

Burglary means breaking in and stealing. To be precise, getting unauthorized access to a building or other premises for [theft](#) or intent of theft — with or without forcing locks, doors, windows, etc.

Stealing without breaking in can be [robbery](#) (violent) or [theft](#) (not violent).
