

## HOW IS THE EU POPULATION STRUCTURED?




## WHO IS MOST AFFECTED BY HEALTH RISKS?


### Avoidable death rates by sex (per 100 000 residents, 2021)


## HOW DO DIFFERENT GROUPS PARTICIPATE IN EDUCATION?


### Women-to-men ratio among tertiary education graduates (women per 100 men, 2021)




### Part-time employment (as share of total employed people aged 25-54 in each category\*, 2023)


