

Bottom trawl and purse-seine fishery management.

- A management plan for the Greek bottom trawl fishery has been implemented all over the country. The main target species are *Merluccius merluccius* (hake), *Mullus barbatus* (red mullet), *Mullus surmuletus* (striped mullet) and *Parapenaeus longirostris* (pink shrimp).
- Additional national measures for the bottom trawl fishery (temporal and spatial constraints).
- Authorization for international waters
- A management plan for the Greek purse-seine fishery has been implemented all over the country. The main target species are *Engraulis encrasicolus* (anchovy) and *Sardina pilchardus* (sardine).
- Additional national measures for the purse-seine fishery (temporal and spatial constraints, minimum distance from the coast and use of light).

Additional national measures for specific iconic species

- Regarding BFT (Bluefin tuna) and swordfish fishery (*Xiphias gladius*), in addition to ICCAT recommendations, an extended closure has been implemented on national level, as well as control measures (obligation for VMS & ERS for all fishing vessels regardless of their length). The marketing of by-catch is forbidden.
- Regarding shellfish fishery, including *Venus* spp., a great number of temporal and spatial constraints have been implemented all over the country.
- Regarding octopus (*Octopus vulgaris*) a minimum landing size of 500 gr has been implemented.
