**The note summarising experiences from previous surveys and of other countries**

- I. Comparative summary of the classification of the activities of HETUS 2000 and HETUS 2008, recommended for use in the next harmonised European time use survey for the base year 2010, with classifications from the latest edition of the time use survey in Italy, France, Serbia, Greece, Spain, Germany, Austria, Finland, Norway, Great Britain, Belgium, Turkey, Poland, Romania.
  - II. Conclusions from the analysis of the intensity of the occurrence of activities according to the HETUS 2008 classification in relation to the age and socio-economic status of respondents in the Polish survey from 2013.
- I. Works on the modernization of the classification for the time use survey started with sending out surveys on the use of the classification proposed by Eurostat – Activity coding list and Location/Transport mode HETUS 2008 by individual countries taking part in the last edition of the time use survey.

Statistical Offices from 15 countries responded to the survey. The last survey was conducted in these countries between 2008 and 2015. Most countries have attached their classifications to the survey.

A comparison of the classifications sent by countries with the HETUS 2008 classification was performed. The most significant differences in comparison to the HETUS 2008 classification are as follows:

1. Italy:

1. The European classification has been modified due to the necessity of coding activities from children's diaries (from 3 years of age), computer and Internet use research and maintaining comparability with previous surveys conducted in the country.
2. In each main group of activities, changes were introduced, which lead to a more detailed description of activities performed by the respondents. The types of modifications are:
  - separate activity codes for children/teenagers under 17 years – regarding duties, free time and being under the care of other people and travelling;
  - separate codes for activities performed using a computer/Internet;
  - division of groups of activities appearing in the European classification on the second or third level (e.g. 11 work – division into main and additional work, 362 – administrative or commercial services – division into commercial and administrative tasks);
  - separation (specification) of activities on the fourth level (e.g. activities from group named sport, reading, activities related to religiosity, taking care of children),
  - separation (specification) activities by adding activities on the third level (e.g. 42 – help to other households),
  - modification of code descriptions.

## 2. France.

The last time use survey was carried out in 2009-2010 and was based on the harmonised European classification for the HETUS 2008 time use survey. The modifications introduced are:

- separation of code 031 Personal hygiene and dressing in two separate positions;
- in the field of travel (codes 9), the categories related to traveling have been extended “in order to use code lists containing detailed terms”;
- activity codes related to the physical care of a dependent adult household member (391, 392 and 399) are slightly different from the HETUS 2008 code lists.

## 3. Serbia

Serbian modifications are new items in groups 021 and 38:

- two new symbols introduced as part of the 021 group Eating and drinking: 022 Drinking coffee and 023 Smoking,
- in group 38 Childcare, a new symbol 388 was added: Care given by other household member, except parents and siblings.

Both Greece and Spain have highly adapted their lists of activities to the official list of HETUS 2008, so their comparability is very large.

## 4. Greece

The following :

- in item 02, Study, the following have additionally been separated: 23 Schools/institutions providing tutoring (231 Supplementary lessons / tutoring at the level of primary and secondary school in private institutions, 232 Preparation for the above-mentioned lessons); 24 Foreign languages (241 Foreign language lesson, 242 Preparing for the above-mentioned lessons),
- in item 936 Travel related to shopping and services: 36 Shopping and services; 37 Home management.

In turn, there is no such item from HETUS 2008, as 20 Unspecified study.

## 5. Spain

Changes introduced:

- in item 12. Activities related to employment, 122 Job search was additionally separated;
- in item 9 Travel, as well as other unspecified activities, the following were additionally separated: 930 Commuting and arrivals related to help to other households; 996 Activity related to other statistical surveys; 997 Other informal activities, such as beggars, street musicians, etc.

From the HETUS 2008 classification item 20 Unspecified study is missing .

## 6. Germany

In general, the German classification does not differ from HETUS 2008. However, there was another codification of activities.

The modifications concern a large number of additional items relating to school and university education – in Germany, every school subject, e.g. German, physics, PE is classified as a separate activity. In addition, there are positions regarding school breaks or the so-called “small windows”.

Additional items not appearing in HETUS 2008 relate to group 1 Professional work, e.g. breaks at work other than a coffee break.

The German classification is narrower in relation to HETUS 2008 when it comes to 38 Care for adult members of the household.

#### 7. Austria

The list of activities from 2008 did not apply, they used the combination of the list from 2000 and the old national list from 1992.

#### 8. Finland

Action codes on the third level have been added to such groups of activities as:

01 Sleep, 02 Eating and drinking, 03 Other personal care, 11 Main job and second job, 21 School or university, 31 Food management, 33 Making and care for textiles 36 Shopping and services, 38 Childcare , 41 Organizational work, 42 Informal help to other households, 51 Social life, 53 Resting – time out, 61 Physical exercise, 62 Collecting, hunting, fishing, 71 Arts and hobbies, 72 Computing, 73 Games, 81 Reading, 82 TV, video and DVD, 83 Radio and recordings, 90 Commuting and access. In total, 22 codes from the second HETUS 2008 level have been specified.

#### 9. Norway

The coding was different from the point of view of HETUS code ordering, but the third level of coding was not extended. Commuting and arrival codes were included in the groups of activities with which they were associated due to the destination.

