

**PRODCOM** is an annual survey for the collection and dissemination of statistics on the production of industrial (mainly [manufactured](#)) goods, both in value and quantity terms, in the [European Union \(EU\)](#). It is abbreviated from the French **Prod**uction **Com**munautaire.

The PRODCOM survey is based on a list of products called the **PRODCOM list** which currently comprises about 4000 headings relating to industrial products and some industrial services (see also [Eurostat - EU Vocabularies - Publications Office of the EU](#)). These products are detailed at an eight-digit level. The first 4 digits refer to the equivalent class within the [Statistical classification of economic activities in the European Community \(NACE\)](#), and the next 2 digits refer to subcategories within the [Statistical classification of products by activity \(CPA\)](#). Most PRODCOM headings correspond to one or more [Combined nomenclature \(CN\)](#) codes.
