Introduction

Basic figures on European Neighbourhood Policy-South countries — 2023 edition

The 2023 edition of Basic figures on European Neighbourhood Policy-South countries presents series of basic statistical data for the EU's southern neighbourhood countries and compares them with EU data.

The European Neighbourhood South (ENP-South) countries are: Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestine*, Syria and Tunisia. Cooperation with Syria is suspended since May 2011.

Eurostat collects data from national statistical authorities and releases a range of publications, all of which are free of charge, on its website in PDF format: <https://ec.europa.eu/eurostat/web/main>.

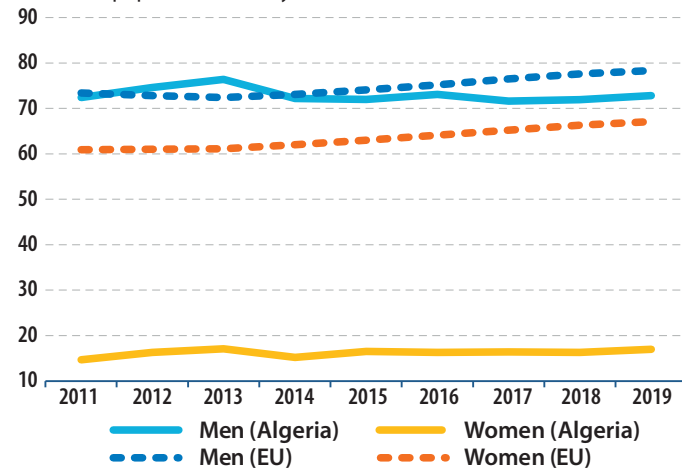
Population by age group, Algeria and EU, 2021

(% of total population, 1 January)



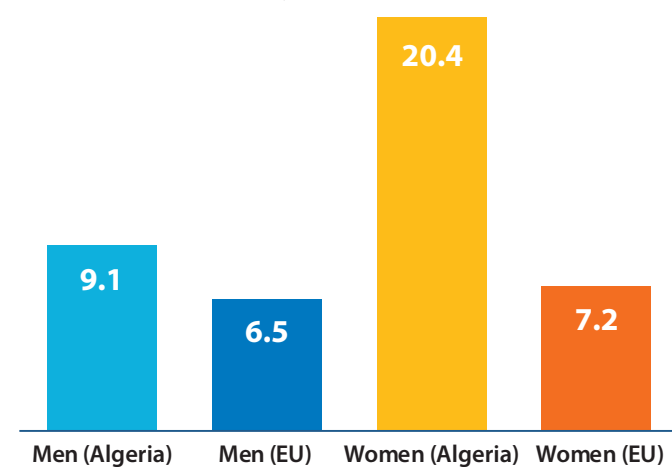
Employment rate, Algeria and EU

(% of total population, 20-64 years old)



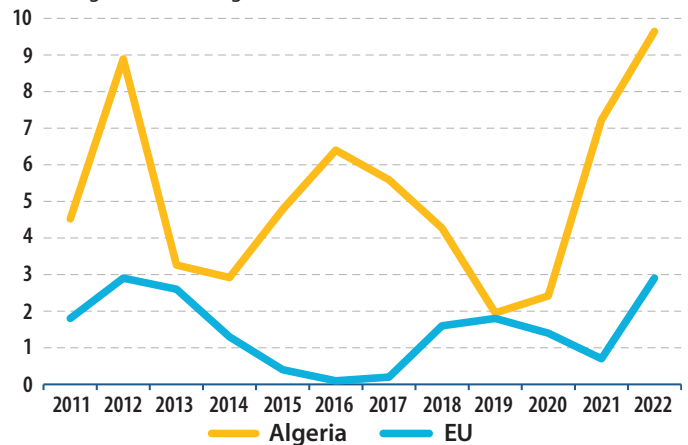

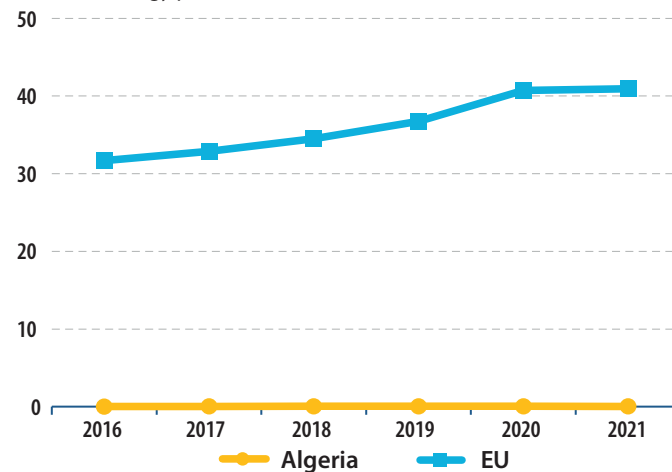

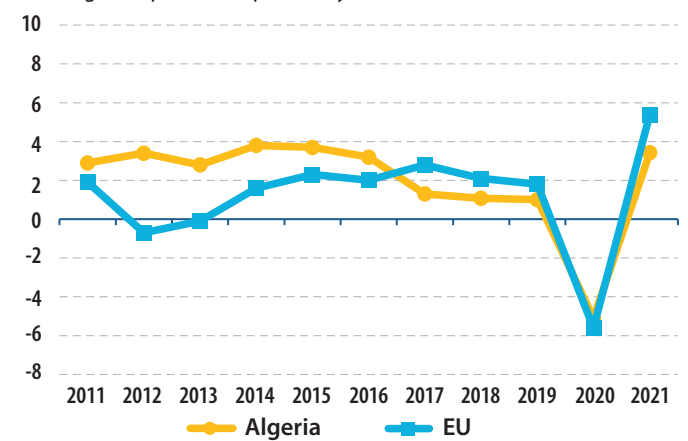
Renewable energy sources, Algeria and EU

(% of total energy production)



