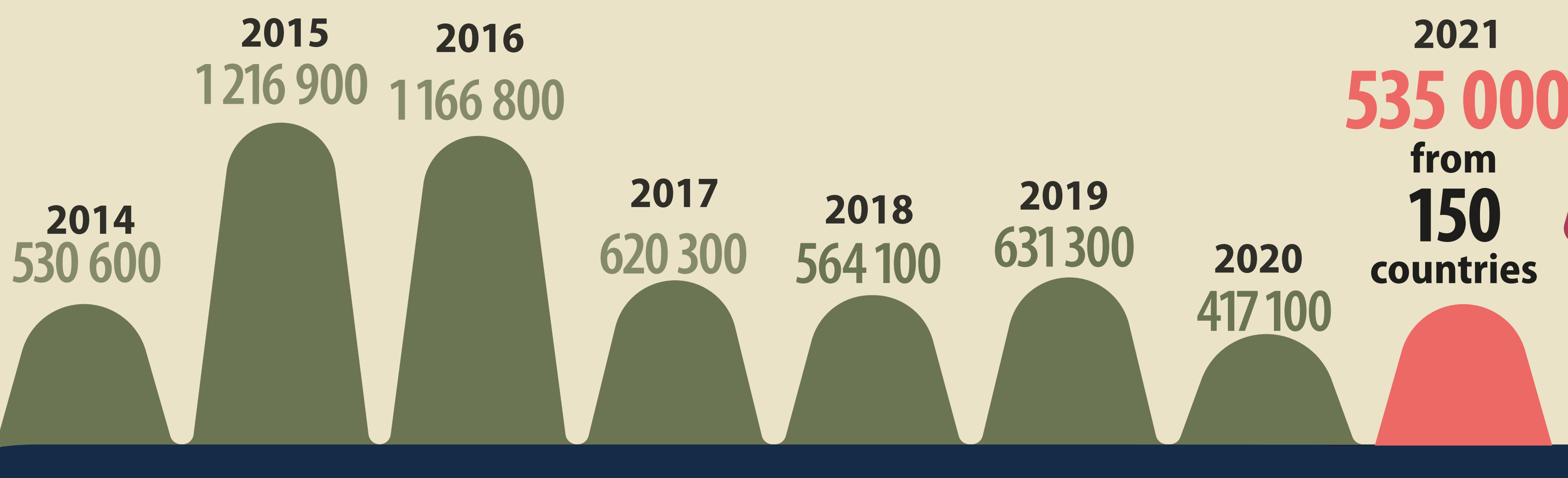


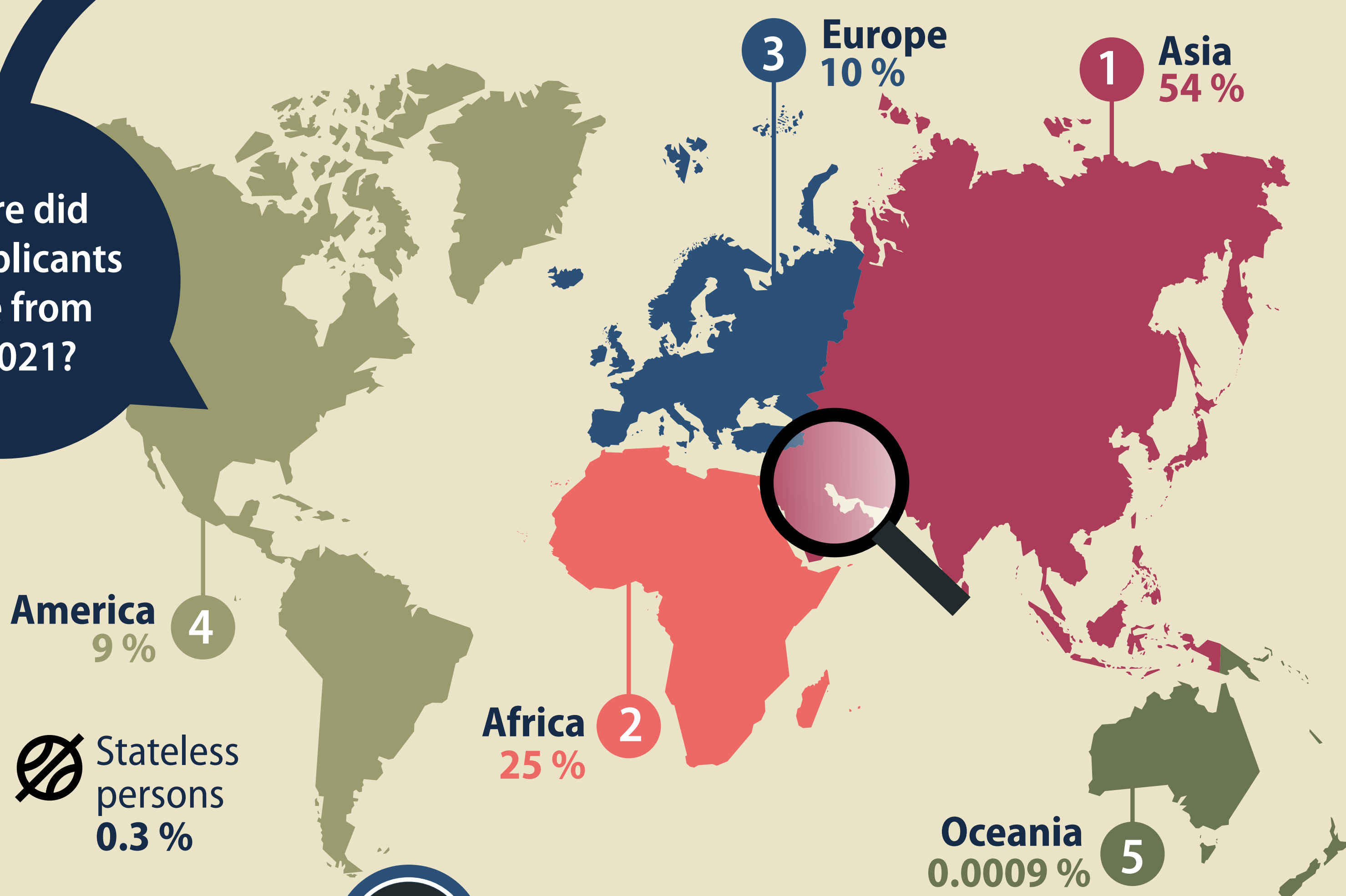

Where did the applicants come from in 2021?

