


Figure 1: Gross domestic product (GDP) per capita 2001 - level 2

According to the most recent estimates for the year 2001, per capita gross domestic product (GDP) in purchasing power standards (PPS) in 50 of the 55 level 2 regions of the Candidate Countries was below 75 % of an average figure grouping the 15 EU Member States and the 10 Acceding Countries (ACC)⁽¹⁾. Per capita GDP ranged from 4 088 PPS (19 % of this average) for the Romanian region of Nord-Est to 31 639 PPS (149 % of this average) for Praha in the Czech Republic.

(1) ACC (Acceding Countries) are the Czech Republic, Estonia, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Hungary, Malta, Poland, Slovenia and Slovakia.

Major differences in per capita GDP between regions and within countries

Table 1 gives an overview of the regions at level 2 with the highest and the lowest per capita GDP. Five regions recorded a per capita GDP of more than 75 % of the EU15+ACC average in 2001, and for 12 regions the figure was between 50 % and 75 %. 23 regions had a per capita GDP between one third and half of the average, and 15 regions, among them most of Bulgaria's and Romania's regions, remained below one third of the average.

Although the same five regions topped the rankings as in 2000, Közép-Magyarország, the capital region of Hungary, overtook Cyprus and moved from 4th to 3rd place.

GDP per capita (in PPS) ranged between 19 % of the EU15+ACC average in Nord-Est (RO) and 149 % of the average in Praha (CZ). This means that the figures for the regions with the lowest and highest per capita GDP differed by a factor of almost eight, whereas among the EU15 Member States this factor is around five.

In five out of the six countries with level 2 regions, the highest regional per capita GDP for 2001 was more than double the lowest. Differences were particularly high in Slovakia (Bratislavský: 112 % of the EU15+ACC average; Východné Slovensko: 37 %) and Romania (Bucuresti: 57 %; Nord-Est: 19 %). On the other hand, regional divergences are relatively moderate in Bulgaria (Yugozapaden: 40 %; Yuzhen Tsentralen: 24 %).

Divergences between regions within a Candidate Country range from a factor of 3.0 to 1.6, whereas among the EU15 Member States they range from 4.4 to 1.6.

For Turkey regional data are not yet available. Therefore the national figures are given.

➤ ESSENTIAL INFORMATION – METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

1. Data revisions: Please note that, compared to the last publication and to the Eurostat news release 21/2004 of 18 February 2004, data for 1995 to 2001 have been revised. This publication does not take account of any data delivered to Eurostat later than 27 February, 2004.

2. Harmonised estimation procedure: At the level 2 regional breakdown considered in this publication, there are 55 regions in the Candidate Countries (excluding Turkey). For Turkey, regional data are not yet available; therefore, the attached table quotes only the national figure. More data are available on request for a level 3 breakdown. National GDP data were provided by the national statistical offices in accordance with the rules of the European System of Accounts (ESA95). National figures are divided up between the regions according to the respective regional shares of gross value added at basic prices, this being the concept applied by ESA95.

Estimates of GDP are based on the structure of gross value added (GVA). GVA figures are used without correction for financial intermediation services indirectly measured (FISIM). Extra-regio GVA was allocated proportionally to the regions of a country. The conversion to PPS is based on national purchasing power parities. In December 2003, Purchasing Power Parities (PPP) were revised for all periods as from 1995 (see Statistics in Focus Theme 2 no. 64/2003 of 18 December 2003).

3. Interpreting the data: GDP and per capita GDP, are indicators of the output of a country or region and are thus a way of measuring and comparing the degree of economic development of countries or regions. However, GDP is not synonymous with the income ultimately available to private households resident in a country or region.

In addition, commuter flows hinder comparisons between countries – and particularly regions – in terms of per capita GDP. In such cases, the majority of which are major cities, net commuter arrivals generally mean that production in these regions is higher than would be possible with the resident population. Consequently, per capita GDP tends to overstate productivity in these regions and to underestimate it in the regions where the commuters live. Per capita GDP is also affected by population structure.