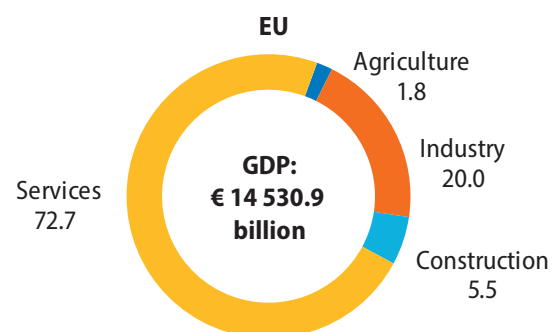
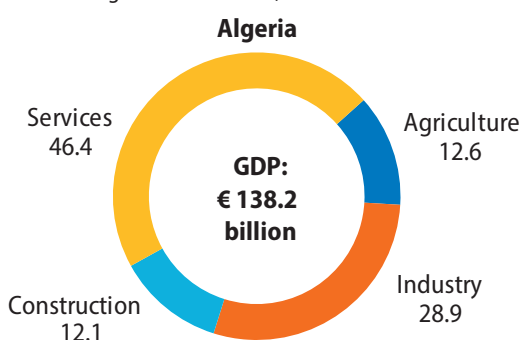
Real change in gross domestic product, Algeria and EU

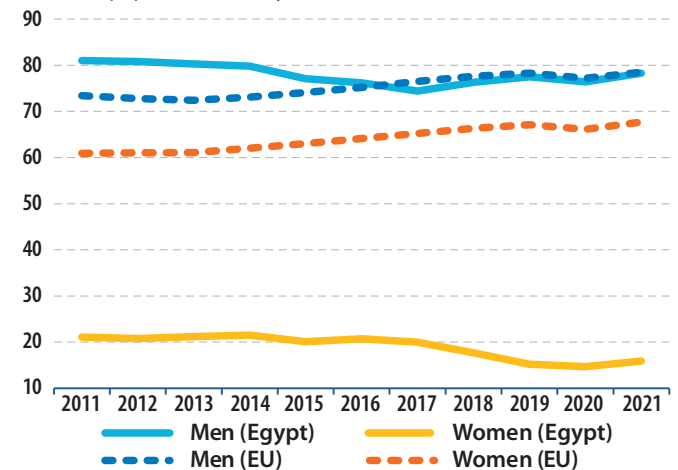
Population by age group, Egypt and EU, 2019

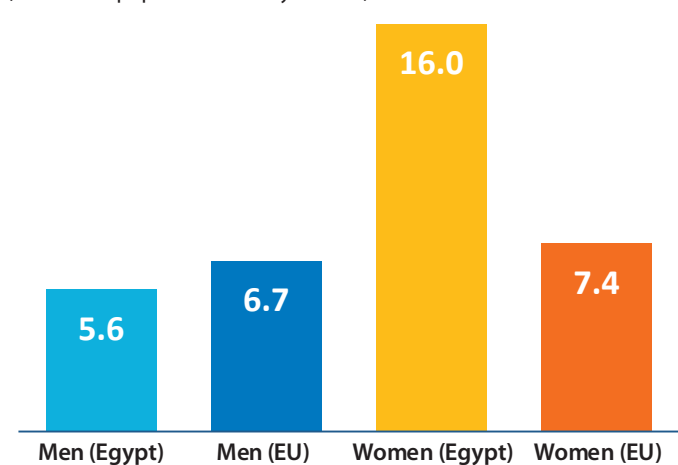
Employment rate, Egypt and EU

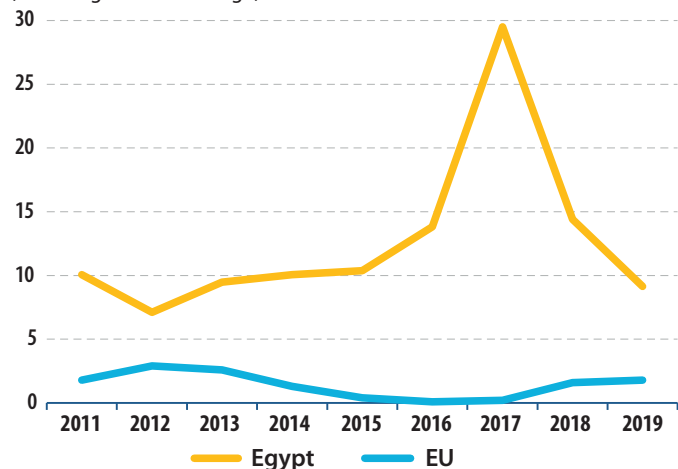

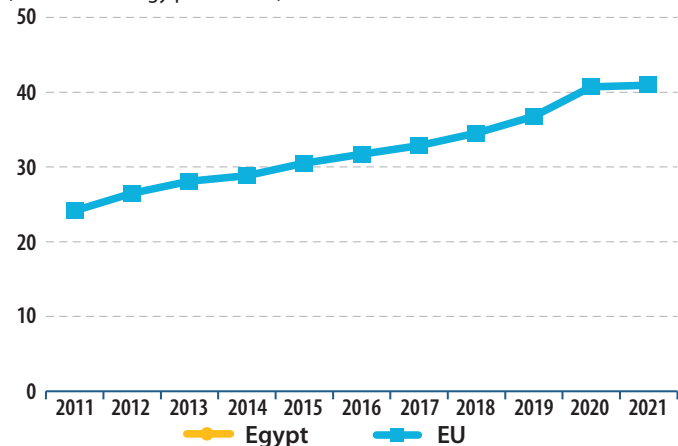
Consumer price inflation, Egypt and EU

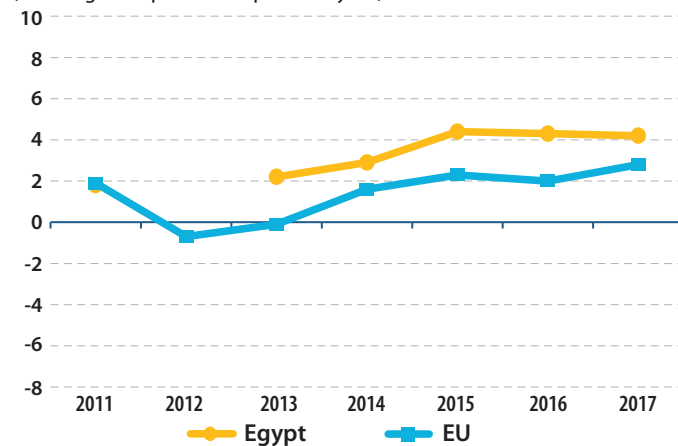

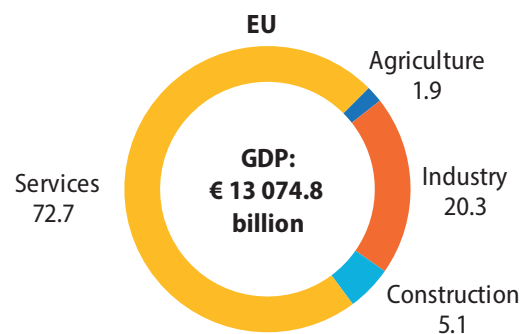
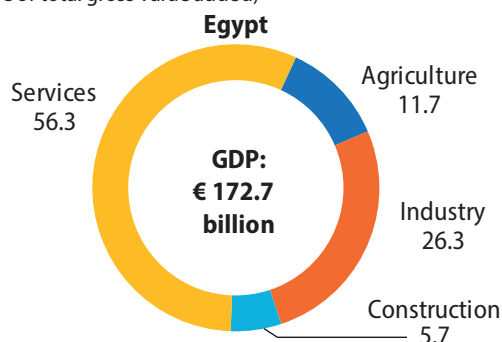
Real change in gross domestic product, Egypt and EU

