

Glossary:Employment rate of recent graduates

Statistics Explained

The indicator **employment rates of recent graduates** presents the employment rates of persons aged 20 to 34 fulfilling the following conditions: first, being employed according to the [International Labour Organization \(ILO\) definition](#) , second, having attained at least upper secondary education ([ISCED 3](#)) as the highest level of education, third, not having received any education or training in the four weeks preceding the survey and four, having successfully completed their highest educational attainment 1, 2 or 3 years before the survey. The indicator is calculated based on data from the EU [Labour Force Survey](#) .
