
# Annual inflation up to 1.3% in the euro area

Stable at 1.6% in the EU

The **euro area** annual inflation rate was 1.3% in June 2019, up from 1.2% in May. A year earlier, the rate was 2.0%. **European Union** annual inflation was 1.6% in June 2019, stable compared to May. A year earlier, the rate was 2.1%. These figures are published by **Eurostat**, **the statistical office of the European Union**.

The lowest annual rates were registered in **Greece** (0.2%), **Cyprus** (0.3%), **Denmark** and **Croatia** (both 0.5%). The highest annual rates were recorded in **Romania** (3.9%), **Hungary** (3.4%) and **Latvia** (3.1%). Compared with May, annual inflation fell in seventeen Member States, remained stable in one and rose in nine.

In June, the highest contribution to the annual **euro area** inflation rate came from services (+0.73 percentage points, pp), followed by food, alcohol & tobacco (+0.30 pp), energy (+0.17 pp) and non-energy industrial goods (+0.07 pp).





#### Geographical information

The **euro area** consists of Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

The euro area and European Union data refer to the respective country compositions at a specific point in time. New Member States are integrated into the aggregates using a chain index formula.

Data for the United Kingdom for June 2019 were not available in time for publication. Due to this fact, the EU totals have been calculated using Eurostat estimates.

#### Methods and definitions

The **annual rate** measures the change of the harmonised indices of consumer prices (HICP) between a month and the same month of the previous year, and the **monthly rate** compares the indices between the two latest months.

A **contribution** shows how much of the annual inflation rate comes from a particular component of the HICP. The contributions are calculated according to a method which ensures their additivity (allowing for rounding).

#### Revisions and timetable

A flash estimate of euro area inflation is issued at the end of each reference month. The euro area <u>flash estimate for June 2019</u>, published on 28 June 2019, was 1.2%.

The next flash estimate of euro area inflation with data for July 2019 is scheduled for 31 July 2019.
