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Structure of agricultural holdings

The Netherlands 2003

A farm structure survey was carried out in all EU Member States in 2003 (2002 in Poland). The detailed results are now available for 11 Member States: Belgium, Denmark, Ireland, Latvia, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom. Results for the other Member States will become available in the course of the next months. This Statistics in Focus is part of a series of country-specific publications, all following the same structure.

In the Netherlands, in the spring 2003 there were about 85 400* agricultural holdings, which means 16% decline compared to 2000.


- These holdings employed 185 800 AWUs (annual work units), the equivalent of 185 800 persons working full time;
- they made use of 2 million ha of agricultural area, which is on average 23.5 hectare per holding (compared to 20 ha in 2000).


Amongst these 85 400 agricultural holdings,

- 23% made use of less than one AWU, while 36% made use of 2 or more AWUs:
- 30% used less than 5 ha, while 2% used more than 100 ha;
- 10% were mixed holdings, while 90% were specialised: dairies 26%, sheep, goat and mixed grazing livestock 22%, field cropping 13%, horticulture 13% (of which 60% under glass), pigs and poultry 7%, permanent crops 5%, cattle fattening and rearing 3%, cereals, oil seed and protein crops 1%;
- about 1% practised organic farming.

Amongst the 81 900 sole holders

- 7% were women;
- 42% were aged 55 or more;
- 13% had another gainful activity as major occupation.






>METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

The survey on the structure of agricultural holdings in The Netherlands was carried out in the spring 2003 on an exhaustive base. Such full-scale agricultural censuses have been conducted on an annual basis since 1934. The reference time of the FSS 2003 was 1 April 2003. However for characteristics that cannot be determined on this date the situation for later in 2003 or the whole year was taken into account.

The target population was all the farms registered in the National Farm Register, which is updated continuously. For the census all holdings above 3 NGE (Nederlandse Grootte Eenheid) are selected (97 thousand farms in 2003). [The NGE is the Dutch equivalent of the ESU, but due to the differences in inflation levels 1 NGE is 1375 euros in the concerning year.] For certain characteristics (e.g. environmental aspects, less-favoured and set-aside areas) administrative sources and Geographic Information System have been used.

The data are multi-level checked; 99% of the questionnaires have been returned completed. Partly completed forms and errors have been corrected via phone-calls.

For each activity ('enterprise') on a farm (for instance wheat, dairy cow or vineyard), a **standard gross margin (SGM)** is estimated, based on the area (or the number of heads) and a regional coefficient. The sum of such margins in a farm is its **economic size**, expressed in **European Size Units (ESU)**. 1 ESU is equal to 1200 euros.

Due to differences in the coverage of units of less than 1 ESU across Member States, these data are not comparable between countries. That is why the present analysis and graphs focus on the holdings of at least one ESU.

Each farm is classified in the community typology by its economic size and its **type of farming**, depending on the share of each enterprise in its economic size. For instance, a farm where breeding sows account for more than 2/3 of the economic size is classified as *specialist pig rearing* (type 5011). Depending on the level of aggregation, farms are grouped into 8 to 70 types.

Annual working unit (AWU) means the labour force working yearly like a worker employed on full time basis, it is 1800 hours (225 working days of 8 working hours per day).
