Statistics Explained

Serious assault means intentional or reckless physical actions that result in serious bodily injury. Includes grievous bodily harm, aggravated assault, shooting, stabbing, wounding, mutilation, etc. Excludes threats, minor assault, [deadly assault](#), and [sexual assault](#).
