

Glossary: Agricultural area (AA)

Statistics Explained


Agricultural area , abbreviated as **AA** , describes the area already used for farming, or that could be brought back into cultivation using the resources normally available on an agricultural holding.

Includes

- [arable land \(ARA\)](#)
- [permanent grassland \(J0000\)](#)
- [permanent crops \(PECR\)](#)
- [kitchen gardens \(K0000\)](#) (even if they only represent small areas of total UAA)
- unutilised agricultural area (NUAA)
- special holding areas (SAA)

Excludes

- [wooded area](#)
- other land (FA9) occupied by buildings, farmyards, tracks, ponds, etc.