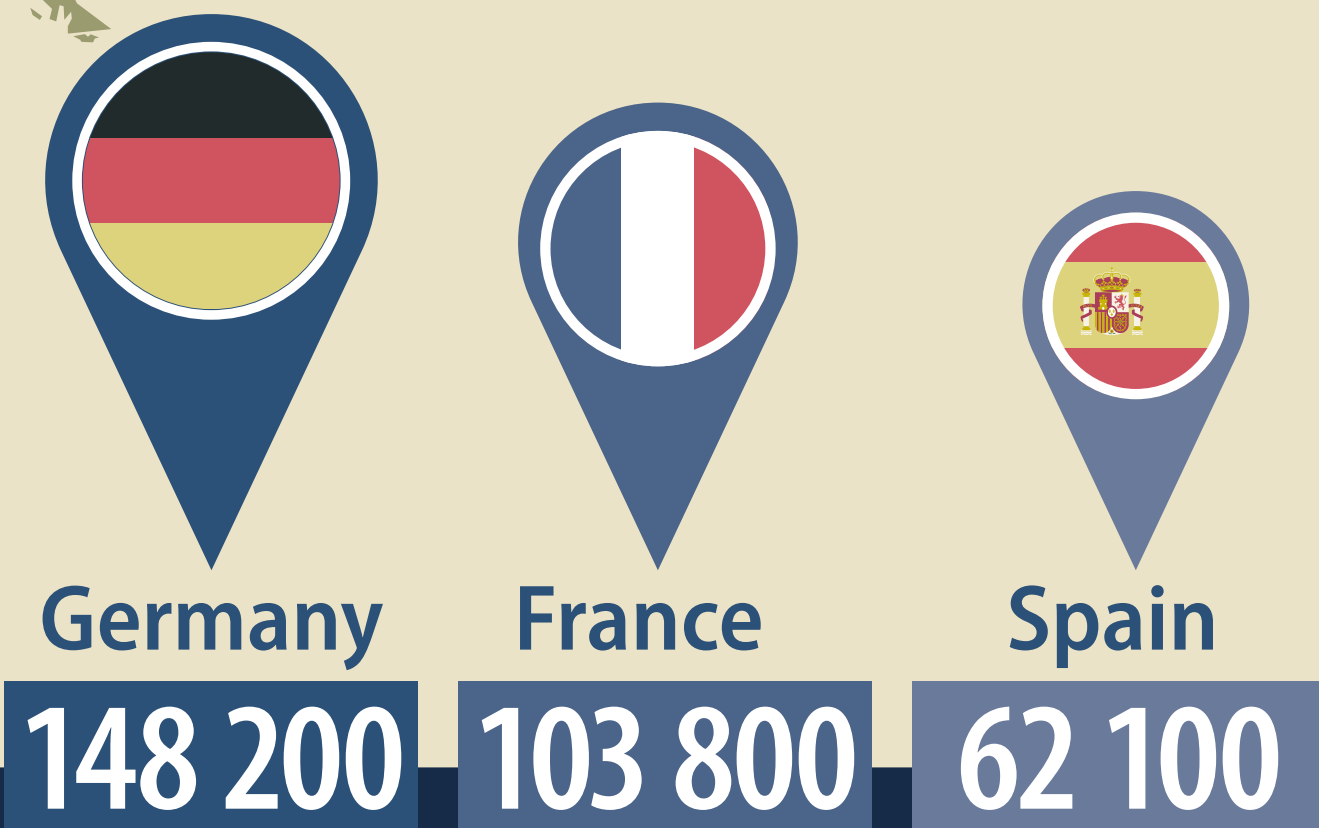


Main 3 countries of citizenship

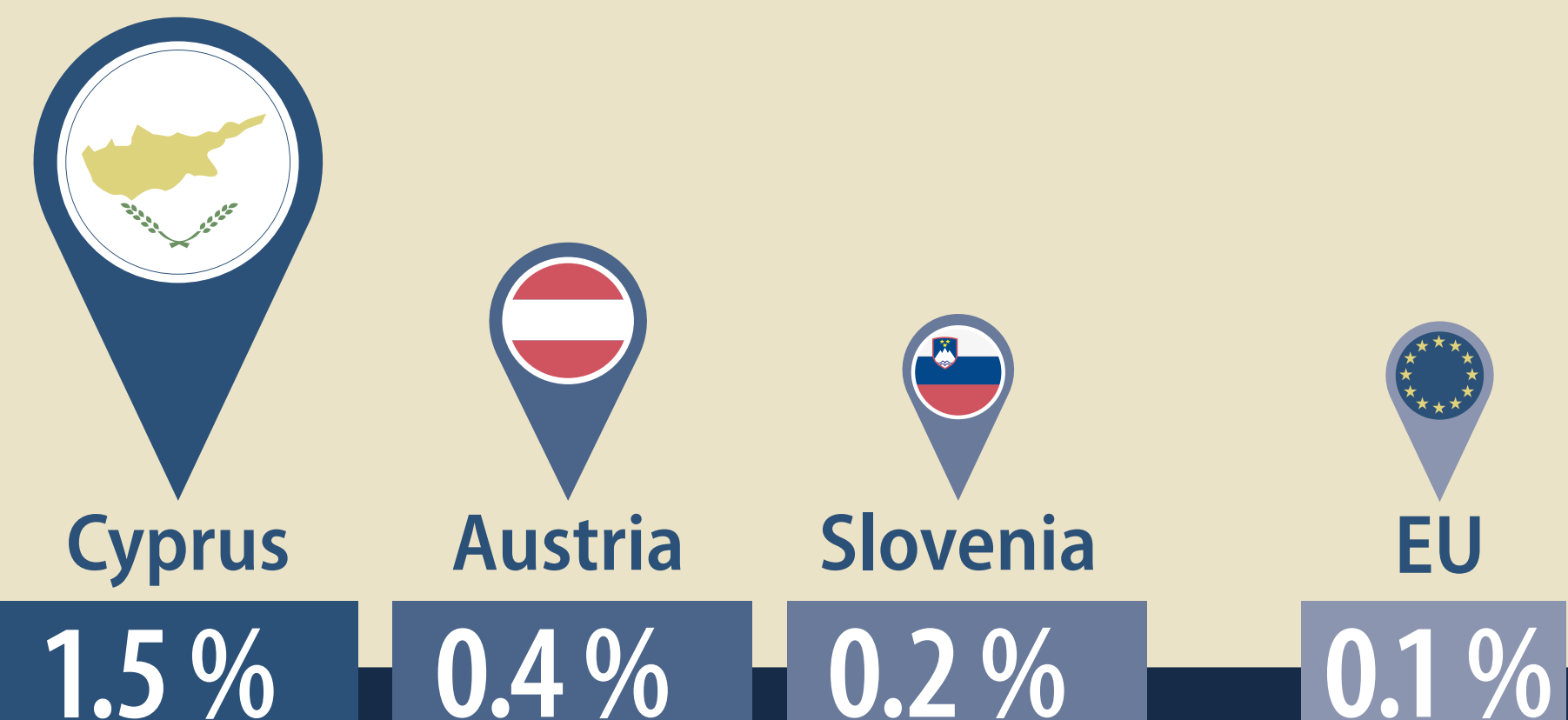


And where did they go to?

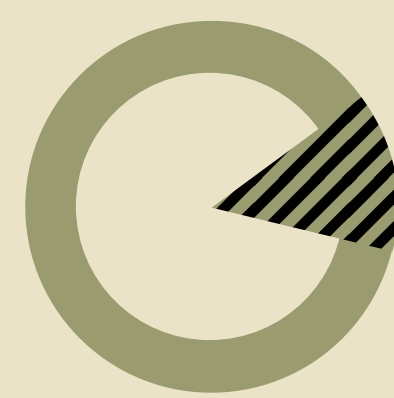
