The **Asia-Europe Meeting**, abbreviated as **ASEM**, is an informal process of dialogue and co-operation which brings together countries from Europe, Asia and Oceania.

- [NESA](#) partners - Australia, Bangladesh, China, India, Japan, Kazakhstan; the Republic of Korea, Mongolia, New Zealand, Pakistan and the Russian Federation.
