A **special purpose road motor vehicle** is a road motor vehicle designed for purposes other than the carriage of passengers or goods.

This category includes:

- fire brigade vehicles,
- mobile cranes,
- self-propelled rollers,
- bulldozers with metallic wheels or track,
- vehicles for recording film, radio and TV broadcasting,
- mobile library vehicles,
- towing vehicles for vehicles in need of repair,
- other special purpose road motor vehicles.
