
Annual inflation up to 2.2% in the euro area

Up to 2.5% in the EU

The **euro area** annual inflation rate was 2.2% in July 2021, up from 1.9% in June. A year earlier, the rate was 0.4%. **European Union** annual inflation was 2.5% in July 2021, up from 2.2% in June. A year earlier, the rate was 0.9%. These figures are published by **Eurostat**, **the statistical office of the European Union**.

The lowest annual rates were registered in **Malta** (0.3%), **Greece** (0.7%) and **Italy** (1.0%). The highest annual rates were recorded in **Estonia** (4.9%), **Poland** and **Hungary** (both 4.7%). Compared with June, annual inflation fell in nine Member States, remained stable in two and rose in sixteen.


In July, the highest contribution to the annual **euro area** inflation rate came from energy (+1.34 percentage points, pp), followed by food, alcohol & tobacco (+0.35 pp), services (+0.31 pp) and non-energy industrial goods (+0.17 pp).

Geographical information

The **euro area** consists of Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

The euro area and European Union data refer to the respective country compositions at a specific point in time. Changes in the composition of these aggregates are incorporated using a chain index formula. For more information on this, please read <u>this note</u>.

Methods and definitions

Annual inflation is the change of the price level of consumer goods and services between the current month and the same month of the previous year. **Monthly inflation** is the change of the price level between the current month and the previous month.

A **contribution** shows how much of the annual inflation rate comes from a particular component of the HICP. The contributions are calculated according to a method which ensures their additivity (allowing for rounding).

Data collection for HICP has been affected by the COVID-19 crisis in all countries. Eurostat and the Member States' national statistical institutes have agreed a set of procedures to estimate prices that could not be collected due to mobility restrictions or closures of outlets. All information about these procedures is available on the Eurostat website section on inflation.

Revisions and timetable

A flash estimate of euro area inflation is issued at the end of each reference month. The euro area <u>flash estimate for July 2021</u>, published on 30 July 2021, was 2.2%.

The next flash estimate of euro area inflation with data for August 2021 is scheduled for 31 August 2021.