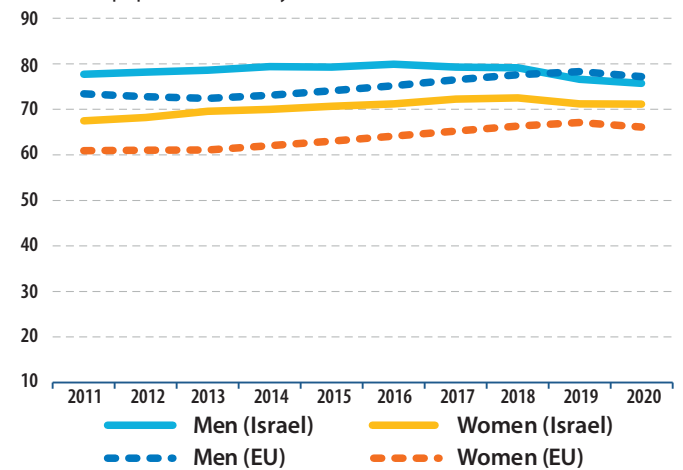
Population by age group, Israel and EU, 2021

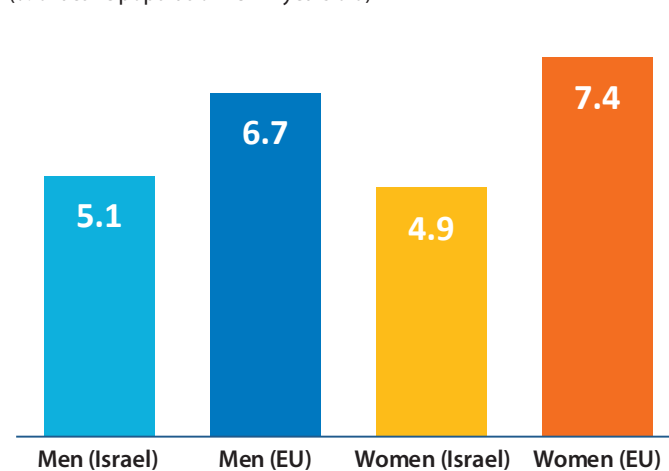
Employment rate, Israel and EU

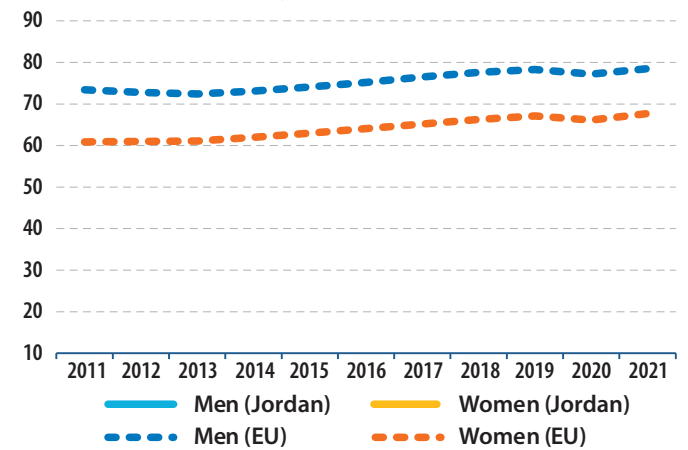
Population by age group, Jordan and EU, 2022

