
August 2023 compared with July 2023

Industrial production up by 0.6% in both the euro area and the EU

Down by 5.1% in the euro area and by 4.4% in the EU compared with August 2022

In August 2023, the seasonally adjusted industrial production increased by 0.6% in both the **euro area** and the **EU**, compared with July 2023, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In July 2023, industrial production decreased by 1.3% in both the **euro area** and the **EU**.

In August 2023 compared with August 2022, industrial production decreased by 5.1% in the **euro area** and by 4.4% in the **EU**.



Monthly comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

In the **euro area** in August 2023, compared with July 2023, production of durable consumer goods grew by 1.2%, non-durable consumer goods by 0.5% and capital goods by 0.3%, while production of intermediate goods fell by 0.3% and energy by 0.9%.

In the **EU**, production of durable consumer goods grew by 1.2%, non-durable consumer goods by 0.7% and capital goods by 0.1%, while production of intermediate goods fell by 0.2% and energy by 0.5%.


Among Member States for which data are available, the highest monthly increases were registered in **Ireland** (+6.1%), **Slovakia** (+4.5%) and **Lithuania** (+3.7%). The largest decreases were observed in **Hungary** (-2.4%), **Croatia** (-2.2%) and **Belgium** (-1.8%).

Annual comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

In the **euro area** in August 2023, compared with August 2022, production of durable consumer goods fell by 7.2%, capital goods by 7.0%, energy by 6.3%, intermediate goods by 5.2% and non-durable consumer goods by 1.4%.

In the **EU**, production of durable consumer goods fell by 7.3%, energy by 6.7%, intermediate goods by 5.5%, capital goods by 5.2%, while production of non-durable consumer remained stable.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest annual decreases were registered in **Ireland** (-27.3%), **Slovenia** (-12.3%) and **Estonia** (-11.9%). The highest increases were observed in **Slovakia** (+4.7%), **Denmark** (+3.5%) and **Malta** (+3.0%).



Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA20) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU27) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

Cyprus has a derogation with respect to Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 to have a longer deadline until the end of 2023.

Methods and definitions

The **index of industrial production** measures the evolution of the volume of production for industry excluding construction, based on data adjusted for calendar and seasonal effects.

Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data.

Total industry covers NACE rev.2 sections B to D. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

Revisions and timetable

Compared with data issued in the News Release 101/2023 of 13 September 2023, the monthly percentage change for July 2023 has been revised from -1.1% to -1.3% in both the euro area and the EU. The annual percentage decrease remained unchanged at -2.2% in the euro area and has been revised from -2.4% to -2.3% in the EU.