#### 10. Great Britain

Very detailed codes were applied at the 4th level, especially in such groups of activities as: 11 Main and second job and 13 Activities related to employment, 31 Food management, 32 Household upkeep, 35 Construction and repairs, 36 Shopping and services, 37 Household management, 38 Childcare and 39 Help to an adult family member, 41 Organizational work, 42 Informal help to other households, 52 Entertainment and culture, 61 Physical exercise, collecting, hunting , 71 Arts and hobbies, 72 Computing, 73 Games, 82 TV and 83 Radio, 90 Travel to/from work.

#### 11. Belgium

Very detailed coding at the 3rd and 4th level was applied, especially in such groups of activities as: 021 Eating, drinking, 031 Washing and dressing, and 039 Other or unspecified personal care, 111 Working time in main job, 211 School or university classes and lectures and 221 Free time study, 311 Food preparation, baking and preserving, 321 Cleaning dwelling, 324 Arranging household goods and materials, 331 Laundry, Handicraft and producing textiles, 341 Gardening, 343 Caring for pets, 352 Repairs to dwelling, 354 Vehicle maintenance, 361 Shopping, 362 Commercial and administrative services, 363 Personal services, 371 Household management, 381 Childcare and supervision, 384 Accompanying child, 41 Organizational work, 432 Participatory activities and religious activities 512 Visiting and receiving visitors, 514 Telephone conversation, 522 Theatre and concerts, 525 Sports events, 529 Other or unspecified entertainment and culture, 531 Resting – Time out, 613 Cycling, skiing and skating, etc., 614 Ball games and related, 711 Arts, 72 Computing, 731 Solo games, 732 Parlour games and play, 811 Reading periodicals, 812 Reading books, 821 Watching TV.

#### 12. Turkey

Full compliance of codes up to level 3. Introduction of a very detailed level 4 for all activity classification items from level 3.

### 13. Poland

Classification according to HETUS 2008 classification up to level 3 was applied, introducing additional detailed codes at level 4 to such groups of activities as: 129 Other or unspecified activities related to employment; 321 Cleaning dwelling; 429 Other or unspecified informal help to another household; 432 Participatory activities, religious activities, 613 Cycling, skiing, skating, etc .; 939 Travel related to household care; 940 Travel related to voluntary work and meetings; 960 Travel related to leisure.

Romania applied the classification in full compliance with HETUS 2008, without modification at the national level.

In summary, it can be concluded that three Statistical Offices carried out the survey according to the HETUS 2008 classification without modification. One statistical office in Austria applied the guidelines from 2000 in conjunction with the older national guidelines from 1992, and nine statistical offices applied the HETUS 2008 classification with modifications. Activities related to the specificity of a given country, e.g. sauna (Finland) were added; cross-country skiing, food management, e.g. own production of berries, fruits and vegetables, own production of meat and fish (Norway); job search, other informal activities such as cleaning car windows at crossroads, help in finding a parking space, opening doors in a store (Spain); drinking coffee, smoking (Serbia); activities related to religious rites, informal help to other households (Poland).

Four countries do not see the need to change the HETUS 2008 classification in the next study. These are Greece, Norway, Germany and France. The remaining 10 countries see the need for some modifications.

Two countries, Italy and Romania, propose that the new European classification of HETUS 2020 should be changed taking into account some of the codes used in the international classification of ICATUS activities.

#### Proposals for changes in the classification:

- introduce codes dedicated to children and young people, e.g. activities of children in nurseries and kindergartens;
- introduce activities related to new technologies (e.g. surfing the Internet, sharing photos/videos in social media, communicating through the Internet, through social media, Skype, online shopping, writing a blog, listening to music from the Internet);
- add *54 Going on holidays (541) and weekends (542)*;
- update the computer's use code *72 Computing* -> *72 ICT by computer or smart phone*,
- enter new main and supplementary work codes according to the type of work (as proposed by ICATUS),
- introduce code *Lunch break at school*,
- add code *Other visits for tourism purposes in group Entertainment and culture*),
- add code for *Audio, video or messaging conversations*,
- reflect on the links between the codes *51 Social life* a *72 Computing* and *371 Household management activities with computer/Internet with 36 Shopping*,

- introduce more detailed codes for work, childcare, media, commuting (Belgium),
  - include a new definition of work, complementing the codes with *Family work, Voluntary work, Unpaid trainee work* and *Personal services* according to ICATUS;
  - take into account the time spent in shopping malls as time spent for social purposes,
- consider Turkey's proposals relating to *Travel related to heating, Reading book from Internet, Lunch break expect heating, Playing with friends (children) Using new technology, smart phones* use of new technologies (smartphones), religious activities in the context of work.

- II. The analysis of the frequency of activities highlighted in the HETUS 2008 classification was based on the results of the Polish 2013 time use survey due to their availability and compliance of codes at all coding levels proposed in the HETUS 2008 classification (the introduced changes did not violate the proposed classification but made it more accurate under the proposed solutions, as in the classifications used by the UK and Turkey).

Due to the low percentage of people performing certain activities both in different socio-economic groups and age groups of respondents, it is proposed to remove or combine activities such as:

#### General conclusions:

1. Levels two and three of the classification for 2020 should be modified to a limited extent and enabling comparison with HETUS 2008 for maintaining consistency of codes at the international level, and the possibility of introducing national modifications should be ensured at the fourth level.
2. Keep the order of the code groups from the HETUS 2008 classification and, if possible, the numbers and descriptions of the codes.
