

Vitaliana Rondonotti currently leads the Statistics Coordination Unit in the Directorate General Statistics of the European Central Bank (ECB). Such Unit is responsible, inter alia, of the coordination of statistical activities within the ECB/European System of Central Banks (ESCB) and supports the cooperation with Eurostat/ESS and other international organisations.
