## The gross-gross weight includes

- · the total weight of the goods;
- · all packaging:
- the tare-weight of the transport unit (for example containers, swap bodies and pallets for containing goods as well as road goods vehicles carrying goods and transported by rail).

The **gross weight** is the total weight of the goods carried, including all packaging but excluding the tare weight of the transport unit.

The tare weight is the weight of a transport unit before any cargo is loaded.
