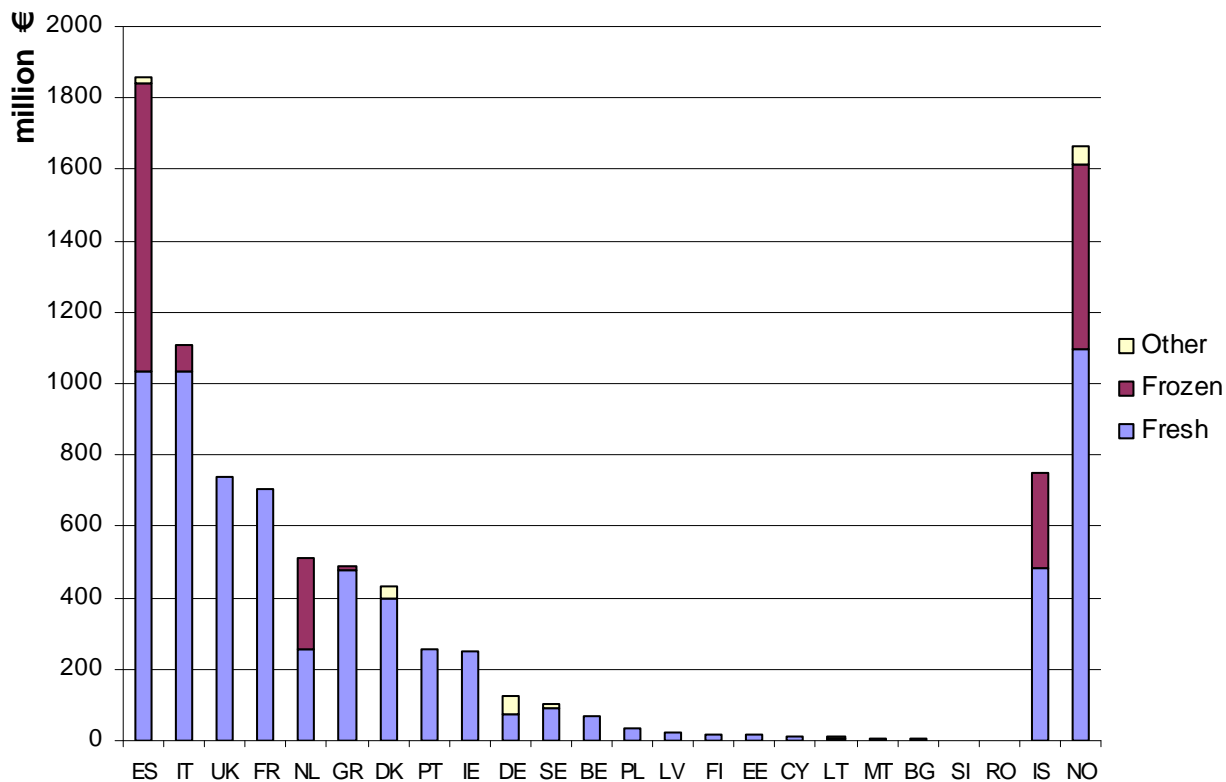

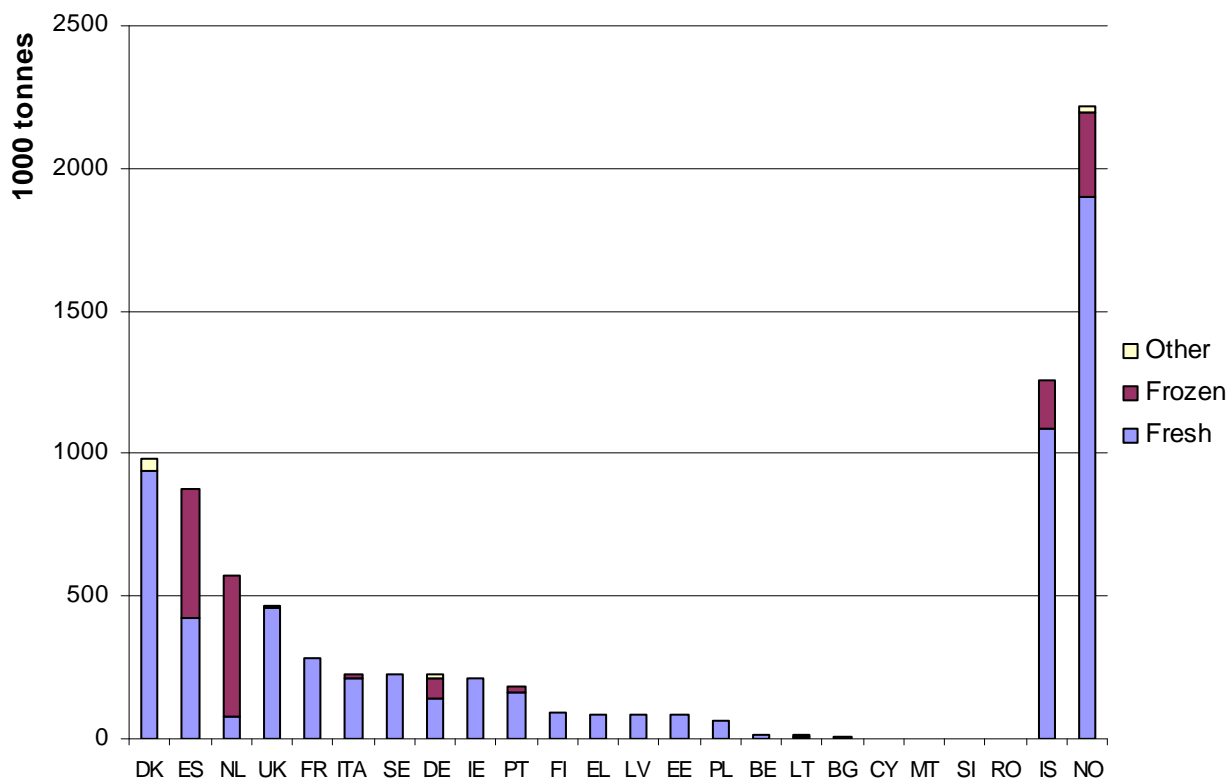

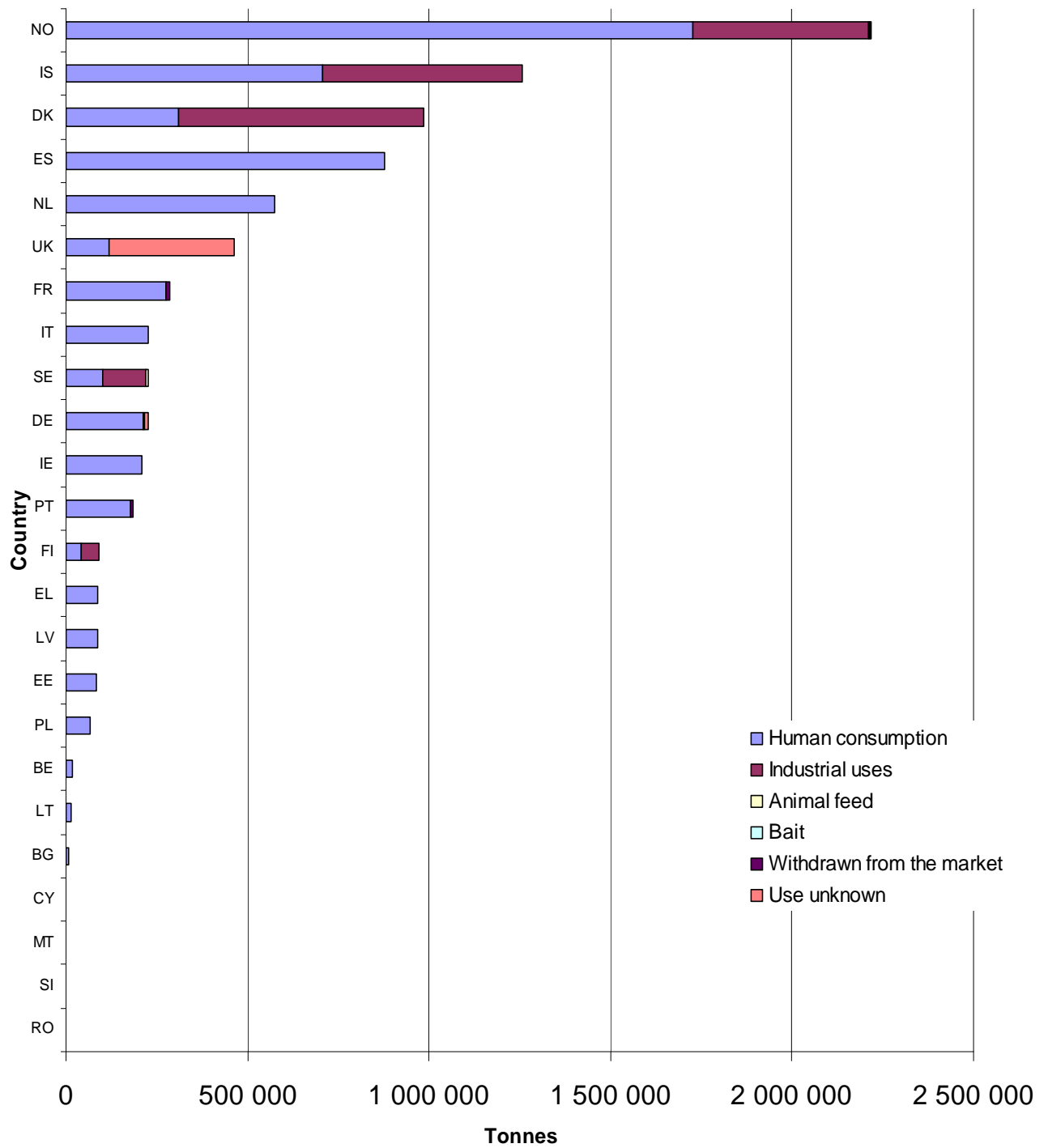

Methodology

EU Member States, Iceland and Norway submit landings data to Eurostat under the terms of the Council Regulation No. 1921/2006 (Official Journal L403, 30.12.2006) on submission of statistical data on landings of fishery products in Member States.

The EU-27 Member states which provide data on landings are Belgium (BE), Bulgaria (BG), Denmark (DK), Germany (DE), Estonia (EE), Ireland (IE), Greece (EL), Spain (SP), France (FR), Italy (IT), Cyprus (CY), Latvia (LV), Lithuania (LT), Hungary (HU), Malta (MT), Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

Landings data are not provided by Czech Republic (CZ), Hungary (HU), Austria (AT) and Slovakia (SK).

Community and EFTA fishing vessels mean fishing vessels flying the flag of a Member State and registered in the European Community or in an EFTA country. The EFTA countries referred to in this publication are Iceland and Norway.

In this DIF, 2008's data for Lithuania are from year 2007.

Landings data are collected from January 1992 onwards, at an annual periodicity.

The following variables are collected:

- Reference year,
- Reporting country,
- Species individually identified or species classified by groups:

