
Annual inflation down to 1.2% in the euro area

Down to 1.6% in the EU

The **euro area** annual inflation rate was 1.2% in February 2020, down from 1.4% in January. A year earlier, the rate was 1.5%. **European Union** annual inflation was 1.6% in February 2020, down from 1.7% in January. A year earlier, the rate was 1.6%. These figures are published by **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**.

The lowest annual rates were registered in **Italy** (0.2%), **Greece** (0.4%) and **Portugal** (0.5%). The highest annual rates were recorded in **Hungary** (4.4%), **Poland** (4.1%) and **Czechia** (3.7%). Compared with January, annual inflation fell in twenty-one Member States, remained stable in one and rose in five.

In February, the largest contribution to the annual **euro area** inflation rate came from services (+0.72 percentage points, pp), followed by food, alcohol & tobacco (+0.41 pp), non-energy industrial goods (+0.13 pp) and energy (-0.03 pp).



Geographical information

The **euro area** consists of Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

The euro area and European Union data refer to the respective country compositions at a specific point in time. Changes in the composition of these aggregates are incorporated using a chain index formula. For more information on this, please read [this note](#).

Methods and definitions

The **annual rate** measures the change of the harmonised indices of consumer prices (HICP) between a month and the same month of the previous year, and the **monthly rate** compares the indices between the two latest months.

A **contribution** shows how much of the annual inflation rate comes from a particular component of the HICP. The contributions are calculated according to a method which ensures their additivity (allowing for rounding).

Revisions and timetable

A flash estimate of euro area inflation is issued at the end of each reference month. The euro area [flash estimate for February 2020](#), published on 3 March 2020, was 1.2%.

The next flash estimate of euro area inflation with data for March 2020 is scheduled for 31 March 2020.
