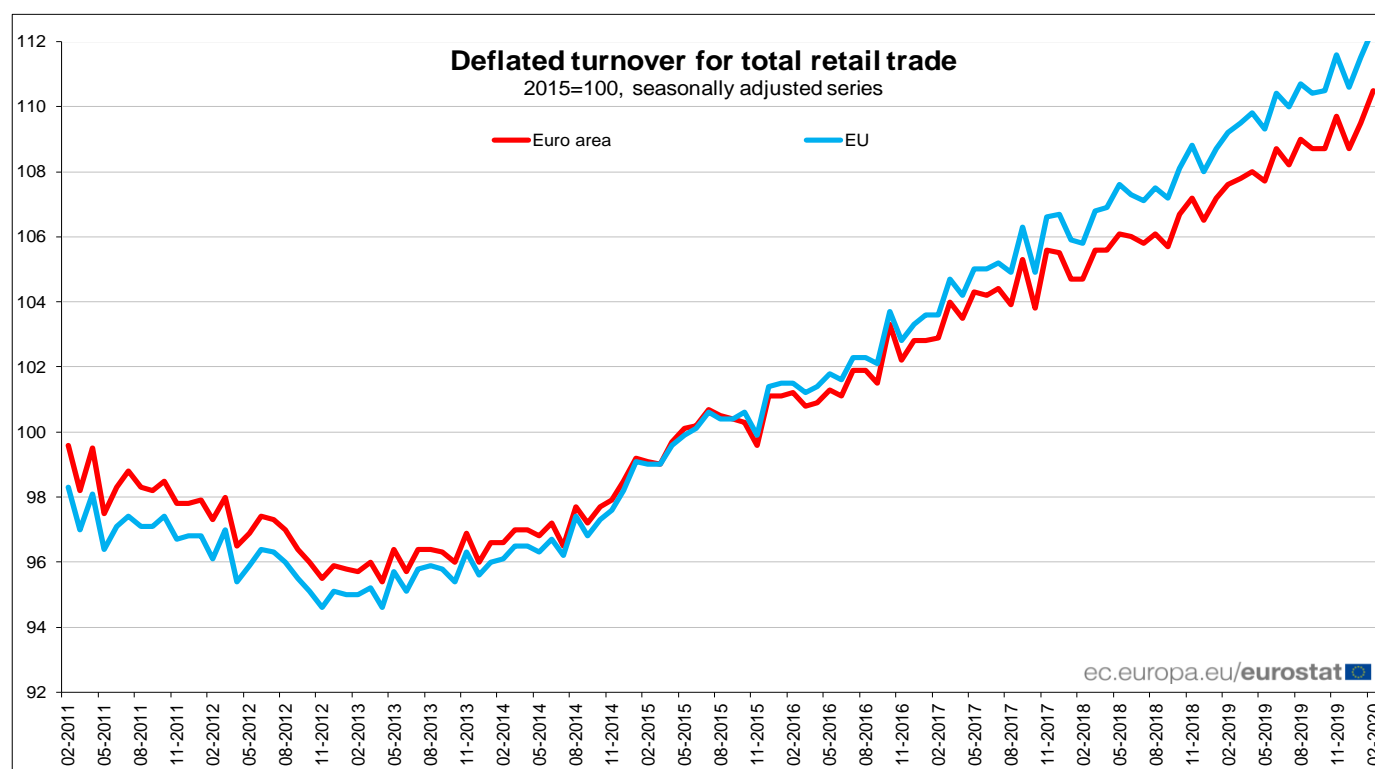
February 2020 compared with January 2020

## Volume of retail trade up by 0.9% in euro area

Up by 0.8% in EU

In February 2020 – the month before COVID-19 containment measures began to be widely introduced by Member States –, the seasonally adjusted volume of retail trade increased by 0.9% in the **euro area** and by 0.8% in the **EU**, compared with January 2020, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In January 2020, the retail trade volume increased by 0.7% in the **euro area** and by 0.8% in the **EU**.

In February 2020 compared with February 2019, the calendar adjusted retail sales index increased by 3.0% in the **euro area** and by 3.2% in the **EU**.



## Monthly comparison by retail sector and by Member State

In the **euro area** in February 2020, compared with January 2020, the volume of retail trade increased by 2.4% for food, drinks and tobacco and 0.2% for non-food products, while automotive fuels fell by 0.1%. In the **EU**, the volume of retail trade increased by 2.1% for food, drinks and tobacco, by 0.2% for non-food products and by 0.1% for automotive fuels.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest increases in the total retail trade volume were registered in **Estonia** (+4.4%), **Latvia** (+3.5%) and **Portugal** (+3.0%). Decreases were observed in **Ireland** (-2.7%), **Slovenia** (-1.8%), **Croatia** and **Poland** (both -0.2%).

## Annual comparison by retail sector and by Member State

In the **euro area** in February 2020, compared with February 2019, the volume of retail trade increased by 3.2% for food, drinks and tobacco, by 2.9% for non-food products and by 0.3% for automotive fuel. In the **EU**, the retail trade volume increased by 3.6% for non-food products, by 3.1% for food, drinks and tobacco and by 0.6% for automotive fuel.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest yearly increases in the total retail trade volume were registered in **Romania** (+11.9%), **Hungary** (+11.4%) and **Portugal** (+8.7%). A decrease was observed in **Slovenia** (-5.2%).

## Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU27) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

## Methods and definitions

The **index of the volume of retail trade** measures the evolution of the turnover in retail trade, adjusted for price changes (deflated), i.e. the evolution of the total amount of goods sold, based on data adjusted for calendar and seasonal effects.

**Seasonally adjusted** euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects.

Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

## Revisions and timetable

Data of previous months have been revised compared to those issued in the News Release [37/2020](#) of 4 March 2020. The monthly percentage change for January 2020 has been revised from +0.6% to +0.7% in the euro area and from +0.5% to +0.8% in the EU. The annual percentage change was revised from +1.7% to +2.2% in the euro area and from +2.1% to +2.4% in the EU.
