

Internet use is the number of people accessing the internet, usually expressed as a proportion of the population.

In the context of the [survey](#) on internet use within [households](#) , an **internet user** is defined as someone who has used the internet within the last three months, while a **regular internet user** is defined as someone who has used the internet at least once a week within the reference period of the survey (the first three months of the calendar year), regardless of where they do so.
