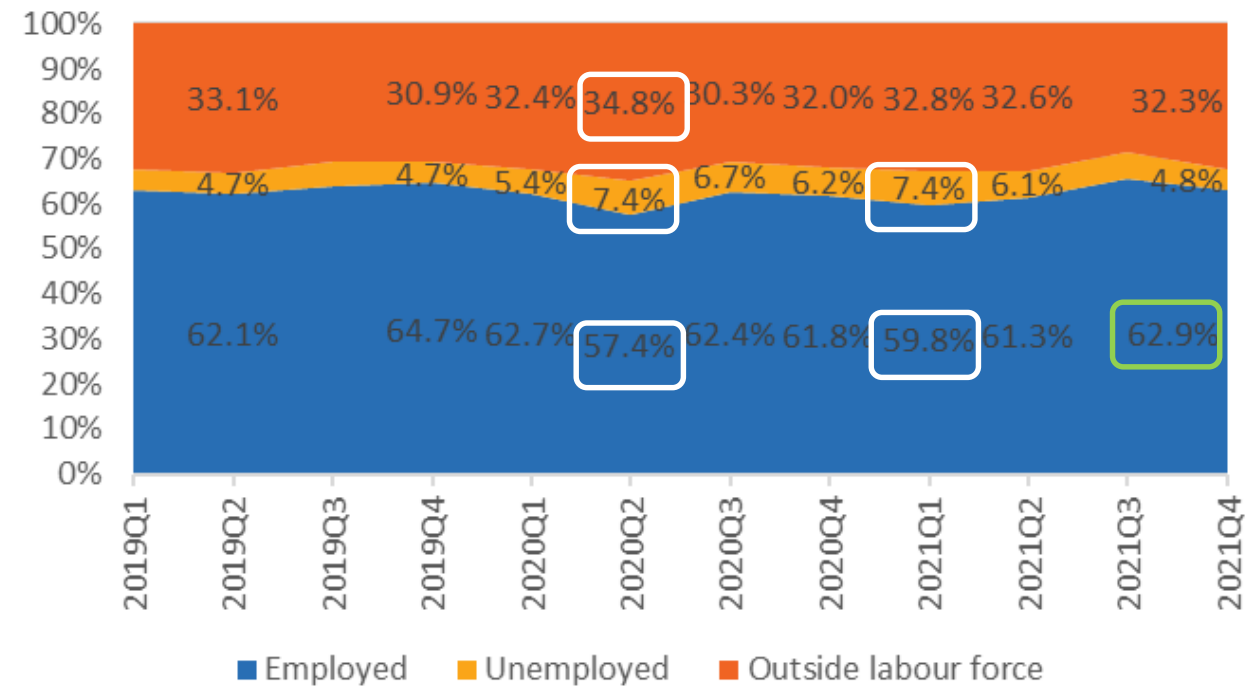

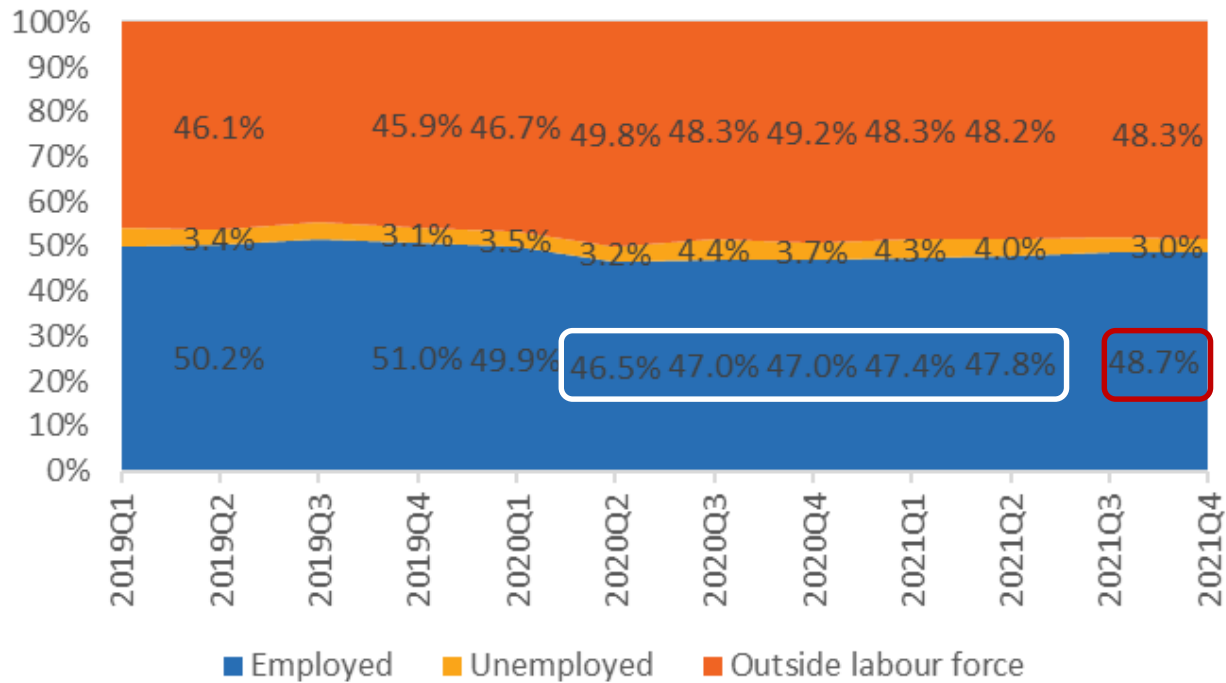

