

POPULATION AND SOCIAL CONDITIONS

In 2006 the number of nights spent by residents and non-residents in hotels and similar establishments increased in most EU Member States; 80% of the nights were spent in 7 of the 27 Member States

Figure 2: Percentage change in number of nights spent by *non-residents* in hotels and similar establishments, 2006 compared with 2005





Figure 3: Percentage change in number of nights spent by *residents* in hotels and similar establishments, 2006 compared with 2005

**CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS** 

Hotels and similar establishments

Hotels, apartment hotels, motels, roadside inns, beach hotels and other similar establishments which provide hotel services including more than bed-making and cleaning of the room and sanitary facilities. Similar establishments are other similar types of accommodation which is let per room and has a limited number of hotel-type services, including bed-making and cleaning of rooms and sanitary facilities, on a daily basis.
