
Utilised agricultural area , abbreviated as UAA , is the total area taken up by arable land, permanent grassland, permanent crops and kitchen gardens used by the holding , regardless of the type of tenure or of whether it is used as a part of common land .

Includes

- arable land
- · permanent grassland
- permanent crops
- kitchen gardens

Excludes

- mushrooms
- unutilised agricultural land (NUAA)
- woodland (WA)
- other land, occupied by buildings, farmyards, tracks, ponds, etc. (FA9)
- · utilised agricultural area which is a property of the owner but is leased or rented to someone else
- · common land which is not used (NUAA)