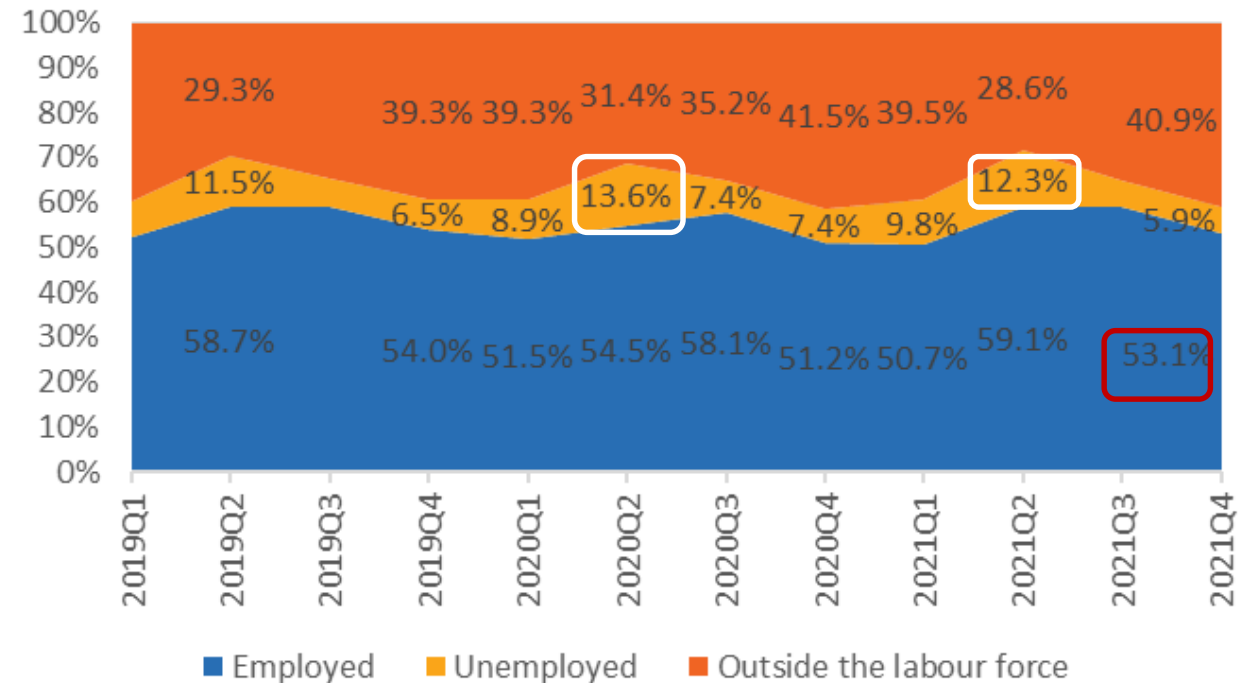

