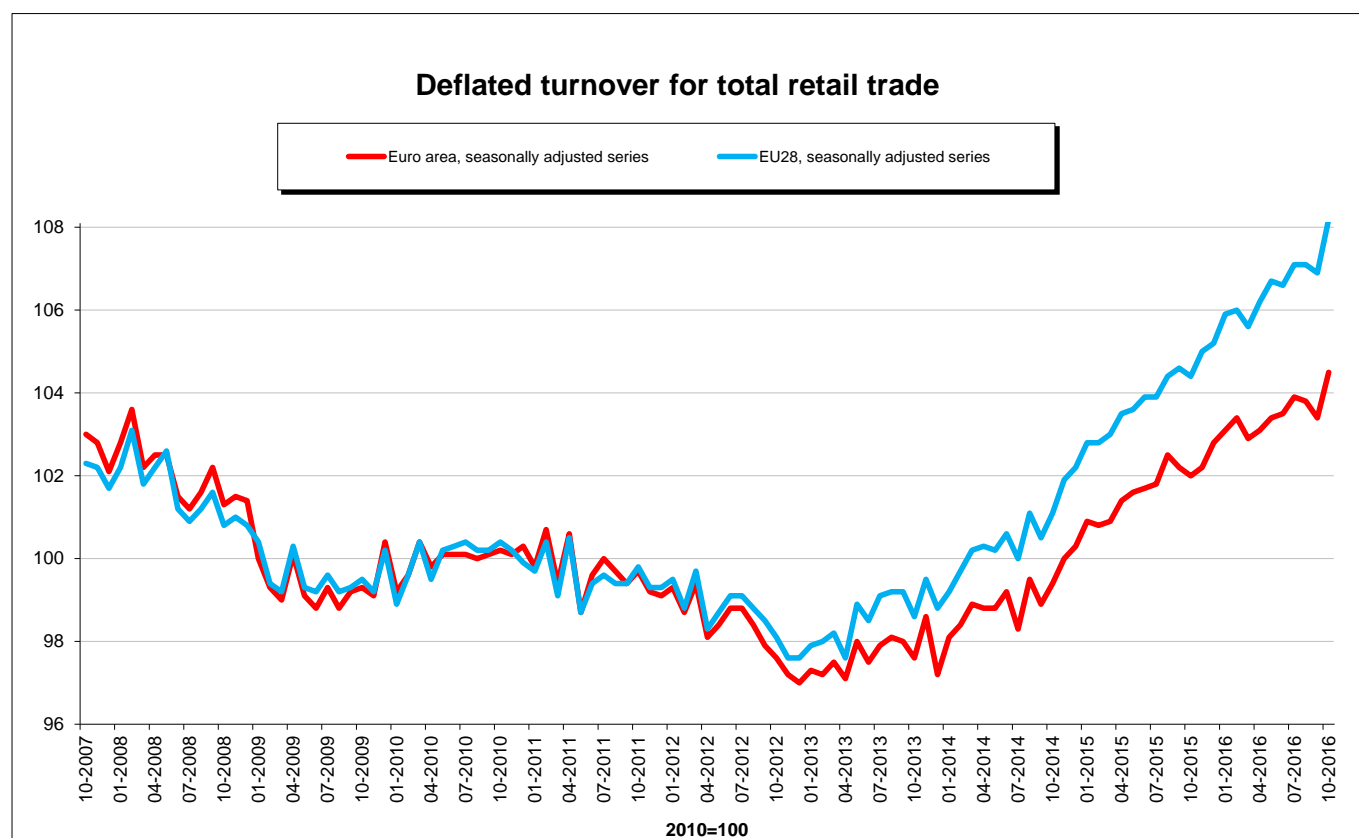
October 2016 compared with September 2016

**Volume of retail trade up by 1.1% in euro area**

Up by 1.2% in EU28

In October 2016 compared with September 2016, the seasonally adjusted volume of retail trade rose by 1.1% in the **euro area** (EA19) and by 1.2% in the **EU28**, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In September the retail trade volume decreased by 0.4% in the **euro area** and by 0.2% in the **EU28**.

In October 2016 compared with October 2015 the calendar adjusted retail sales index increased by 2.4% in the **euro area** and by 3.5% in the **EU28**.



## Monthly comparison by retail sector and by Member State

The 1.1% increase in the volume of retail trade in the **euro area** in October 2016, compared with September 2016, is due to rises of 2.3% for non-food products and of 0.2% for “Food, drinks and tobacco”, while automotive fuel fell by 1.0%. In the **EU28**, the 1.2% increase in the volume of retail trade is due to rises of 2.3% for non-food products and of 0.2% for “Food, drinks and tobacco”, while automotive fuel fell by 0.9%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest increases in the total retail trade volume were registered in **Slovenia** (+3.7%), **Luxembourg** (+2.9%), **Germany** (+2.4%) and the **United Kingdom** (+2.0%), while decreases were observed in **Malta** (-0.5%), **Ireland** (-0.4%), **Hungary** (-0.3%), **Slovakia** (-0.2%) and **Spain** (-0.1%).

## Annual comparison by retail sector and by Member State

The 2.4% increase in the volume of retail trade in the **euro area** in October 2016, compared with October 2015, is due to rises of 3.3% for non-food products, of 2.1% for “Food, drinks and tobacco” and of 0.7% for automotive fuel. In the **EU28**, the 3.5% increase in retail trade volume is due to rises of 4.9% for non-food products, of 2.5% for “Food, drinks and tobacco” and of 1.7% for automotive fuel.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest increases in the total retail trade volume were observed in **Luxembourg** (+16.0%), **Romania** and **Slovenia** (both +8.7%) and **Lithuania** (+8.3%), while a decrease was observed in **Belgium** (-1.9%).

### Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

### Methods and definitions

The **index of the volume of retail trade** measures the evolution of the turnover in retail trade, adjusted for price changes (deflated), i.e. the evolution of the total amount of goods sold, based on data adjusted for calendar and seasonal effects.

**Seasonally adjusted** euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects.

Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

### Revisions and timetable

Data of previous months have been revised compared to those issued in the News Release [219/2016](#) of 7 November 2016. The monthly percentage change for September 2016 has been revised from -0.2% to -0.4% in the euro area and remains unchanged at -0.2% in the EU28. The annual percentage changes have been revised from +1.1% to +1.0% in the euro area and from +2.2% to +2.0% in the EU28.
