The Eurostat Press Office collects two sets of personal data, under the responsibility of **Tim ALLEN, Head of Unit Communication**, acting as the Controller: a list of email addresses of persons having requested to receive our News Releases, Release Calendar and other Eurostat information by email; and details of those persons having made requests to our Media and Institutional support service, namely email address, name, telephone number, media type and name, as well as the question(s) asked. Please note that your personal data is only collected to the extent necessary to send you our News Releases, Release Calendar and other Eurostat information, or to process and reply to your requests for information.

Legal basis

Eurostat provides high quality statistics when necessary for the policies of the Union, in accordance with the TFEU. The personal data concerned by this notification is processed with a view to providing a service, in line with Eurostat's general mission, at the explicit request of the data subjects.

The processing operations on personal data are necessary and lawful under article 5(a) of Regulation (EC) 45/2001.

Who has access to your information and how it is protected?

Within the Commission, only designated staff within the Eurostat Communication unit can access your data by using a UserID and a Password. It will not be communicated to anyone outside the European Commission.
