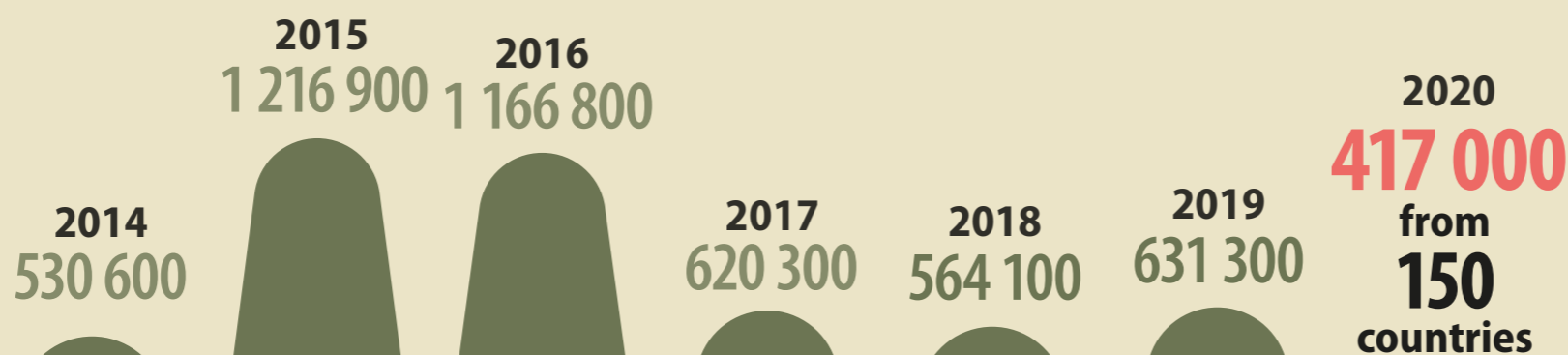


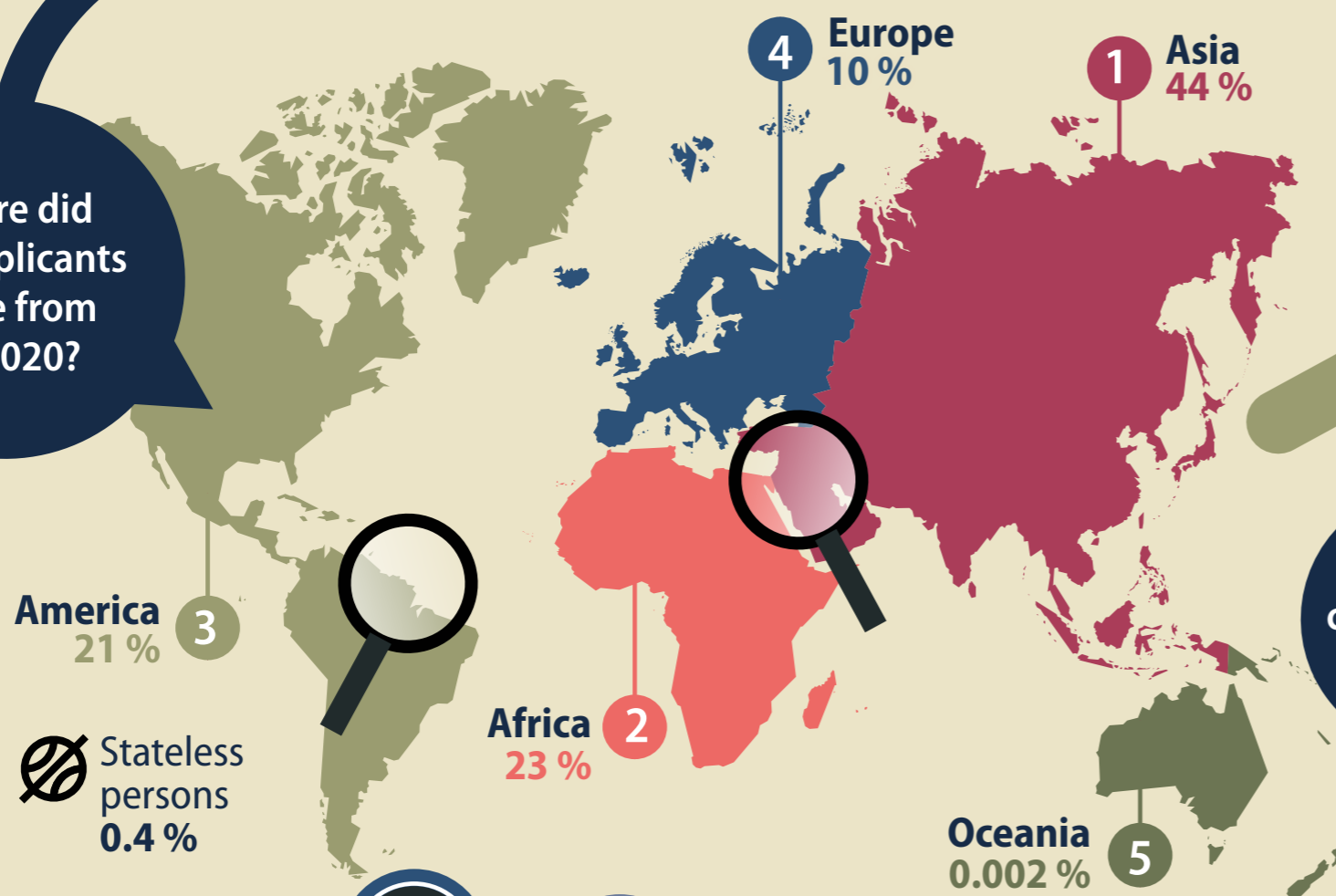

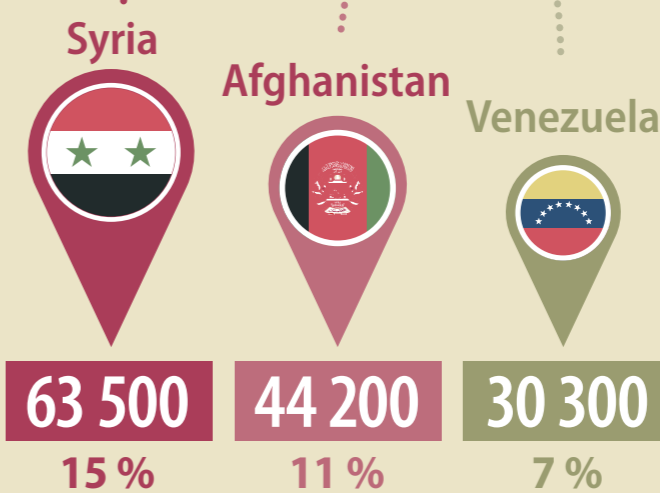
First-time asylum applicants, 2014-2020



