

Annex I to Doc. CPSA/613 - Burden assessment of existing FSS variables

Explanation of the codes:

- 1 Information very easy to obtain e.g. information extracted from administrative source without need for complex processing
- 2-3 Regular variables with average (normal) level of burden i.e. question usually understood by the farmers, information readily accesible, suitable for postal survey etc.
- 4-5 Variable e.g. for obtaining which special financial investments are necessary, needs to be collected by an interviewer assisting the farmer in understanding of the question, requiring special training, response errors etc.
