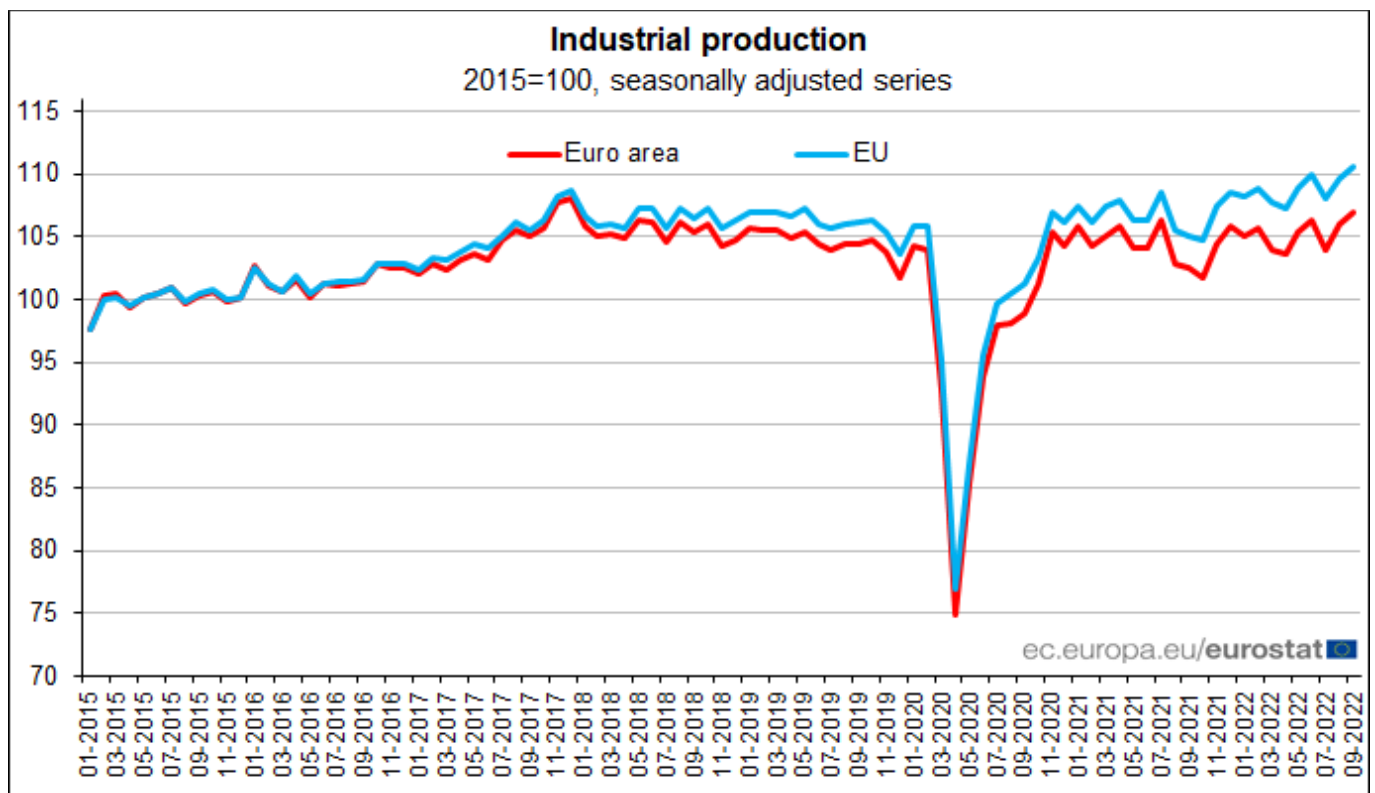
September 2022 compared with August 2022

## Industrial production up by 0.9% in both the euro area and the EU

Up by 4.9% and 5.7% compared with September 2021

In September 2022, the seasonally adjusted industrial production rose by 0.9% in both the **euro area** and the **EU**, compared with August 2022, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In August 2022, industrial production increased by 2.0% in the **euro area** and by 1.5% in the **EU**.

In September 2022 compared with September 2021, industrial production increased by 4.9% in the **euro area** and by 5.7% in the **EU**.



## Monthly comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

In the **euro area** in September 2022, compared with August 2022, production of non-durable consumer goods rose by 3.6% and capital goods by 1.5%, while production of intermediate goods as well as durable consumer goods fell by 0.9% and energy by 1.1%.

In the **EU**, production of non-durable consumer goods rose by 3.1% and capital goods by 1.7%, while production of intermediate goods as well as durable consumer goods fell by 0.6% and energy by 2.0%.

