Information: revision of PPP time series

Today, Eurostat publishes a revised time series of Purchasing Power Parities (PPPs), starting in 1995. This revision was undertaken for three main reasons:

- to incorporate the latest national accounts data that were produced under [ESA2010](#) by all Member States and other countries;
- to harmonise, to the maximum extent, the [methodology](#) used in calculating the PPPs for all reference years;
- to introduce, for all reference years, the latest [classification of expenditures](#).

Information: révision des séries chronologiques des PPA

Aujourd’hui, Eurostat publie les séries chronologiques révisées de parités de pouvoir d’achat (PPA), à partir de 1995. Cette révision a été réalisée pour trois raisons principales:

- pour intégrer les dernières données des comptes nationaux qui ont été produites dans le cadre du [SEC 2010](#) par l’ensemble des États membres et d’autres pays;
- d’harmoniser la [méthodologie](#) utilisées pour le calcul des PPA pour toutes les années de référence;

Information: KKP-Zeitreihen revidiert

Eurostat veröffentlicht heute revidierte Zeitreihen für Kaufkraftparitäten für die Jahre ab 1995. Die Revision wurde vor allem aus drei Gründen vorgenommen:

- Einarbeitung der jüngsten VGR-Daten nach dem [ESVG2010](#), die seitens der Mitgliedstaaten und anderer Länder vorliegen;
- Harmonisierung der für die Berechnung der KKP benutzten [Methodik](#) über den gesamten Zeitraum hinweg
- Einführung der aktuellen [Systematik der Ausgaben](#) für alle Berichtsjahre

Annex

Background to the revision

The provision of data for and the calculation and dissemination of Purchasing Power Parities (PPPs) is governed by [Regulation 1445/2007](#) (the "PPP Regulation"). This Regulation stipulates in Article 9:

"1. The Commission (Eurostat) shall publish the final annual results no later than 36 months after the end of the reference year.

(...)

4. Published final PPPs shall generally not be revised."

However, paragraph 4 of this article continues:

"Exceptional general revisions shall be carried out if, owing to changes to the concepts underlying ESA 95 that affect PPP results, the volume index of GDP for any Member State changes by more than one percentage point."

The introduction of [ESA2010](#) had a significant [impact](#) on the level of GDP in many countries. Hence, this initiated a general revision of the PPP time series starting in 1995.

In addition, in 2015 a new classification of "basic headings" was [adopted](#). Basic headings are the lowest level of aggregation for which PPPs are calculated and expenditures collected. The general revision provided the opportunity to recalculate PPPs using the same classification for all years, improving their coherence over time.

Finally, in the course of time, several methodological advances were made to different elements of the PPP calculations. Again, the general revision allowed introducing these changes also for reference years that were already beyond the 36 months mentioned above at the time of introduction.

Most important changes

The most important changes made were:

- Collection of new basic heading level expenditure data according to ESA2010. The expenditure data are used as weights to derive the published aggregate PPPs from the basic heading PPPs.
- Collection of new data on housing (actual rents and imputed rents), following the introduction of results of the [2011 Census](#) in the national accounts in recent years.
- Introduction of the output approach for education for the years 1995-2004 (previously starting in 2005); see chapter 8 of the [PPP Manual](#).
- Use of prices for electricity and gas from Eurostat's Energy Statistics for the years 2007-2011 (previously starting in 2012).
- Introduction of the output approach for [health](#) for the year 2010 (previously starting in 2011).

Country coverage

The coverage of countries in different years has also improved. The following table summarises the new data availability, for the series with EU-15 as base:

Impact of the revision on GDP per capita in PPS

The tables on the next pages provide an overview of the impact of the revisions on the main indicator GDP per capita in PPS, with EU-28=100. Revisions to Actual Individual Consumption follow broadly the same pattern.

Next revisions

Until the next general revision, the usual revision routine for PPPs will again apply:

- In June of year t, the first preliminary results for the reference year t-1 are published
- In December of year t, the final results for the reference year t-3, and updated results for the reference years t-2 and t-1 are published.
- Data for reference year t-3 are not further revised.
- Data for reference year t-2 is once further revised in December t+1.
- Data for reference year t-1 is revised further in December t+1 and December t+2.