Main 3 receiving countries by number of applicants



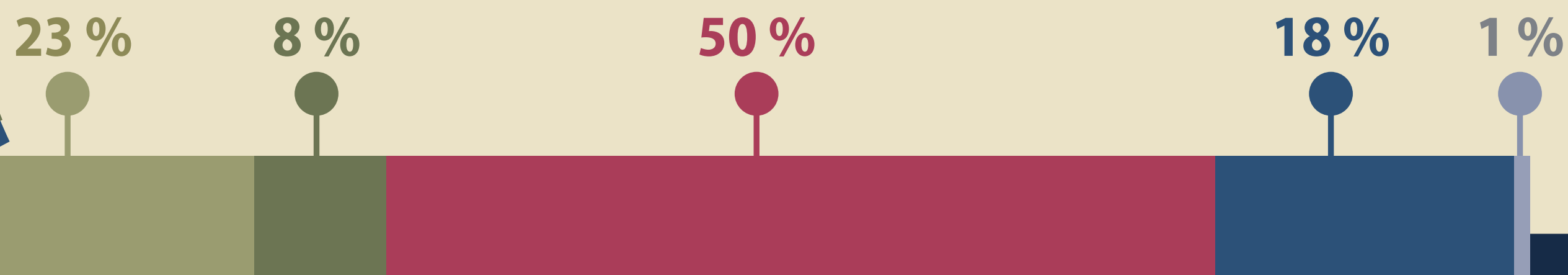
Main 3 receiving countries by share of country's population



