[Migrant integration statistics - over-qualification](#) Updated 21/07/2021 In the EU in 2020, the highest proportion of tertiary-educated people aged 20-64 years was observed among nationals (31.8 %). This proportion was 0.9 percentage points higher than for citizens of other EU Member States and 7.7 points higher than for non-EU citizens. While the ranking of these three groups varied among the Member States, in more than two thirds (of those for which data are available for one or both of the migrant populations) at least one of the migrant populations had a higher share than nationals. [World trade in goods](#) Updated 21/07/2021 The Chinese share of world imports for trade in goods rose from 10.0 % in 2009 to 13.3 % in 2019 (a gain of 3.3 percentage points (p.p.)). The import shares for the United States (+ 0.6 p.p.) and Hong Kong (+0.2 p.p.) also grew. By contrast the imports of the EU declined by 2.6 p.p. from 16.6 % in 2009 to 14.0 % in 2019. There was also a contraction in the shares of Japan (-0.9 p.p.) and the United Kingdom (-1.0 p.p.) . [More ...](#)

[Minimum wage statistics](#) Updated 21/07/2021 On 1 July 2021, 21 out of the 27 EU Member States had a national minimum wage. EU countries without a national minimum wage were: Denmark, Italy, Cyprus, Austria, Finland and Sweden. Monthly minimum wages vary widely across the Member States, from EUR 332 in Bulgaria to EUR 2 202 in Luxembourg [More ...](#)

[Seasonality in tourism demand](#) Updated 20/07/2021 In 2019, tourism demand of EU residents was concentrated in the third quarter, mainly in August followed by July, when respectively 12.4 % and 11.3 % of the entire year's trips were made (see Figure 1). The number of trips in the peak month (August) was 2.4 times higher than the number of trips in the weakest month (January). [More ...](#)
