She graduated from Vilnius University with a Master's degree in Statistics and in 2011 obtained her PhD in Mathematics.



Her Doctoral dissertation thesis was: "Poisson type approximations for sums of dependent variables". As a Member of the Advisory Council of Vilnius University Faculty of Mathematics and Informatics, Dr. Jūratė Petrauskienė still participates in the activities of Vilnius University as well as performs the functions of the Deputy Head of the Lithuanian Statistical Association and the Deputy President of the Lithuanian Union of Statistics.

Dr. Jūratė Petrauskienė is an active member of the ESS and international statistical community; during the period of 2021-2022 she was a member of the European Statistical System Partnership Group. She is also a permanent member of the International Statistical Institute (ISI) and the IAOS Executive Committee Co-opted Member (2023-2025).