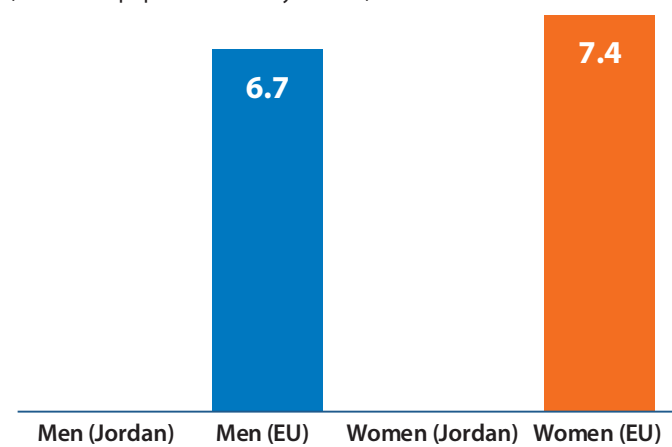

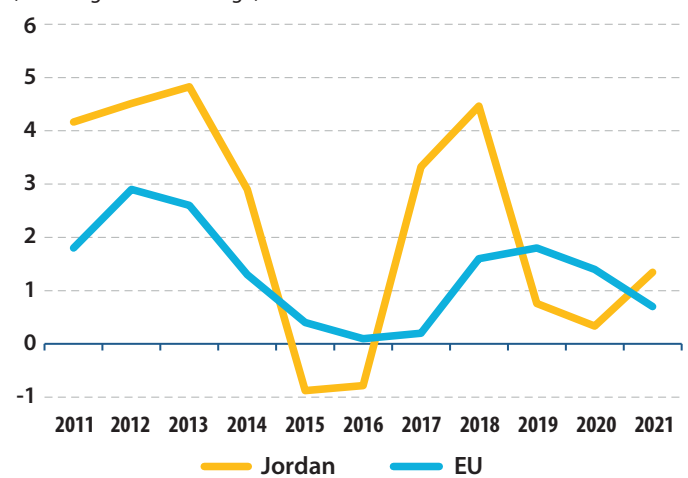

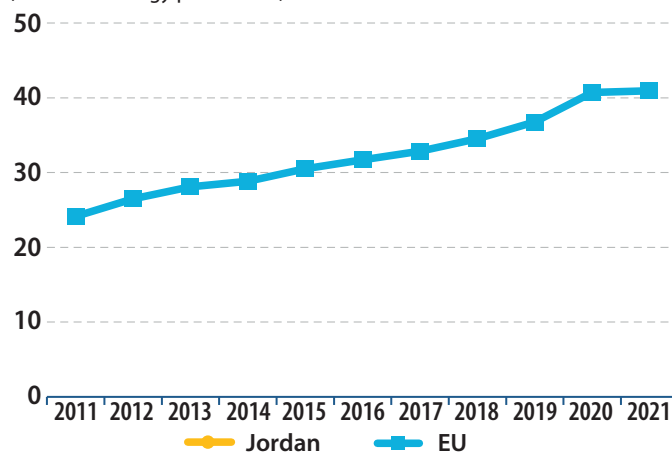
Consumer price inflation, Jordan and EU

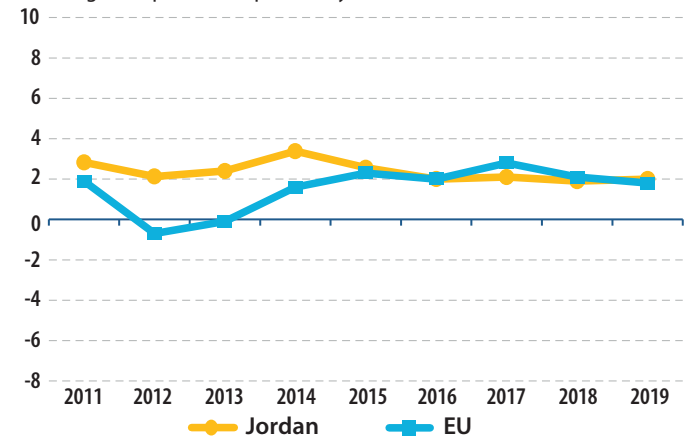

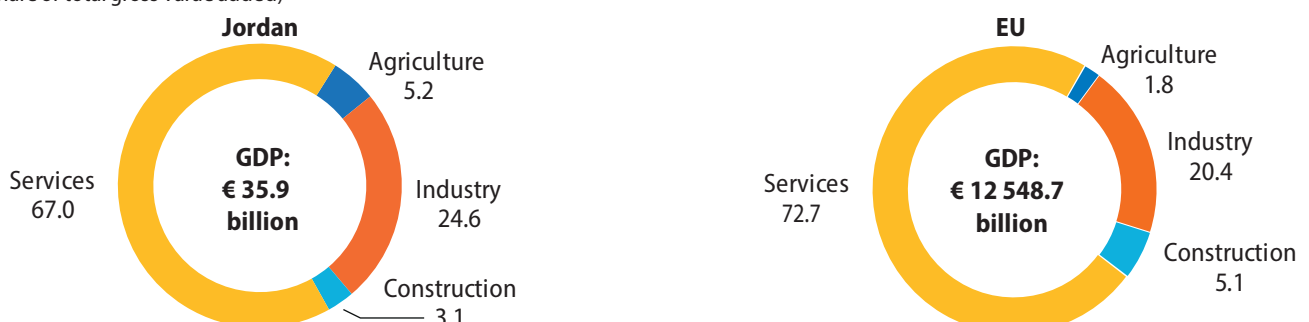
Real change in gross domestic product, Jordan and EU

Population by age group, Lebanon and EU, 2018

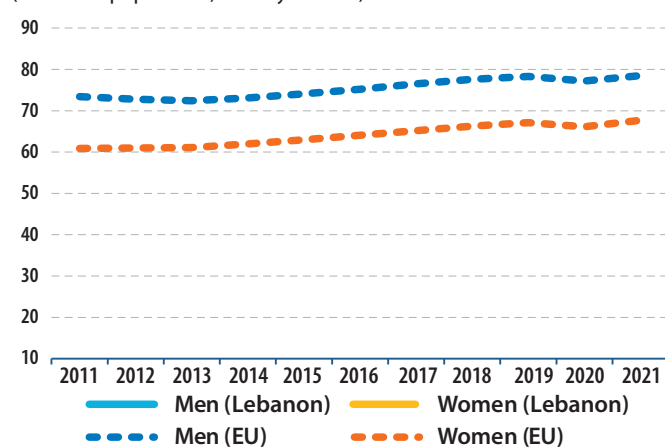

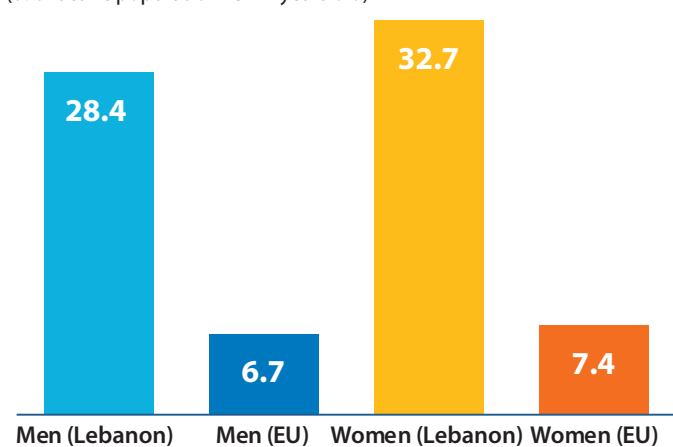

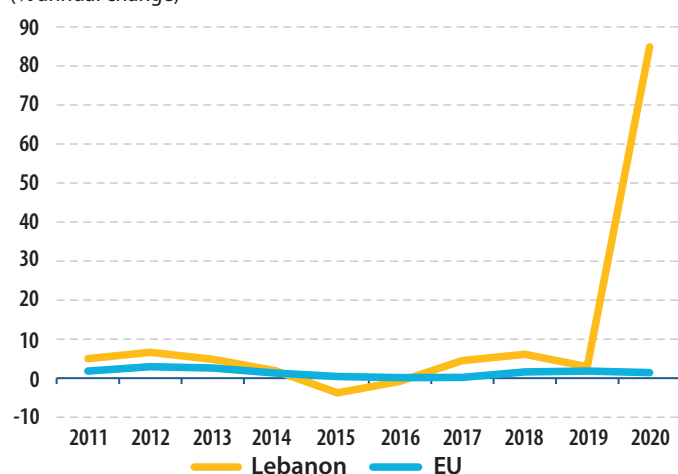
Unemployment rate, Lebanon and EU, 2022

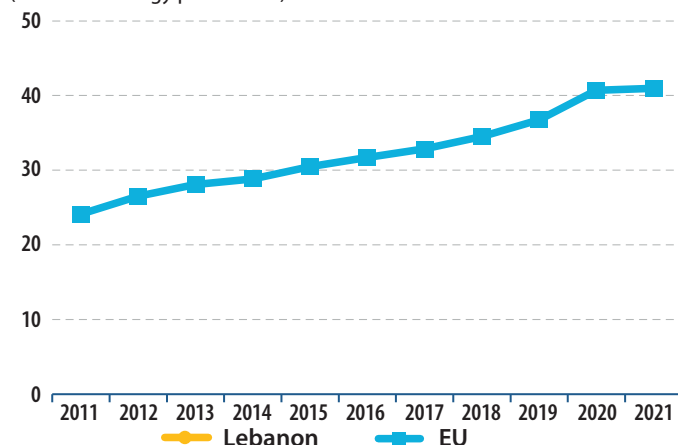
Consumer price inflation, Lebanon and EU

