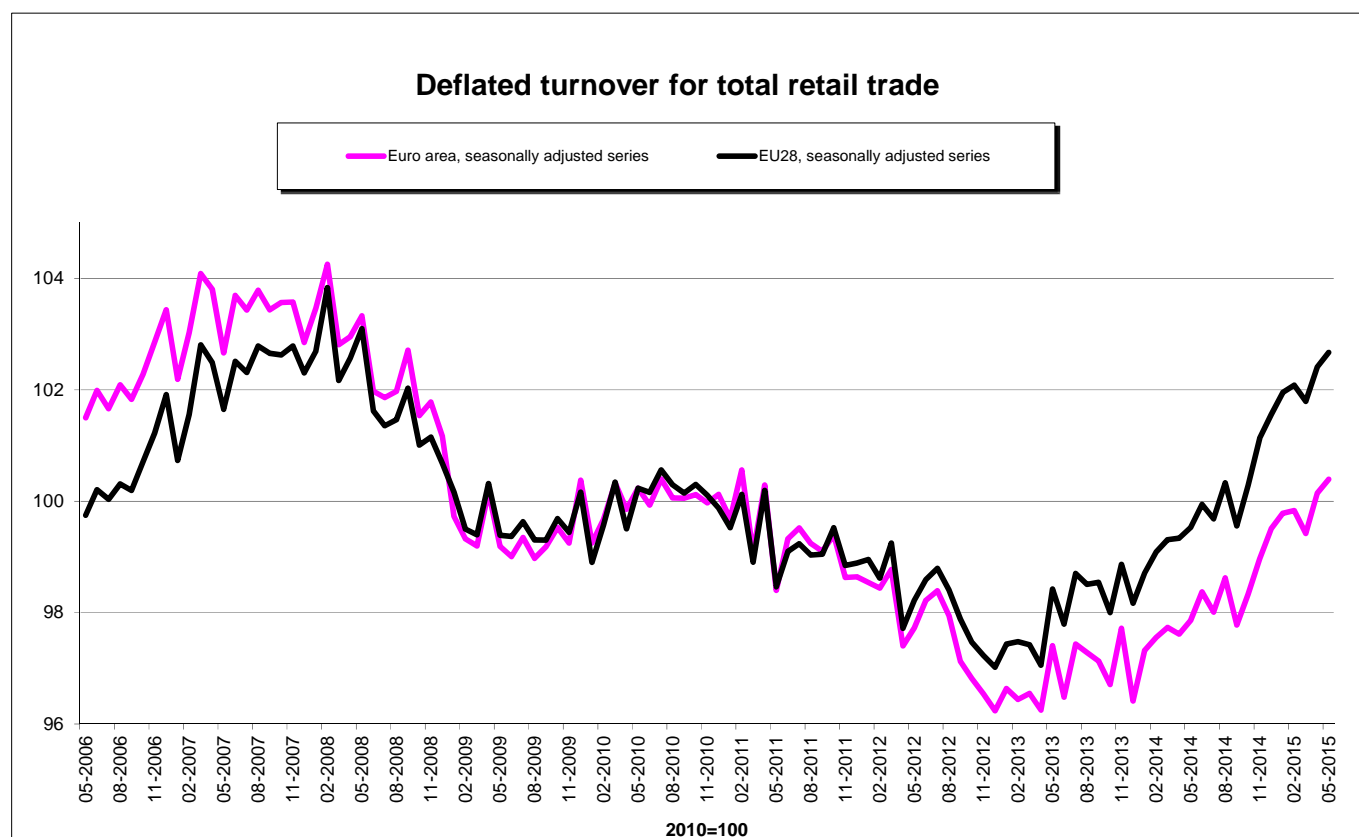
May 2015 compared with April 2015

## Volume of retail trade up by 0.2% in euro area

Up by 0.3% in EU28

In May 2015 compared with April 2015, the seasonally adjusted volume of retail trade<sup>1</sup> rose by 0.2% in the **euro area**<sup>2</sup> (EA19) and by 0.3% in the **EU28**<sup>2</sup>, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In April<sup>3</sup> retail trade increased by 0.7% and 0.6% respectively.

In May 2015 compared with May 2014<sup>4</sup> the retail sales index increased by 2.4% in the **euro area** and by 3.0% in the **EU28**.



## Monthly comparison by retail sector and by Member State

The 0.2% increase in the volume of retail trade in the **euro area** in May 2015, compared with April 2015, is due to rises of 0.4% for both "Food, drinks and tobacco" and non-food products, while automotive fuel fell by 0.7%. In the **EU28**, the 0.3% increase in the retail trade volume is due to rises of 0.4% for "Food, drinks and tobacco" and of 0.3% for non-food products, while automotive fuel fell by 0.6%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest increases in total retail trade were registered in **Poland** (+1.5%), **Estonia** (+1.4%) and **Malta** (+1.1%), while the largest decreases were observed in **Ireland** (-2.5%), **Denmark** (-1.4%) and **Lithuania** (-1.2%).

## Annual comparison by retail sector and by Member State

The 2.4% increase in the volume of retail trade in the **euro area** in May 2015, compared with May 2014, is due to rises of 3.4% for non-food products, of 1.7% for "Food, drinks and tobacco" and of 0.7% for automotive fuel. In the **EU28**, the 3.0% increase in retail trade volume is due to rises of 4.2% for non-food products, of 2.0% for "Food, drinks and tobacco" and of 1.3% for automotive fuel.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest increases in total retail trade were observed in **Poland** (+7.6%), **Estonia** (+5.7%) and **Ireland** (+5.6%), while decreases were observed in **Luxembourg** (-10.6%), **Denmark** (-2.4%) and **Belgium** (-1.5%).


1. The index of the volume of retail trade measures the evolution of the turnover in retail trade, adjusted for price changes (deflated), i.e. the evolution of the total amount of goods sold, based on data adjusted for working day and seasonal effects. Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

2. The euro area (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.  
The European Union (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.  
The tables also include Norway and Switzerland.
3. Data of previous months have been revised compared to those issued in the News Release 97/2015 of 3 June 2015. The monthly percentage changes for April 2015 remain unchanged at +0.7% in the euro area and at +0.6% in the EU28. The annual percentage changes have been revised from +2.2% to +2.7% in the euro area and from +2.6% to +2.9% in the EU28.
