The **European statistical system** , abbreviated as **ESS** , is a partnership between [Eurostat](#) and national statistical institutes or other national authorities in each [European Union \(EU\)](#) Member State responsible for developing, producing and disseminating European statistics.

The ESS functions as a network, with Eurostat playing a leading role in harmonising statistics in close cooperation with national statistical authorities. The ESS in turn coordinates its work with international organisations such as the [OECD](#) , the [United Nations](#) , the [International Monetary Fund](#) and the [World Bank](#) .