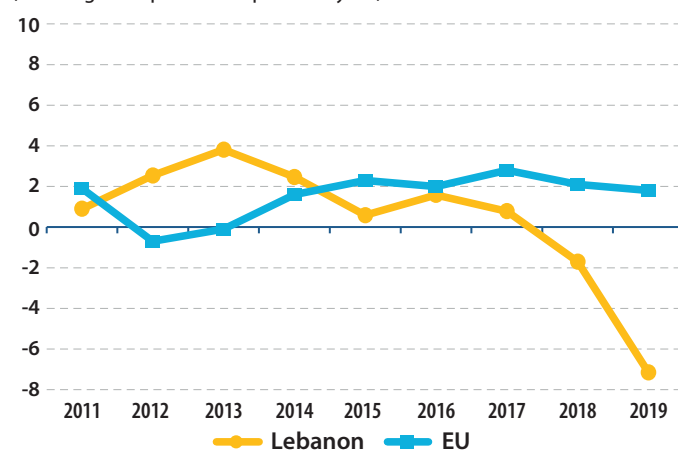

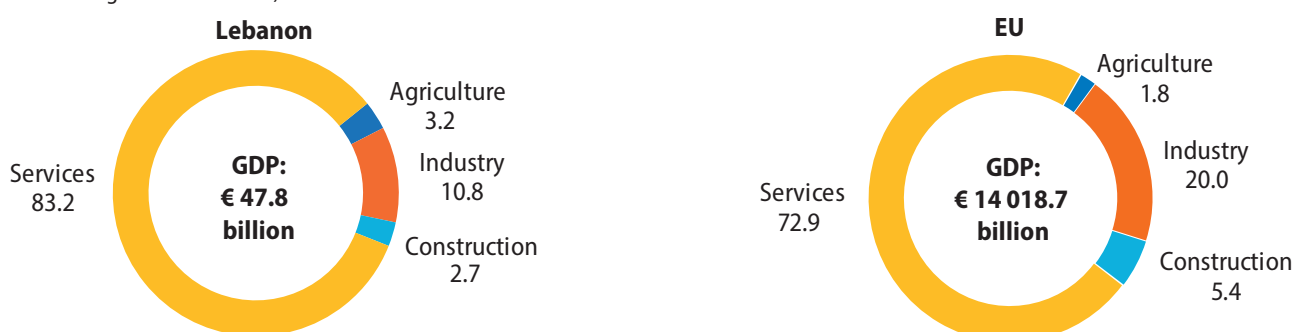
Real change in gross domestic product, Lebanon and EU

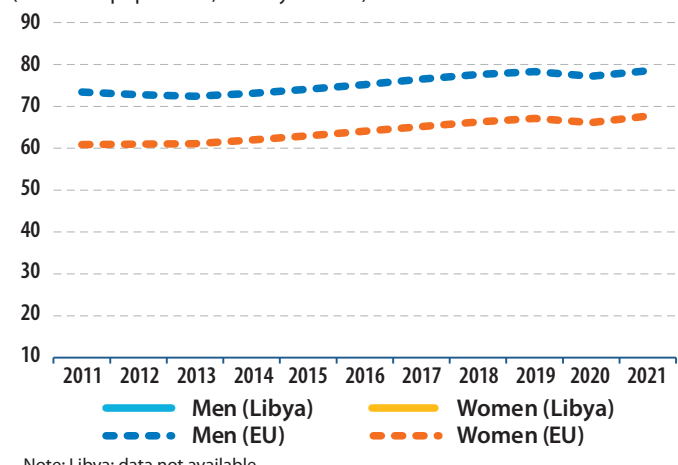
Population by age group, Libya and EU, 2020