Where did the applicants come from in 2020?

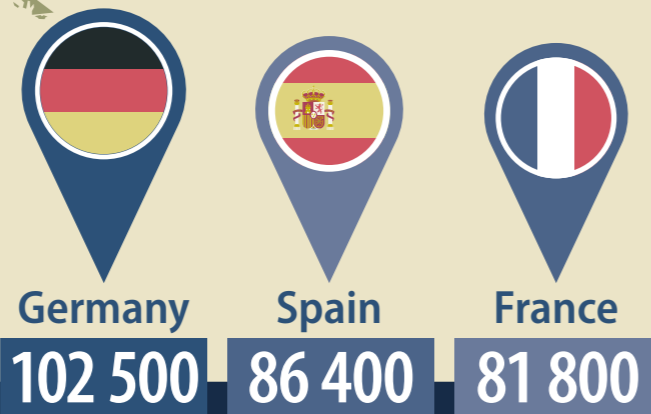


Main 3 countries of citizenship

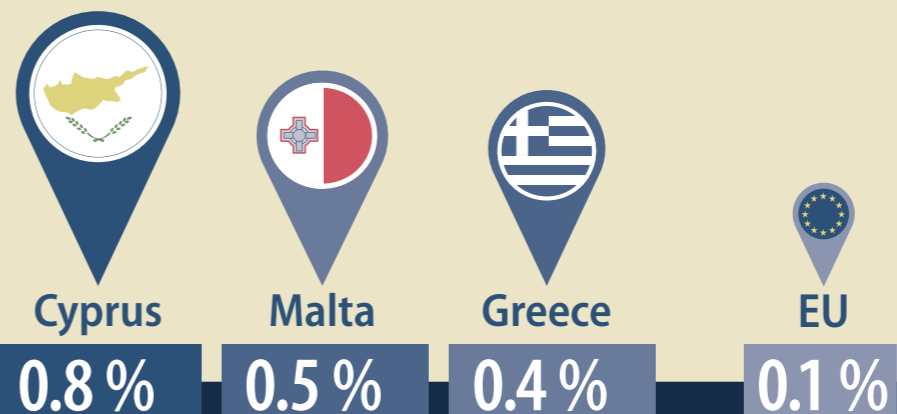


And where did they go to?

