The International standard classification of education , abbreviated as ISCED , is an instrument for compiling internationally comparable education statistics.

Data by levels of education/educational attainment until 2013 are classified according to ISCED 1997 and **data as** from 2014 according to ISCED 2011. Data by fields of education are classified until 2015 according to ISCED 1997 and **data as from 2016 are classified accroding to ISCED-F 2013**.
