

Glossary:Real-time data flow

Statistics Explained

The **real-time data flow** at a specific [point in time](#) is the information set available to people (official statisticians, researcher, etc.). It includes [soft](#) , [hard](#) , [financial data](#) and it usually provides an incomplete data [coverage](#) of the [reference period](#) at a specific point in time.

The real-time data flow is by construction unbalanced: ragged or jagged hedge data.
