


Glossary: Association of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN)

Statistics Explained

The **Association of South East Asian Nations**, abbreviated as **ASEAN**, was established on 8 August 1967 in Bangkok (Thailand) to accelerate economic growth, social progress and cultural development and to promote peace and stability in the region.

- Singapore (Republic of Singapore)
- Thailand (Kingdom of Thailand)
- Vietnam (Socialist Republic of Vietnam)