Main 3 receiving countries by number of applicants

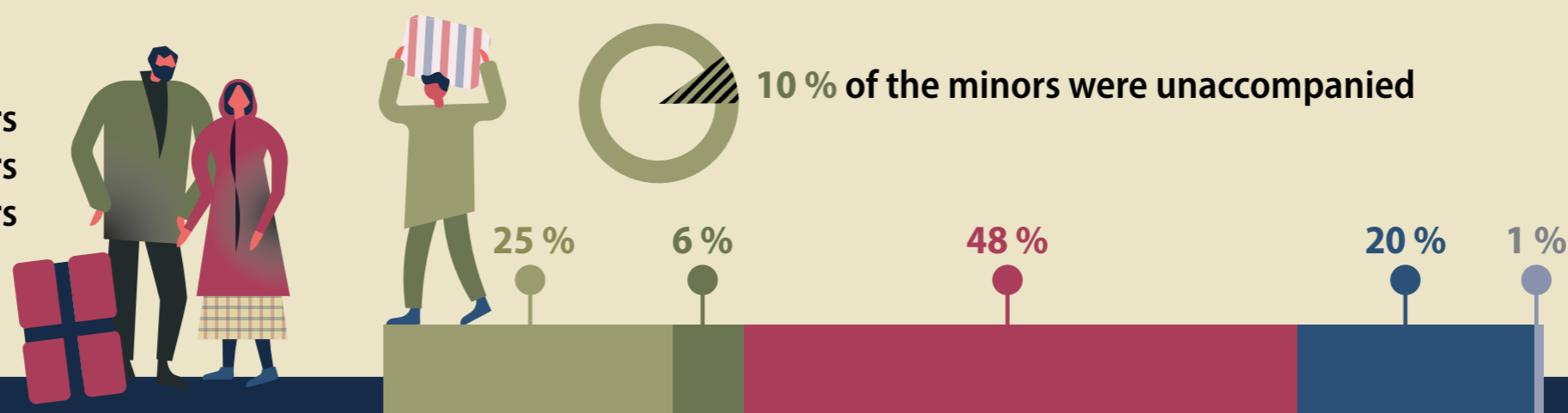


Main 3 receiving countries by share of country's population

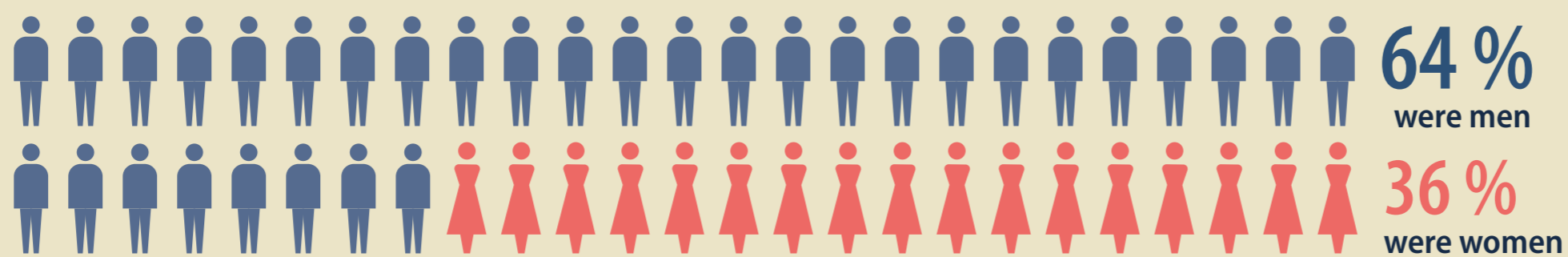

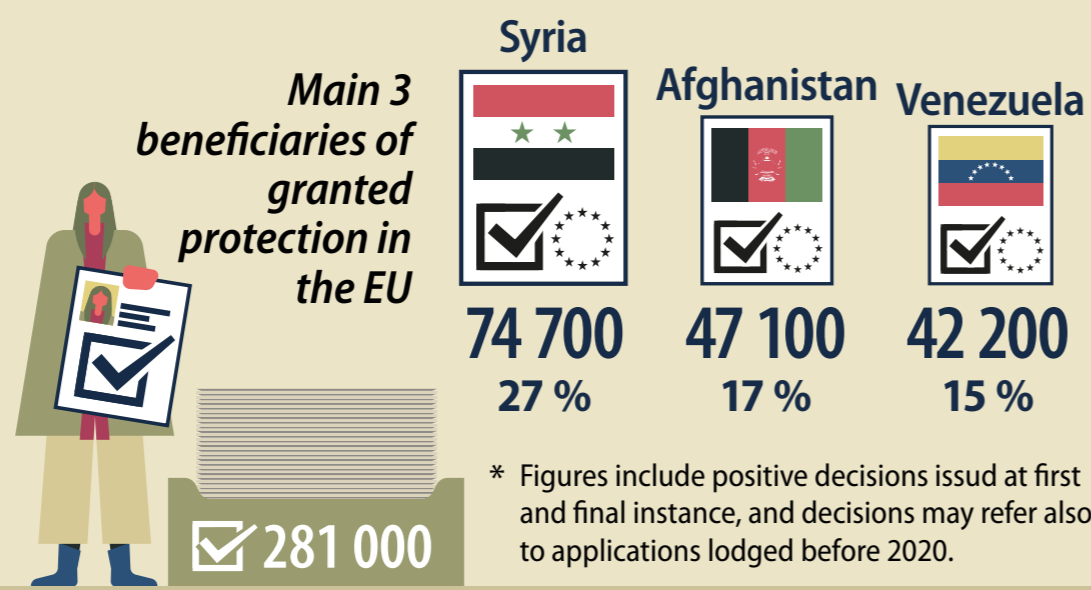
