



May 2019 compared with April 2019

## Industrial producer prices down by 0.1% in euro area Unchanged in EU28

In May 2019, compared with April 2019, industrial producer prices fell by 0.1% in the **euro area** (EA19) and remained unchanged in the **EU28**, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In April 2019, prices decreased by 0.3% in the **euro area** and remained unchanged in the **EU28**.

In May 2019, compared with May 2018, industrial producer prices rose by 1.6% in the **euro area** and by 1.9% in the **EU28**.



### Monthly comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

Industrial producer prices in the **euro area** in May 2019, compared with April 2019, fell by 0.6% in the energy sector and by 0.1% for intermediate goods, while prices rose by 0.1% for capital goods and durable consumer goods, and by 0.2% for non-durable consumer goods. Prices in total industry excluding energy remained unchanged.

In the **EU28**, industrial producer prices fell by 0.3% in the energy sector and by 0.1% for intermediate goods, while prices remained unchanged for durable consumer goods, rose by 0.1% for capital goods and by 0.2% for non-durable consumer goods. Prices in total industry excluding energy rose by 0.1%.

The largest decreases in industrial producer prices were recorded in **Luxembourg** (-1.0%), **Greece** (-0.8%), and **Latvia** (-0.6%), while the highest increases were observed in **Cyprus** (+2.4%), **Hungary** (+0.8%) and **Czechia** (+0.5%).

## Annual comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

Industrial producer prices in the **euro area** in May 2019, compared with May 2018, rose by 3.1% in the energy sector, by 1.6% for capital goods, by 1.4% for durable consumer goods, by 0.9% for non-durable consumer goods and by 0.8% for intermediate goods. Prices in total industry excluding energy rose by 1.0%.

In the **EU28**, industrial producer prices rose by 3.3% in the energy sector, by 1.6% for capital goods, by 1.3% for durable consumer goods, by 1.2% for non-durable consumer goods and by 1.1% for intermediate goods. Prices in total industry excluding energy rose by 1.3%.

Industrial producer prices rose in all Member States, with the highest increases in **Romania** (+5.9%), **Latvia** and **Hungary** (both +5.4%), and **Slovakia** (+4.1%).

### Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

### Methods and definitions

The **index of producer prices** shows (in the national currency of the country concerned) changes in the ex-works sale prices of all products sold on the domestic market, excluding imports. Euro area and EU indices refer to overall weighted price changes. The figures are not calendar day or seasonally adjusted.

Total industry covers NACE rev.2 sections B to D + E36.

### Revisions and timetable

Compared with data issued in the News Release 91/2019 of 5 June 2019, the monthly percentage change for April 2019 remains unchanged at -0.3% in the euro area and at 0.0% in the EU28. The annual percentage change remains unchanged at +2.6% in the euro area and at +2.9% in the EU28.