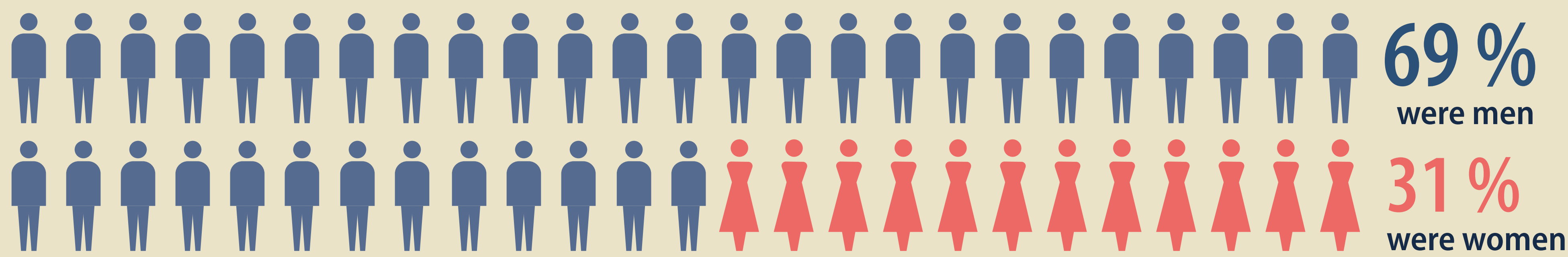

- 65 or over



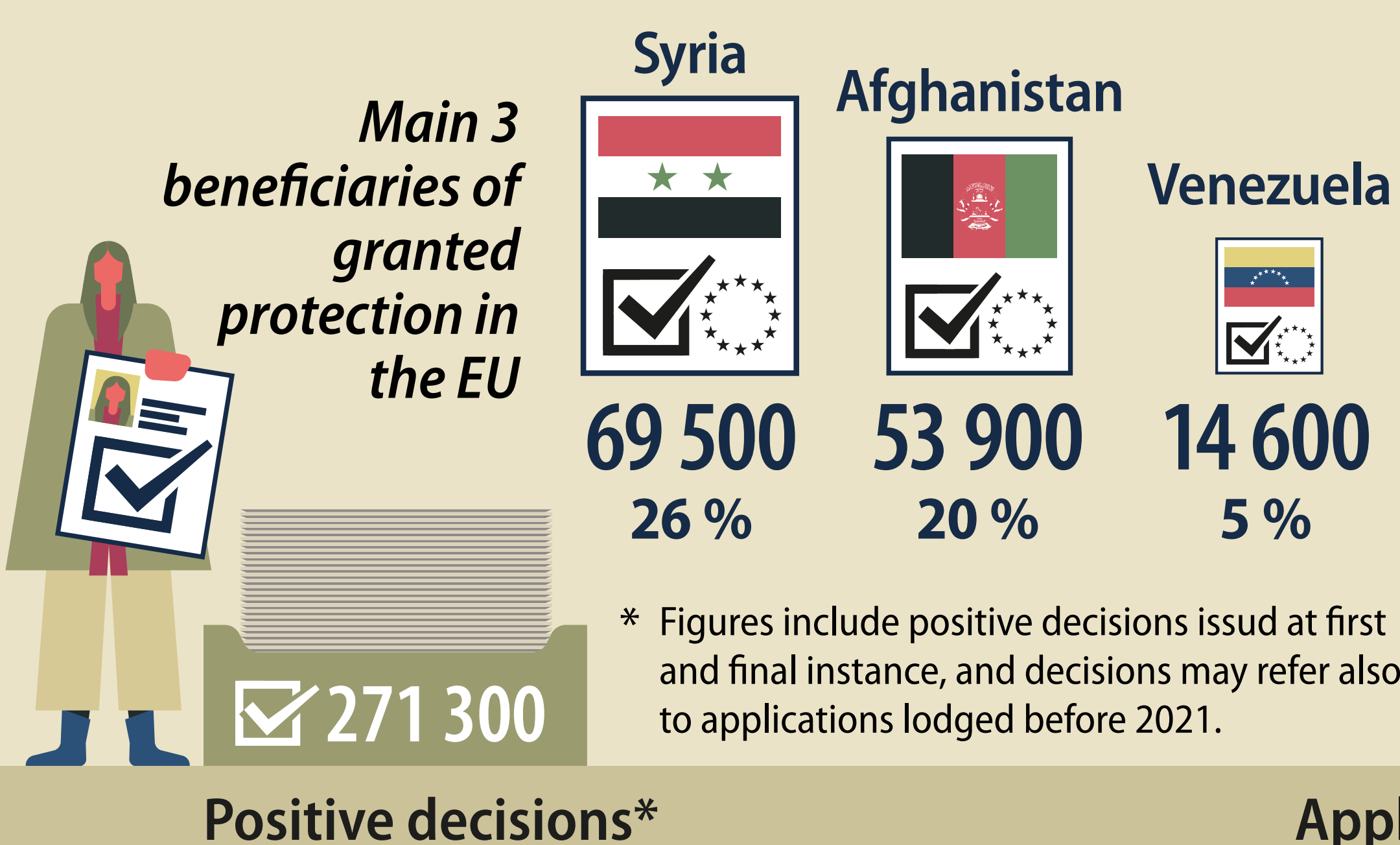
