
May 2023 compared with April 2023

Production in construction up by 0.2% in both the euro area and the EU

Up by 0.1% in the euro area and down by 0.4% in the EU compared with May 2022

In May 2023 compared with April 2023, seasonally adjusted production in the construction sector increased by 0.2% in both the **euro area** and in the **EU**, according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In April 2023, production in construction fell by 0.6% in the **euro area** and by 0.8% in the **EU**.

In May 2023 compared with May 2022, production in construction increased by 0.1% in the **euro area** and decreased by 0.4% in the **EU**.



Monthly comparison by construction sector and by Member State

In the **euro area** in May 2023, compared with April 2023, building construction increased by 0.4% and civil engineering by 0.1%.

In the **EU**, civil engineering increased by 0.4% and building construction by 0.2%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest monthly increases in production in construction were recorded in **Slovakia** (+5.5%), **Romania** and **Slovenia** (+3.7%) and the **Netherlands** (+3.6%). The largest decreases were observed in **Belgium** (-2.8%), **Austria** (-2.5%) and **Hungary** (-1.7%).

Annual comparison by construction sector and by Member State

In the **euro area** in May 2023, compared with May 2022, civil engineering increased by 2.7%, while building construction decreased by 0.3%.

In the **EU** civil engineering increased by 3.0%, while building construction decreased by 0.9%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest annual increases in production in construction were observed in **Slovenia** (+24.6%), **Romania** (+10.6%) and **Spain** (+7.1%). The largest decreases were recorded in **Hungary** (-12.0%), **Italy** (-6.5%) and **Sweden** (-6.3%).

Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA20) included Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU27) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

Estonia, Greece, Croatia, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg and Malta are not required to supply monthly data within 1 month and 15 days after the end of the reference month under Regulation (EU) 2019/2152. Ireland has a derogation to remain with quarterly frequency and Denmark to have a longer deadline until the end of 2023.

Methods and definitions

The **index of production in construction** approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering.

Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects.

The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

Revisions and timetable

Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release [71/2023](#) of 20 June 2023. The monthly percentage change for April 2023 was revised from -0.4% to -0.6% in the euro area and from -0.4% to -0.8% in the EU. The annual percentage change has been revised from +0.2% to +0.4% in the euro area and from -0.1% to 0.0% in the EU.
