Statistics Explained

Official and common term: Intermediate region; **Plural:** Intermediate regions

Short definition: intermediate regions form part of the [urban-rural typology](#) , they are [NUTS](#) level 3 regions where more than 50 % and up to 80 % of the population live in [urban clusters](#) .
