Introduction and Background

This open public consultation aims to inform both the assessment of the performance of EU's support to Public Administration Reform (PAR) through European Neighbourhood Instrument (ENI) and Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance (IPA) and the design of future financial assistance. It thus seeks to reach the widest audience, that is citizens of the EU and citizens of ENI countries and of IPA beneficiaries to enhance the quality of the evaluation.

The PAR concept has evolved during the past two decades and it now covers reliability, predictability, accountability and transparency, as well as technical and managerial competence, organisational capacity, financial sustainability and citizen participation. Policy dialogue is the main policy tool and financial assistance, especially under IPA, is considered to facilitate the dialogue to achieve these goals.
