Fishery statistics

Updated 20/10/2016

The EU-28's fishing fleet in 2015 had a combined capacity of 1.6 million gross tonnes and a total engine power of 6.4 million kilowatts (kW). By far, the largest fishing fleets among the EU Member States, in terms of power, were those from France, Italy, Spain and the United Kingdom. In 2015, the fishing fleets of each of these countries had a total power of between 0.8 million kW and 1.0 million kW. In terms of gross tonnage (an indicator of fish-holding capacity), however, the Spanish fishing fleet was by far the largest (343 thousand gross tonnes); [More ...](#)

The network energy supply sector (Section D) in the EU-28 employed 1.2 million persons in 2013 and generated EUR 227.3 billion of value added. The production, transmission, distribution and trade of electricity subsector (Group 35.1, hereafter referred to as the electricity supply subsector) was by far the largest part of the network energy sector, contributing 81.8 % of sectoral value added and 75.3 % of the workforce.
