December 2022 compared with November 2022


Industrial production down by 1.1% in the euro area and by 0.4% in the EU

Down by 1.7% in the euro area and by 0.4% in the EU compared with December 2021

In December 2022, the seasonally adjusted industrial production fell by 1.1% in the **euro area** and by 0.4% in the **EU**, compared with November 2022, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In November 2022, industrial production increased by 1.4% in the **euro area** and by 1.2% in the **EU**.

In December 2022 compared with December 2021, industrial production decreased by 1.7% in the **euro area** and by 0.4% in the **EU**.

The annual average industrial production for the year 2022, compared with 2021, increased by 0.9% in the **euro area** and by 1.9% in the **EU**.



Monthly comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

In the **euro area** in December 2022, compared with November 2022, production of intermediate goods fell by 2.8%, durable consumer goods by 1.4%, non-durable consumer goods by 1.0% and capital goods by 0.4%, while production of energy grew by 1.3%.

In the **EU**, production of intermediate goods fell by 2.4%, durable consumer goods by 0.7% and capital goods by 0.3%, while production of non-durable consumer goods grew by 1.0% and energy by 1.3%.


Among Member States for which data are available, the largest monthly decreases were registered in **Ireland** (-8.5%), **Luxembourg** (-5.2%) and **Lithuania** (-4.0%). The highest increases were observed in **Denmark** (+13.5%), **Portugal** (+4.1%) and **Hungary** (+3.8%).

Annual comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

In the **euro area** in December 2022, compared with December 2021, production of energy fell by 9.3%, intermediate goods by 6.9% and durable consumer goods by 1.3%, while production of capital goods remained stable and production of non-durable consumer goods grew by 7.9%.

In the **EU**, production of energy fell by 9.5%, intermediate goods by 6.2% and durable consumer goods by 2.1%, while production of capital goods grew by 1.7% and of non-durable consumer goods by 11.1%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest annual decreases were registered in **Slovakia** (-13.1%), **Estonia** (-11.5%) and **Luxembourg** (-8.4%). The highest increases were observed in **Denmark** (+26.1%), **Malta** (+17.1%), **Hungary** and **Poland** (both +5.8%).



Geographical information

Up to 31 December 2022, the **euro area (EA19)** included Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland. From 1 January 2023 the **euro area (EA20)** also includes Croatia.

The aggregate data series commented on in this News Release refer to the official composition of the euro area in the most recent month for which data is available. Thus, News Releases with data for months up to December 2022 comment on EA19 series, while Releases with data for January 2023 onwards will comment on EA20 series.

The **European Union (EU27)** includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

Cyprus has a derogation with respect to Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 to have a longer deadline until the end of 2023.

Methods and definitions

The **index of industrial production** measures the evolution of the volume of production for industry excluding construction, based on data adjusted for calendar and seasonal effects.

Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data.

Total industry covers NACE rev.2 sections B to D. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

Revisions and timetable

Compared with data issued in the News Release 8/2023 of 13 January 2023, the monthly percentage change for November 2022 has been revised from +1.0% to +1.4% in the euro area and from +0.9% to 1.2% in the EU. The annual percentage change has been revised from +2.0% to +2.8% in the euro area and from 2.0% to +2.7% in the EU.