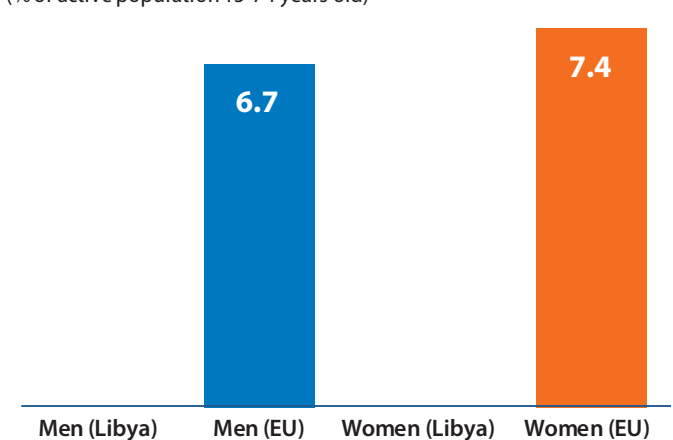

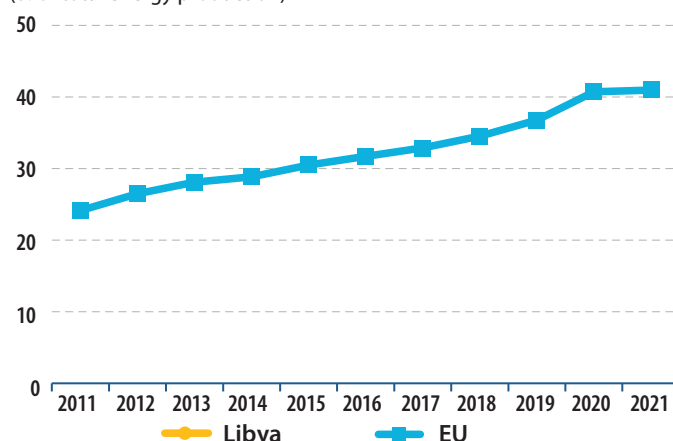

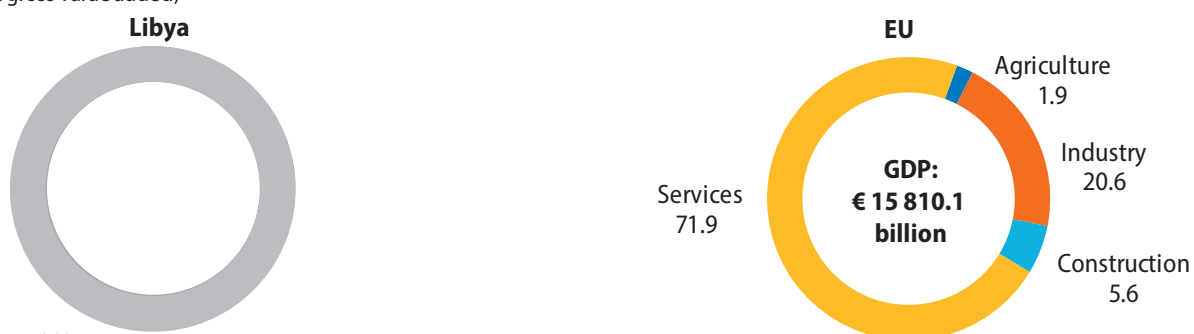
Real change in gross domestic product, Libya and EU

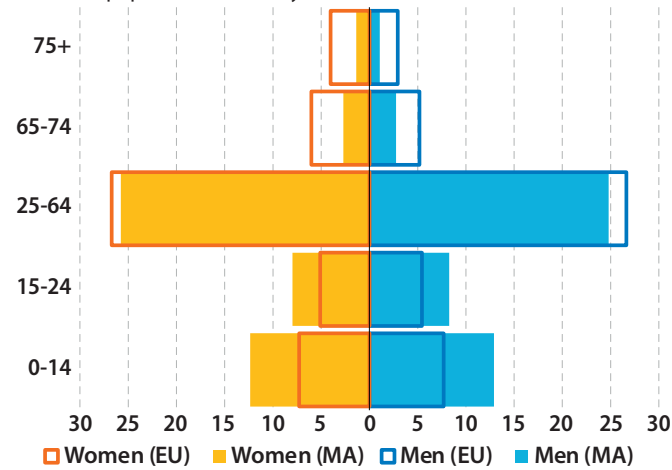

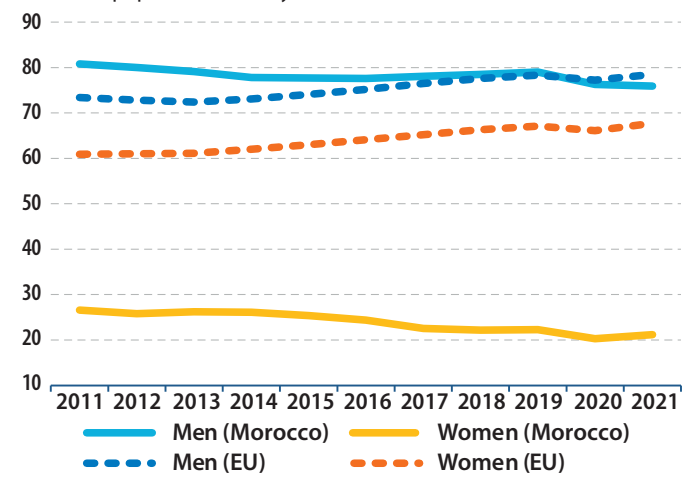
Population by age group, Morocco and EU, 2022

