

The 2023 edition of Labour market statistics factsheets on the candidate countries and potential candidates present series of statistical data on different aspects of the labour market for ten candidate countries and potential candidates and compares them with EU data.

The candidate countries, at the time of writing, are: Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, the Republic of Moldova, North Macedonia, Albania, Serbia, Türkiye and Ukraine. Kosovo and Georgia are potential candidates.




Participation in the labour force, Bosnia and Herzegovina and EU, 2021

(% of active population, 20-64 years old)




Share of women in employment, Bosnia and Herzegovina and EU


Unemployment by education level, Bosnia and Herzegovina and EU, 2021




Weekly working hours, in full-time and part-time work, Montenegro and EU, 2021

(average number of working hours per week)




Share of older persons in employment, Montenegro and EU

(% of active population, 20-64 years old)




Share of women in employment, Moldova and EU




Weekly working hours, in full-time and part-time work, Moldova and EU, 2022








Proportion of employed, Moldova and EU, 2021








Employment by main sector, Serbia and EU, 2022








Proportion of employed, Serbia and EU, 2022






Proportion of employed, Ukraine and EU, 2021






Employment by main sector, Kosovo and EU, 2021




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Employment by main sector, Georgia and EU, 2021

(% of employed population, 15+ years old)







Statistical cooperation with the candidate countries and potential candidates

Among the EU Member States, statistics are coordinated by Eurostat, the statistical office of the EU, through the European statistical system (ESS). The ESS is based on the harmonisation of statistical concepts, methodologies, definitions and methods, which enable the collection of reliable, robust and comparable statistics among EU Member States, EFTA countries and the candidate countries and potential candidates.

Reliable and comparable statistics are a precondition for a successful accession process. The EU acquis in the field of statistics requires the existence of a statistical infrastructure based on principles such as professional independence, objectivity, impartiality, commitment to quality, reliability, transparency, confidentiality of individual data and equal access of official statistical data for all users. The EU acquis also covers methodology, classifications and procedures for data collection.

Eurostat monitors the compliance of national statistical systems with the EU acquis in statistics and also provides technical assistance and support to national statistical authorities and other producers of official statistics.

The candidate countries and potential candidates are expected to increase the volume and quality of their data progressively and to transmit these data to Eurostat. Data from the candidate countries and potential candidates is increasingly being collected by the Eurostat thematic units through their regular data collections and are increasingly included in their regular Eurobase data sets.

EU headline targets by 2030

The EU has set three headline targets on employment, skills and poverty reduction for 2030, as laid down in the European Pillar of Social Rights Action Plan. For the EU labour market, the targets define that by 2030:

- At least 78% of the population aged 20 to 64 should be in employment.
- At least 60% of adults (25-64) should participate in training every year.

Complementary goals were set to increase the labour market participation of women and young people:

- halving the gender employment gap,
- decreasing to 9% the share of young people (15-29) who are neither in employment, nor in education or training (NEETs).

European labour market statistics

The EU Labour Force Survey (EU-LFS) is a key source of information on the situation and trends of the EU and national labour markets. It is a large household sample survey, providing data on the participation in the labour force (employed and unemployed) of people aged 15 and over, as well as on persons outside it, and provides descriptive and explanatory data on each of these groups. Due to the diversity of information and the large sample size, the EU-LFS is also an important source for other European statistics, like education statistics or regional statistics. The EU-LFS currently covers 34 countries, including the EU Member States and the candidate countries Montenegro, North Macedonia, Serbia and Türkiye. The EU-LFS ensures comparability across countries and over time by using the same concepts and definitions, following International Labour Organization guidelines, using common classifications (NACE, ISCO, ISCED, NUTS), and recording the same characteristics in each country. Some of the key definitions used are:

- The **activity rate** is the percentage of active persons in the total population of the same age.
- The **labour force** (the economically active population) is the total number of people employed plus unemployed.
- The **unemployment rate** is the number of people unemployed as a percentage of the labour force.
- The **youth unemployment rate** is the number of unemployed people aged 15 to 24 as a percentage of the labour force of the same age.
- The **long-term unemployment rate** concerns those persons who are out of work and have been actively seeking employment for at least a year.

Employment statistics are frequently reported as employment rates to enable comparisons over time and between countries of different sizes.

Geographical coverage of the candidate countries and potential candidates

The data and their denomination in no way constitute the expression of an opinion by the European Commission on the legal status of a country or territory or on the delimitation of its frontiers.

- The data managed by the National Bureau of Statistics of the Republic of Moldova does not include data from Transnistria over which the government of the Republic of Moldova does not exercise control.
- Data for Ukraine generally have a break in series in 2014, since they exclude the illegally annexed Autonomous Republic of Crimea and the City of Sevastopol and territories which are not under control of the Ukrainian government (see specific footnotes for precise coverage). Data on Ukraine for the year 2021 is limited due to exemption under the martial law from mandatory data submission to the State Statistics Service of Ukraine, effective as of 3 March 2022.
- The data for Georgia exclude the regions of Abkhazia and South Ossetia over which Georgia does not exercise control.