For statistical purposes, nominal catches of aquatic animals and plants, taken in inland and marine waters or derived from aquaculture, for all kinds of commercial, industrial and subsistence purposes are presented at either species, genus or family level in approximately 1 250 statistical categories called "species items". The "International Standard Statistical Classification of Aquatic Animals and Plants" (ISSCAAP), developed by FAO, classifies these species into 50 groups of species and 9 divisions. For further details please see CWP Handbook of Fishery Statistical Standards (<http://www.fao.org/fishery/cwp/handbook/S/en>). Groups presented in the document align to the ISSCAAP. The demersal category includes: flounders, halibuts and soles; cods, hakes and haddocks; miscellaneous coastal fishes and miscellaneous demersal fishes. The pelagic category includes: herrings, sardines and anchovies; tunas, bonitos and billfishes and miscellaneous pelagic fishes.

- Presentation: Information on presentation is collected according to the state of preservation (fresh, frozen, salted, dried, etc.) as well as whether the fish is whole, gutted, headed etc.

Fresh (fish that have not been preserved, cured, frozen or otherwise treated other than chilled. They are generally presented whole or gutted);

Frozen (fish that have been subjected to freezing in a manner to preserve the inherent quality of the fish by reducing the average temperature to -18 °C or lower and which are then kept at a temperature of -18 °C or lower);

Other (salted (fish often in gutted and headed form, preserved in salt or brine), smoked, cooked or dried).

- Destination or intended use:

Human consumption: all fishery products which are sold at first sale for human consumption or which are landed under contract or other agreement for human consumption. Excluded are quantities intended for human consumption but which, at the time of first sale, are withdrawn from the market for human consumption owing to market conditions or hygiene regulations or for similar reasons.

Industrial uses: all fishery products specifically landed for reduction to meal and oil for consumption by animals, and quantities which, although originally intended for human consumption, are not sold for that purpose at first sale.

Withdrawn from the market: the quantities which originally were intended for human consumption but which, at the time of first sale, are withdrawn from the market owing to market conditions or hygiene regulations or for similar reasons.

Bait: quantities of fresh fish which are intended to be used as bait in other fishing activities. An example is the bait used in tuna pole and line fisheries.

Animal feed: the quantities of fresh fish intended to be fed direct to animals. Excluded are quantities intended for processing to fish meal and oil.

Waste: fish or parts thereof which due to their state are to be destroyed prior to landing.

Intended use unknown: quantities of fish which cannot be assigned to any of the above categories.

- Vessel nationality,
- Quantities in tonnes products weight and value (ECU/EUR).