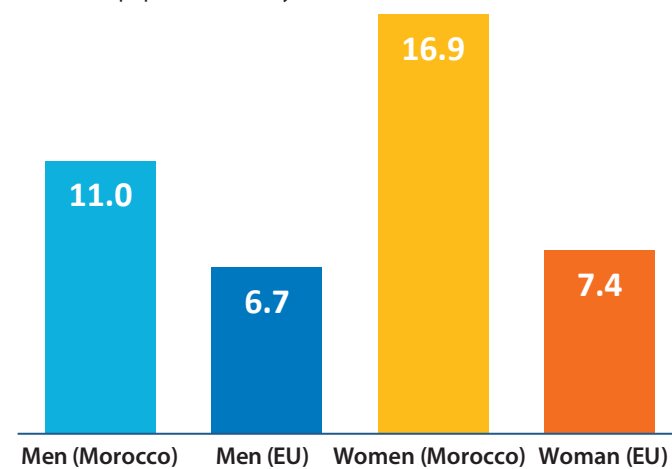

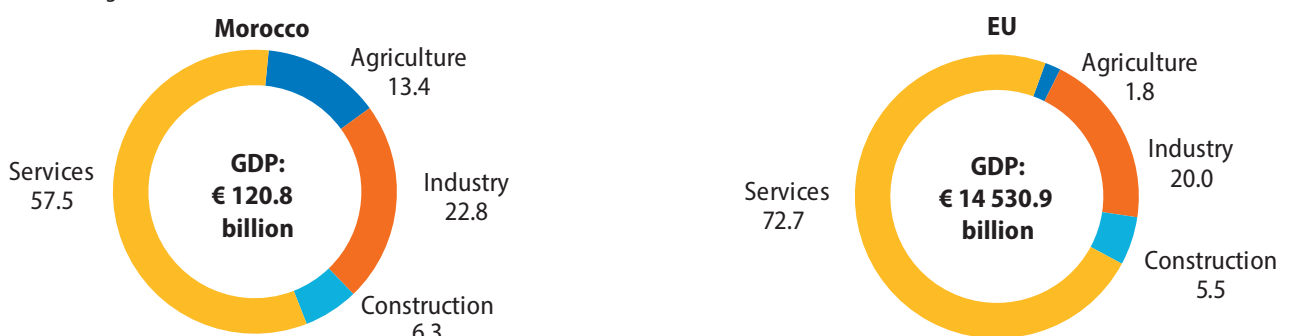

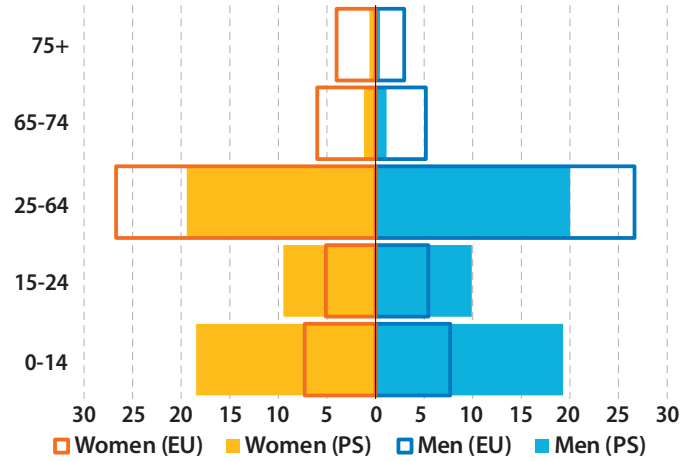

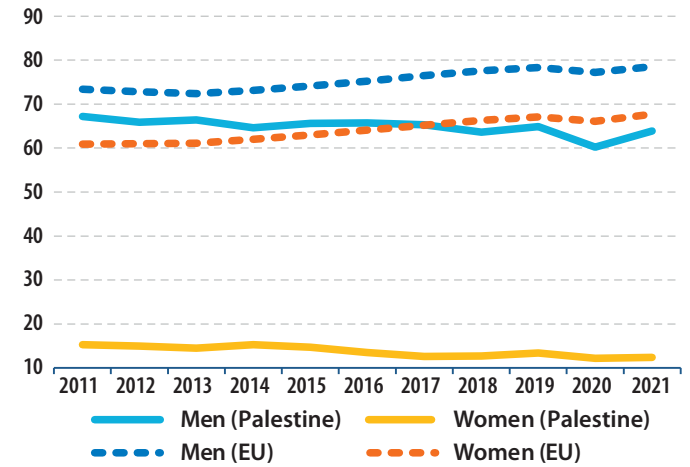
Population by age group, Palestine and EU, 2022

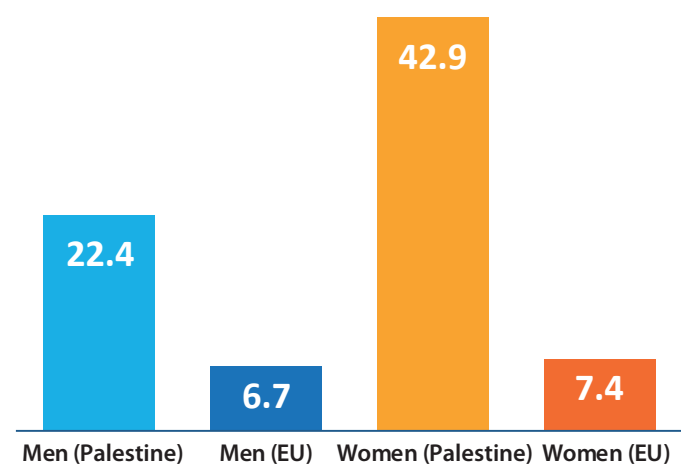

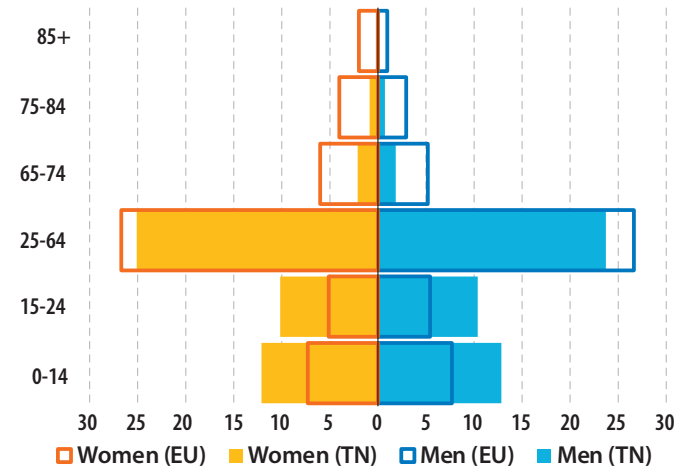

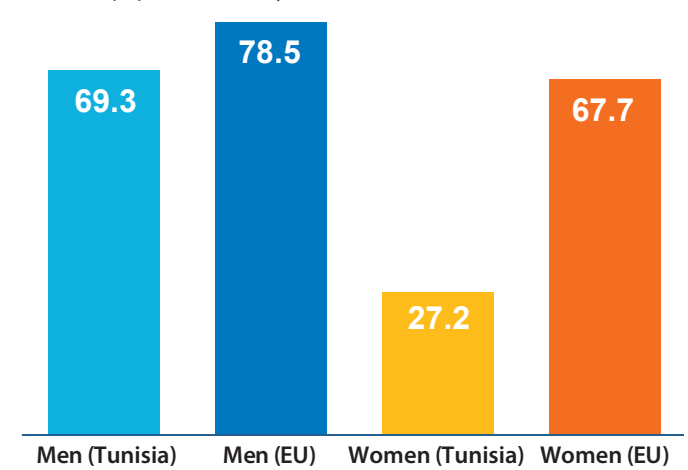
Population by age group, Tunisia and EU, 2022

(% of total population, 1 January)



