

Glossary:Arrival of tourist at a tourist accommodation establishment

Statistics Explained

Within the context of [European Union \(EU\) tourism statistics](#) , an **arrival** is defined as a [tourist](#) who arrives at a [tourist accommodation establishment \(rented accommodation\)](#) or at a [non-rented accommodation](#) ; in the scope of the Tourism Regulation, however, no data for the latter are collected.

The tourist can be either a [resident](#) or a [non-resident](#) of the country where the establishment is located; no age limit is applied: children are counted as well as adults, even in the case when the [overnight stays](#) of children might be free of charge.
