

Glossary: Utilised agricultural area (UAA)

Statistics Explained

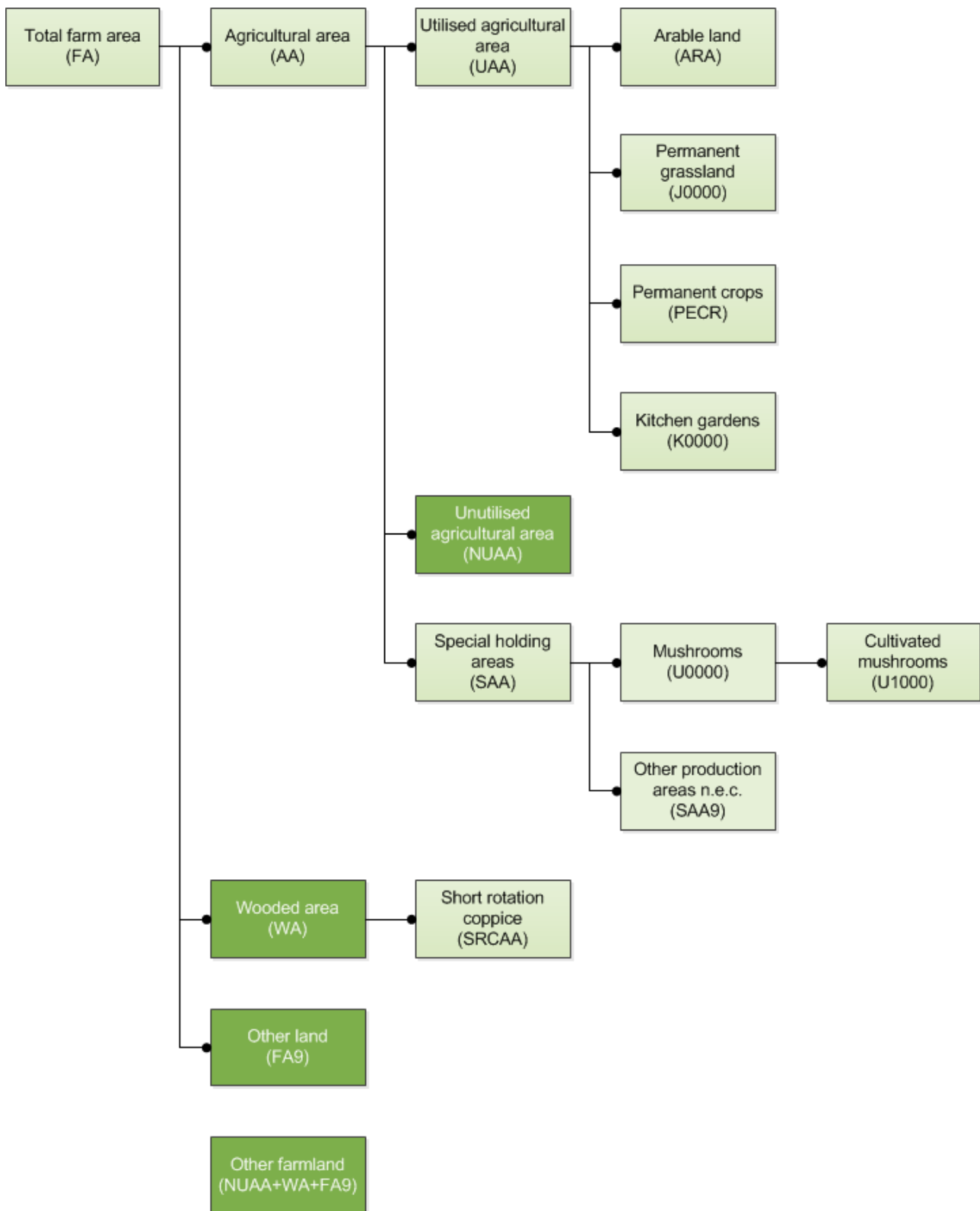
Utilised agricultural area , abbreviated as **UAA** , is the total area taken up by arable land, permanent grassland, permanent crops and kitchen gardens used by the [holding](#) , regardless of the type of tenure or of whether it is used as a part of [common land](#) .

Includes

- [arable land](#)
- [permanent grassland](#)
- [permanent crops](#)
- [kitchen gardens](#)

Excludes

- mushrooms
- unutilised agricultural land (NUAA)
- woodland (WA)
- other land, occupied by buildings, farmyards, tracks, ponds, etc. (FA9)
- utilised agricultural area which is a property of the owner but is leased or rented to someone else
- common land which is not used (NUAA)