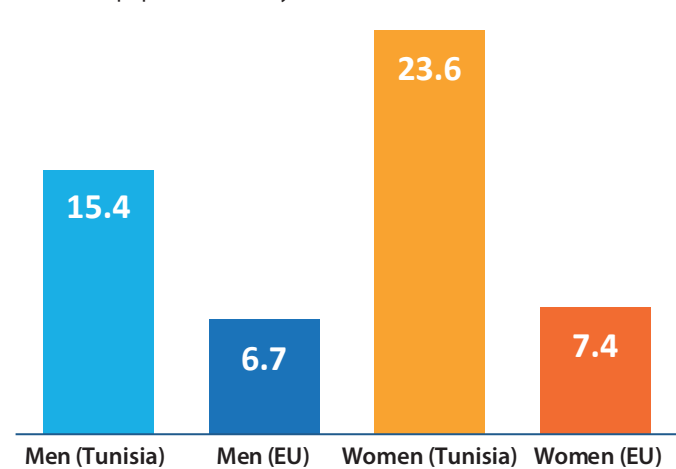
Employment rate, Tunisia and EU, 2021

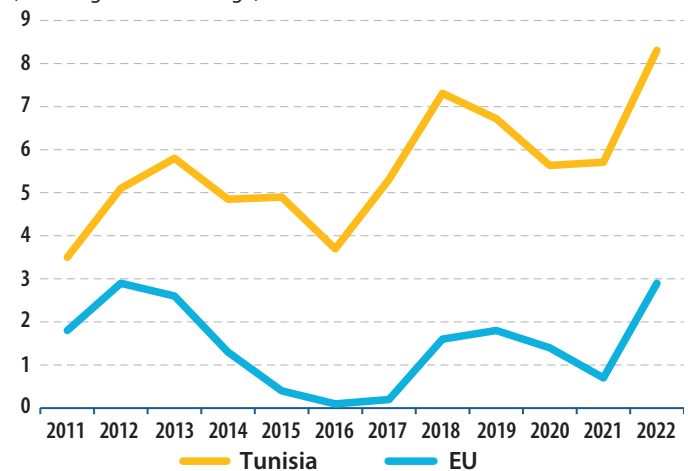

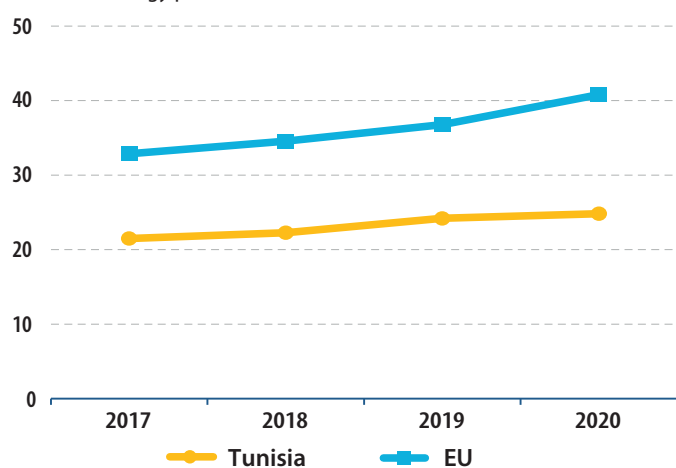
Consumer price inflation, Tunisia and EU

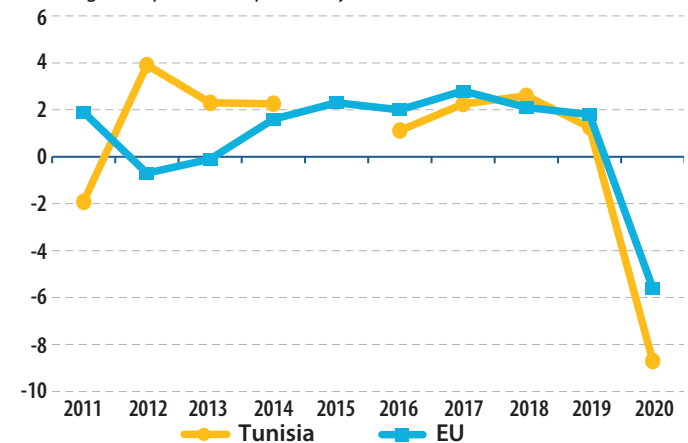

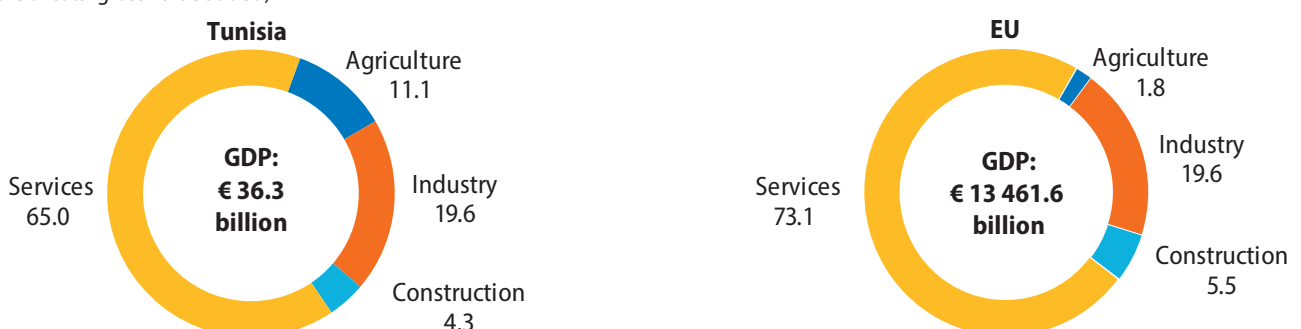
Real change in gross domestic product, Tunisia and EU

Statistical cooperation with the European Neighbourhood Policy-South countries

European Neighbourhood Policy (ENP)

The European Neighbourhood Policy (ENP), launched in 2003 and developed throughout 2004, supports and fosters stability, security and prosperity in the EU's neighbourhood. The ENP was revised in 2015. The main principles of the revised policy are a tailored approach to partner countries; flexibility; joint ownership; greater involvement of EU member states and shared responsibility. The ENP aims to deepen engagement with civil society and social partners. It offers partner countries greater access to the EU's market and regulatory framework, standards and internal agencies and programmes.

The Joint Communication by the European External Action Service and the European Commission on "Renewed Partnership with the Southern Neighbourhood – A new Agenda for the Mediterranean", accompanied by an EU "Economic and Investment Plan for the Southern neighbours", of 9 February 2021⁽¹⁾ further guides cooperation with the ENP-South countries.

Statistical cooperation with the ENP-South countries

The main objective of Euro-Mediterranean cooperation in statistics is to enable the production and dissemination of reliable and comparable data, in line with European and international norms and standards.

Reliable and comparable data are essential for evidence-based decision-making. They are needed to monitor the implementation of the agreements between the EU and the ENP-South countries, the impact of policy interventions and the reaching of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

The EU has been supporting statistical capacity building in the region for a number of years through bilateral and regional capacity-building activities. This takes the form of technical assistance to partner countries' national statistical authorities through targeted assistance programmes and activities such as training courses, working groups and workshops, exchange of best practice and the transfer of statistical know-how.

A key tool for statistical cooperation with the ENP-South countries is the MEDSTAT programme⁽²⁾, launched in 1996. MEDSTAT is a multiannual regional cooperation programme for statistics and its fifth phase – MEDSTAT V – was launched in January 2022 for the period 2022-2025.

The annual Forum of Euro-Mediterranean statisticians steers the Euro-Mediterranean regional cooperation in statistics. In 2016, the Forum endorsed the Statistics Code of Practice for the European Neighbourhood South countries⁽³⁾, based on the European Statistics Code of Practice.

Geographical coverage of ENP-South countries

The data and their denomination in no way constitute the expression of an opinion by the European Commission on the legal status of a country or territory or on the delimitation of its frontiers.

The ENP-South region covers the following ten countries: Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestine⁽⁴⁾, Syria⁽⁵⁾ and Tunisia.
