

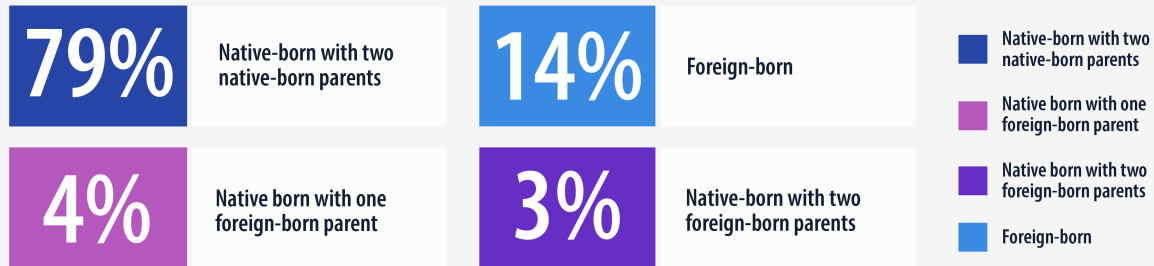
Foreign-born people and their descendants

The publication **Foreign-born people and their descendants** is an online [Eurostat](#) publication based on data collected by Eurostat from the [EU Labour Force Survey \(EU-LFS\)](#) and from the [ad-hoc module](#) (with eight-yearly periodicity) of the EU-LFS on the labour market situation of migrants and their immediate descendants implemented in 2021.

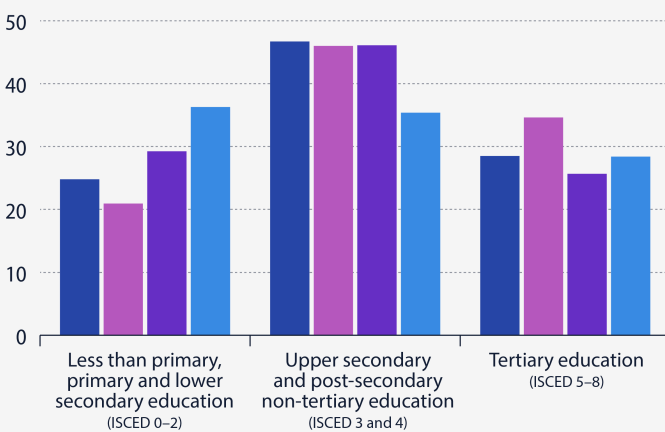
Key figures on foreign-born people and their descendants in the EU (2022)

People aged 15-74 years old residing in private households in the EU were:



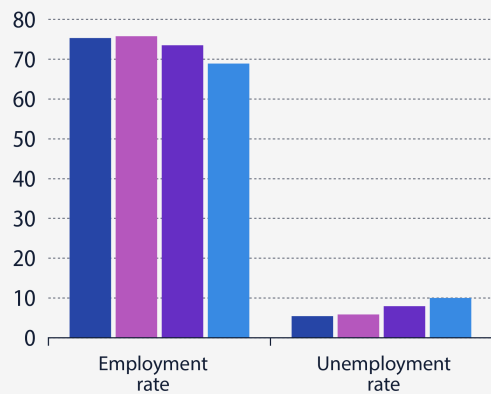
Shares of educational attainment

(% people aged 15-74 years)



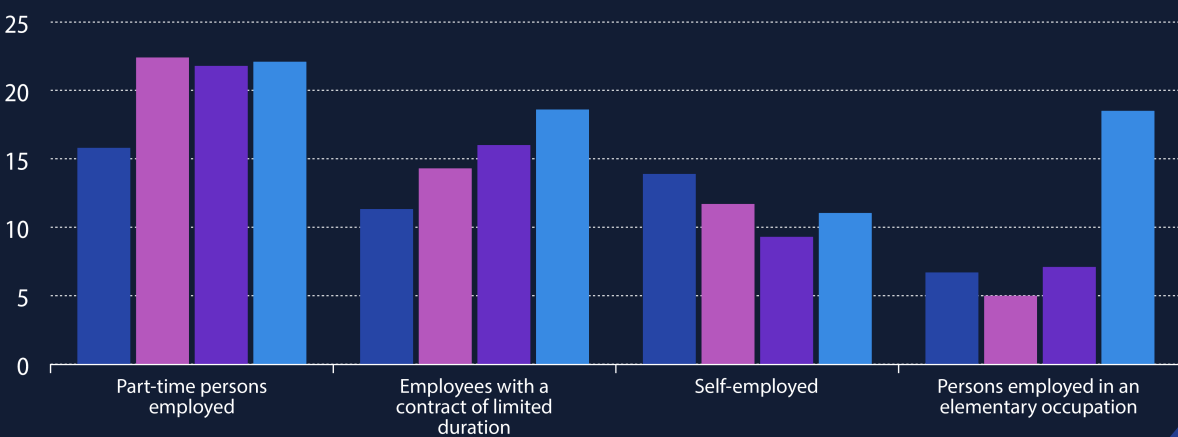
Employment and unemployment rates