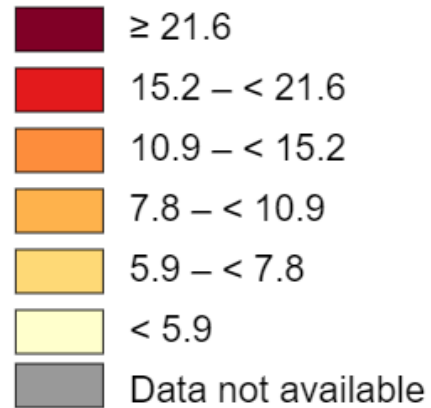

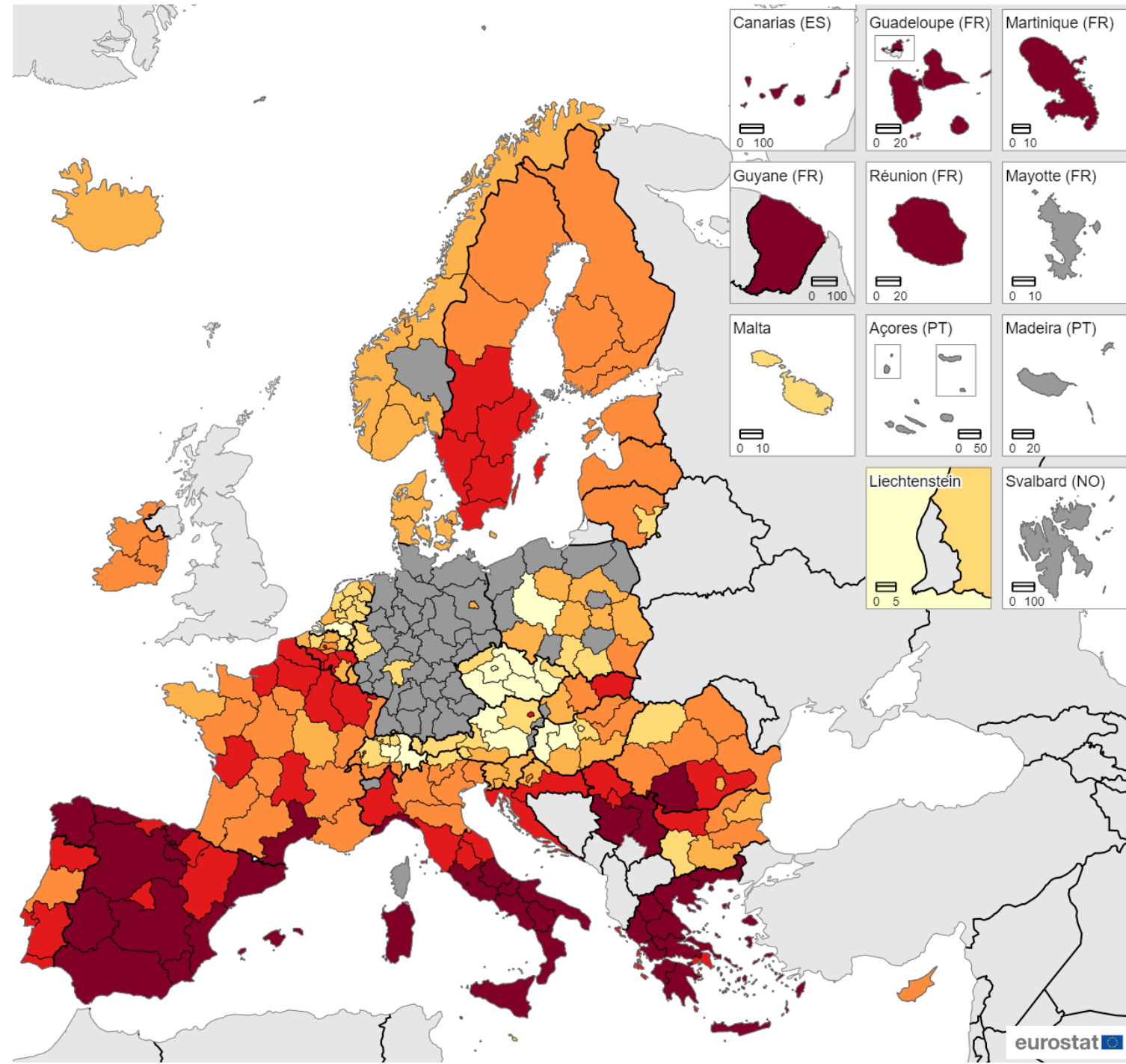