14% of the minors were unaccompanied



Who were the people asking for asylum?

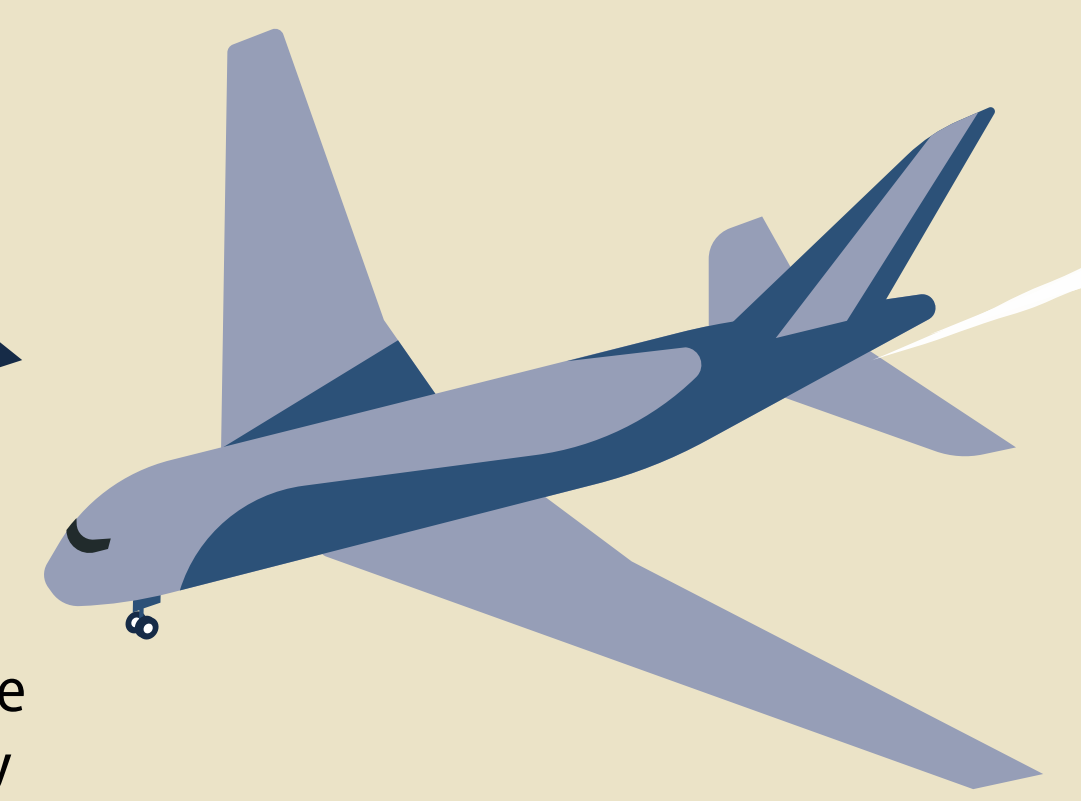