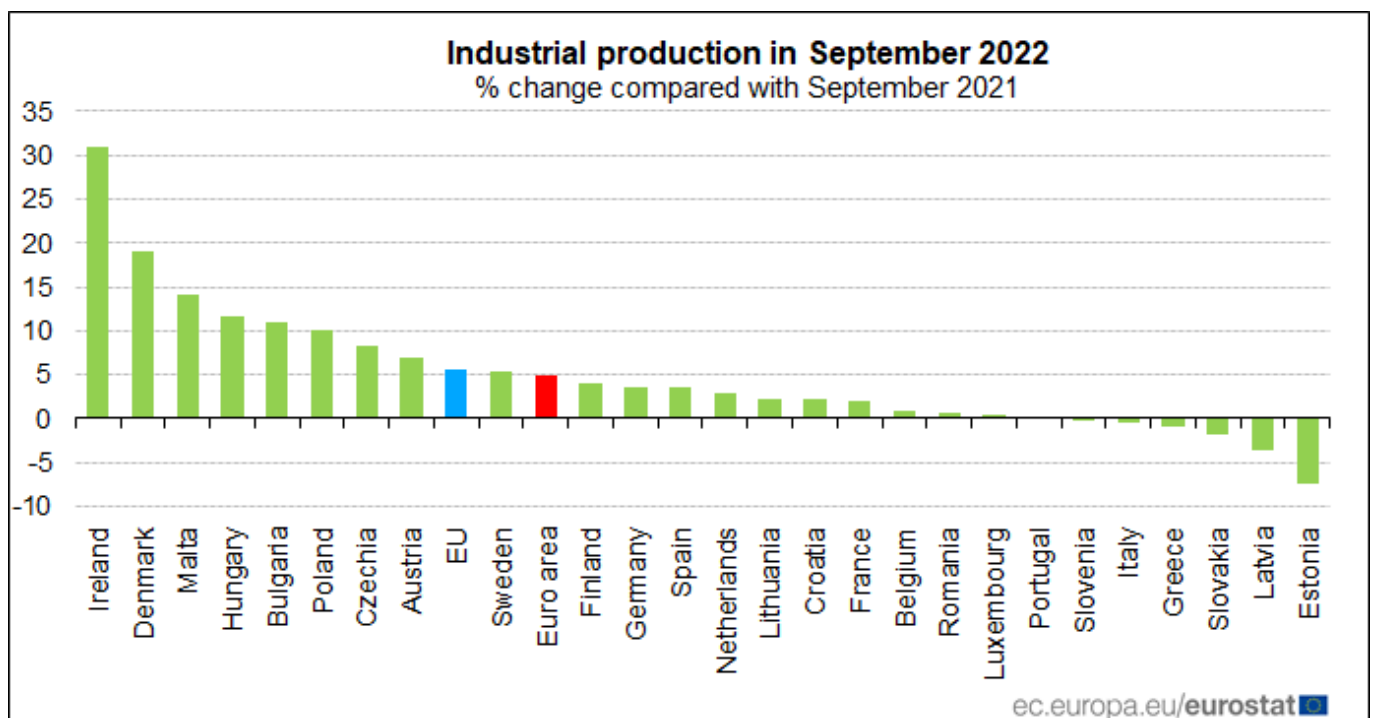
Among Member States for which data are available, the highest monthly increases were registered in **Ireland** (+11.9%), **Belgium** (+7.1%) as well as in **Hungary** and the **Netherlands** (both +1.6%). The largest decreases were observed in **Lithuania** (-8.2%), **Greece** (-4.5%) and **Estonia** (-3.6%).

## Annual comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

In the **euro area** in September 2022, compared with September 2021, production of capital goods rose by 13.5%, non-durable consumer goods by 5.7% and durable consumer goods by 3.6%, while production of intermediate goods fell by 2.1% and energy by 3.0%.

In the **EU**, production of capital goods rose by 14.3%, non-durable consumer goods by 8.4% and durable consumer goods by 1.8%, while production of intermediate goods fell by 1.4% and energy by 2.8%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest annual increases were registered in **Ireland** (+31.0%), **Denmark** (+19.0%) and **Malta** (+14.2%). The largest decreases were observed in **Estonia** (-7.5%), **Latvia** (-3.7%) and **Slovakia** (-1.9%).



## Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU27) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

Cyprus has a derogation with respect to Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 to have a longer deadline until the end of 2023.

## Methods and definitions

The **index of industrial production** measures the evolution of the volume of production for industry excluding construction, based on data adjusted for calendar and seasonal effects.

**Seasonally adjusted** euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data.

Total industry covers NACE rev.2 sections B to D. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

## Revisions and timetable

Compared with data issued in the News Release 114/2022 of 12 October 2022, the monthly percentage change for August 2022 has been revised from +1.5% to +2.0% in the euro area and from +1.1% to +1.5% in the EU. The annual percentage change has been revised from +2.5% to +2.8% in the euro area and from +3.5% to +3.8% in the EU.
